1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective operation, assembly, and maintenance of your FAGUS H TR2024-BLK-RS Motorized Treadmill. Please read all instructions carefully before using the equipment. Retain this manual for future reference.

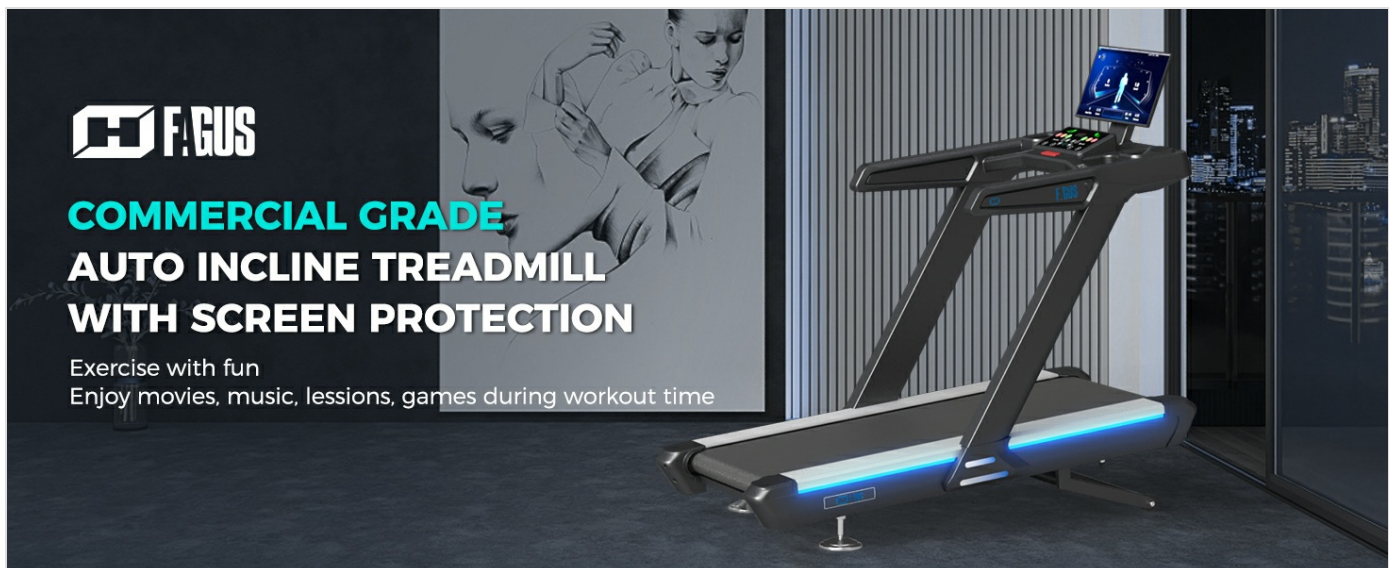

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: To reduce the risk of serious injury, read all important precautions and instructions in this manual before using the treadmill.

- Always consult with a physician before starting any exercise program.
- Keep children and pets away from the treadmill at all times.
- Place the treadmill on a level surface with at least 6 feet of clear space behind it and 2 feet on each side.

- Ensure the safety key is properly attached to your clothing before beginning a workout.
- Do not operate the treadmill if it has a damaged power cord or plug, or if it is not working properly.
- Wear appropriate athletic footwear and clothing. Avoid loose clothing that could get caught in moving parts.
- Do not step on or off the treadmill while the running belt is in motion.
- Maximum user weight capacity is 520 pounds. Do not exceed this limit.

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack all components and ensure you have received the following items:

- 1x FAGUS H Commercial Projection Black Treadmill
- User Manual (this document)
- Assembly Tools (if applicable, check packaging)
- Power Cord

If any parts are missing or damaged, do not assemble or use the treadmill. Contact customer support immediately.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your FAGUS H TR2024-BLK-RS Motorized Treadmill:

1. **Unpacking:** Remove all packaging materials and place the treadmill frame on a flat, stable surface.
2. **Unfolding (if applicable):** If the treadmill is folded, carefully lift the running deck until it locks into position. Refer to any quick-start guides included for specific folding/unfolding mechanisms.
3. **Securing Components:** Attach any loose components such as the console mast, handlebars, or display screen according to the included hardware and diagrams. Ensure all bolts and screws are tightened securely.
4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into the treadmill's power input, then into a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the power switch is in the OFF position before plugging in.
5. **Initial Inspection:** Before first use, inspect the running belt for proper alignment and tension. Ensure no foreign objects are on or under the belt.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Control Panel and Display

The treadmill features a 22-inch interactive fitness dashboard that tracks real-time workout metrics such as incline, speed, heart rate, time, and distance. The control panel below the display allows for easy adjustment of settings.

5.2 Starting and Stopping

1. Ensure the safety key is in place and attached to your clothing.
2. Press the **START** button on the control panel. The belt will begin to move at a low speed.
3. To stop, press the **STOP** button. For emergency stops, pull the safety key from the console.

5.3 Adjusting Speