1. INTRODUCTION

The Enhulk PC68 Pro is a cordless handheld pool vacuum designed for efficient cleaning of above-ground and in-ground pools, spas, and hot tubs. This manual provides detailed instructions for assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not operate the vacuum out of water.
- Ensure the filter bag is correctly installed before use to prevent damage and ensure proper suction.
- Keep children and pets away from the pool area during operation.
- Use only the charger provided by Enhulk.
- Do not attempt to lift the pool vacuum horizontally by the extension pole, as this may cause damage.
- The vacuum is suitable for water depths ranging from 1.5 ft to 10 ft (0.45 m to 3 m). It is not designed for zero-depth shallow areas.
- If the water outlet is above the water surface, suction performance will be reduced.

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack all components and ensure all items are present. Refer to the image below for a visual guide to the contents.

- Extension Poles x6 (for 9' total length)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Enhulk PC68 Pro requires minimal assembly. Follow these steps for quick setup:

1. **Install the Filter:** Remove the protective plastic from the main unit. Insert the desired filter bag (cotton mesh for fine debris, plastic mesh for larger debris) into the collection chamber.
2. **Connect the Body Part:** Securely attach the transparent collection chamber to the main fuselage.
3. **Insert the Vacuum Brush Head:** Attach one of the brush heads to the bottom of the collection chamber. Ensure it clicks into place.
4. **Attach the Extension Pole:** Connect the six extension pole sections together to achieve the desired length (up to 9 feet). Insert the assembled pole into the top of the main unit. For shorter reach, use the included short handle.

Q: Does it require any assembly?

A: Yes, Enhulk PC68 pool vacuum does require assembly, but it's minimal. You'll need to:

1: Remove protective plastic; 2: Insert the filters; 3: Attach the extension pole sections (6 pieces that snap together).

Once assembled, the pole extends to over 11 feet to reach your entire pool.

Q: Can it clean large debris?

A: Yes, Enhulk PC68 cordless pool vacuum is designed to handle large debris like leaves, twigs, and acorns with impressive suction power up to 26.5 gallons/min.

Q: Can the pool vacuum be lifted horizontally by the extension wand?

A: Do not attempt. Wand may break.

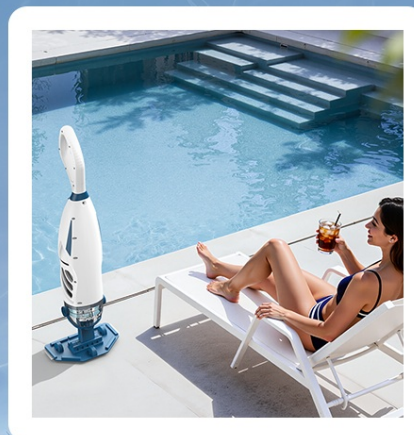


Image: Assembly steps for the Enhulk PC68 Pro.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Enhulk PC68 Pro is designed for simple one-button operation. Ensure the unit is fully charged before use.

General Operation

1. Submerge the vacuum head into the water.
2. Press the power button to activate the vacuum.
3. Slowly guide the vacuum across the pool floor, walls, steps, and corners to collect debris. The vacuum provides 26.5 GPM suction and a 6000 L/h drainage rate.
4. The replaceable cleaning head is designed to reach tight corners and blind spots effectively.
5. After cleaning, turn off the vacuum and lift it out of the water. The quick drain system will release clean water upon lifting.

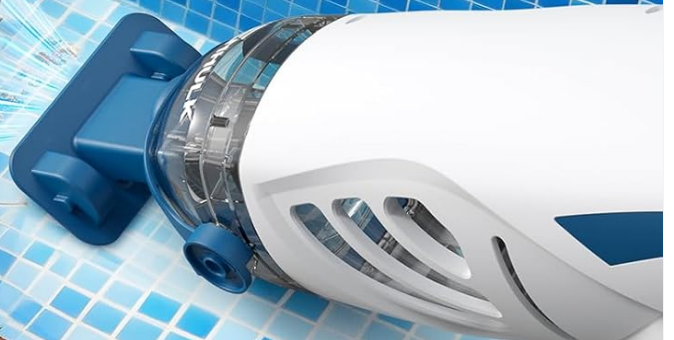


Image: The PC68 Pro cleaning a pool corner.

- Hot Tubs (water temperature 32–122°F)

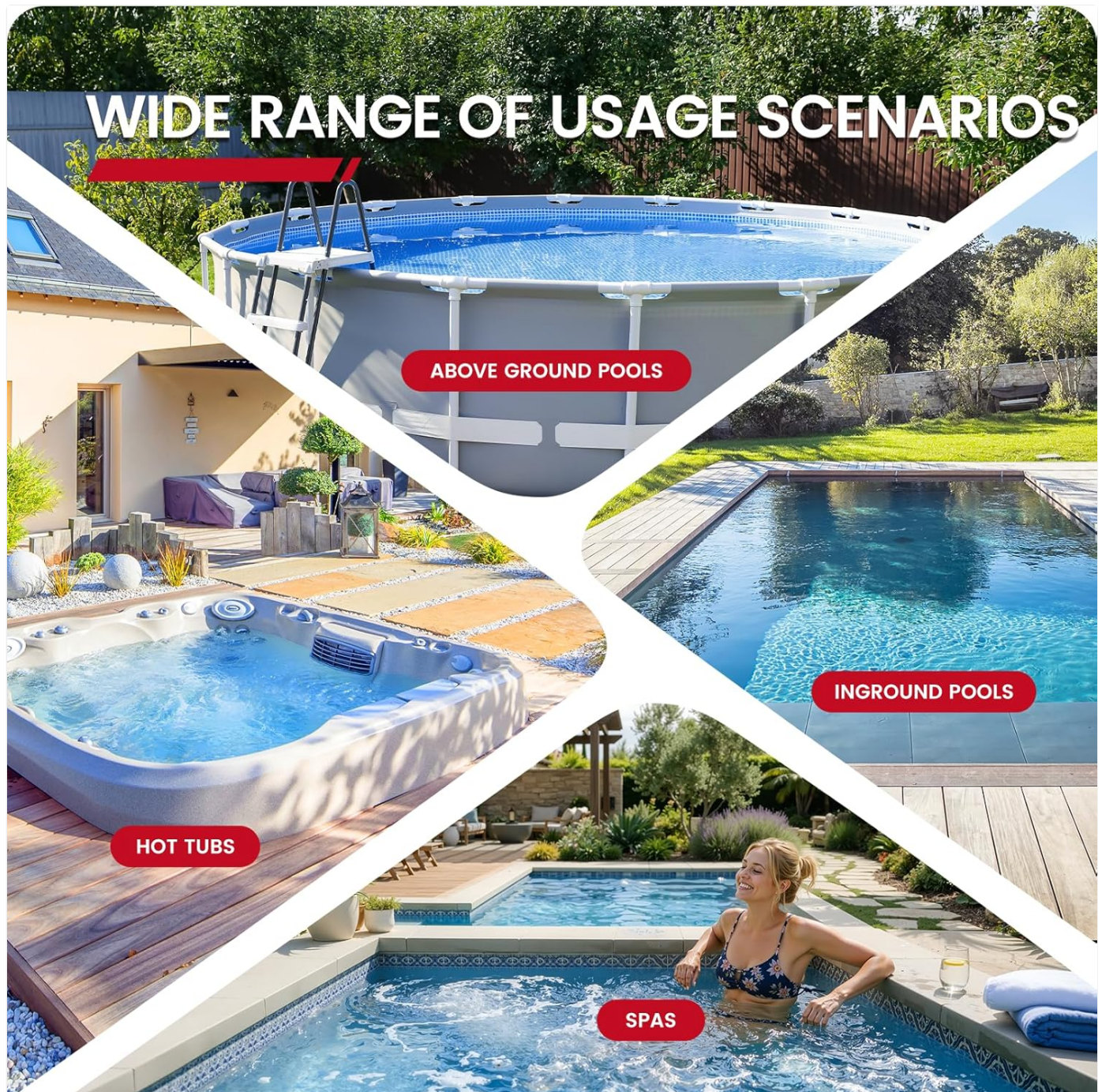


Image: Various usage scenarios for the PC68 Pro.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficiency of your Enhulk PC68 Pro pool vacuum.

Cleaning the Filter

After each use, or when suction power decreases, clean the filter bag. Remove the collection chamber, empty the debris, and rinse the filter bag thoroughly with water. Allow it to dry completely before reinserting.

Charging the Battery

The PC68 Pro features a 5200mAh battery providing up to 60 minutes of runtime. A full charge takes approximately 4 hours. Connect the provided charger to the charging port on the vacuum and plug it into a power outlet. The charging cable length is 74.8 inches.



7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your PC68 Pro, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **No Suction:** Ensure the filter bag is properly fitted inside the collection chamber. A loose or missing filter bag will result in no suction.
- **Reduced Suction:** Check if the filter bag is full or clogged with debris. Clean the filter bag as described in the Maintenance section. Also, ensure the water outlet is submerged during operation.
- **Vacuum Not Turning On:** Ensure the battery is fully charged. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
- **Vacuum Not Picking Up Large Debris:** Ensure you are using the appropriate filter (180-micron plastic mesh for larger debris).

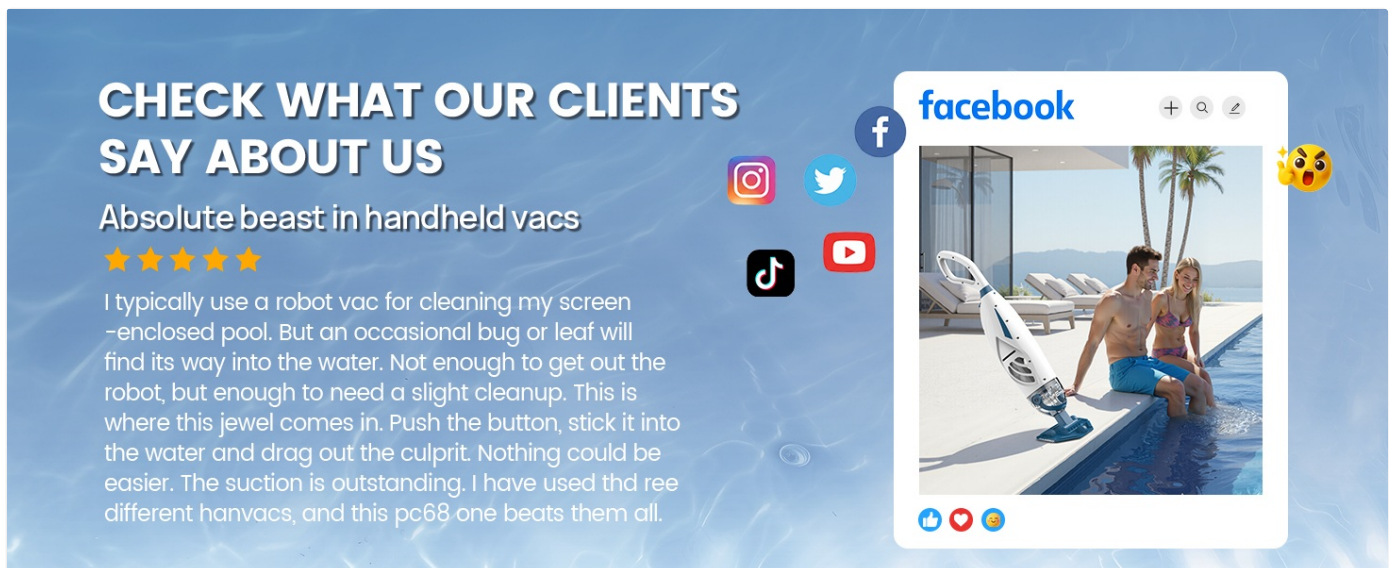


Image: Common questions and answers.

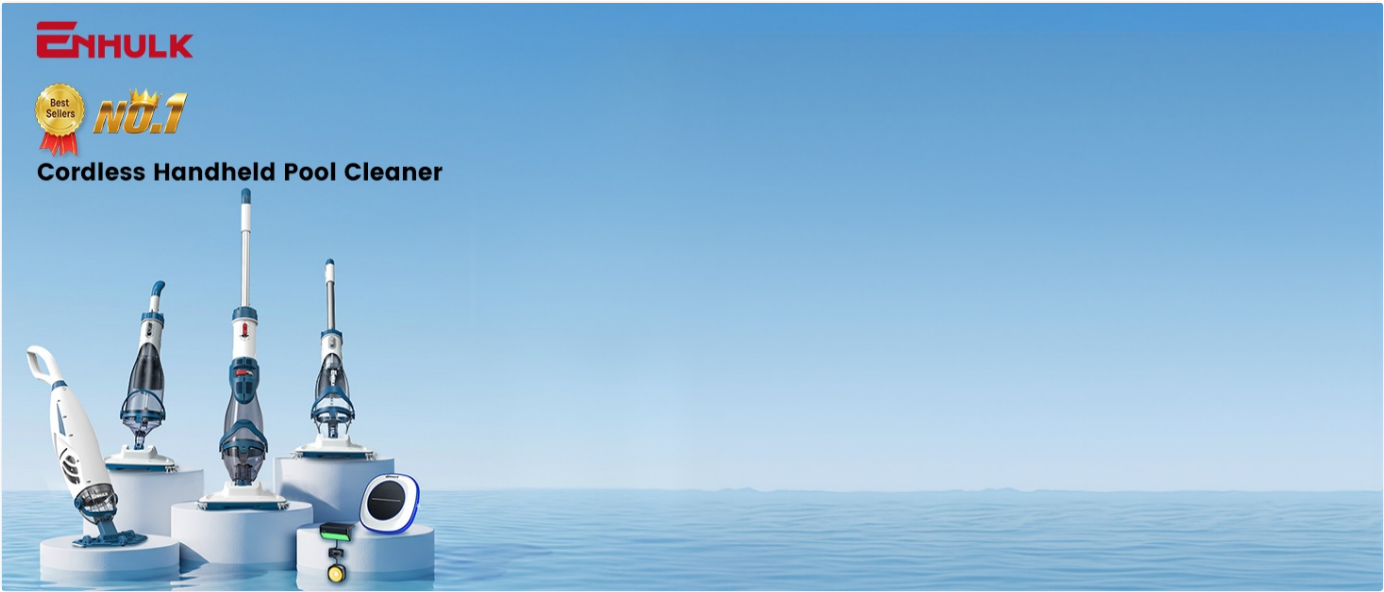
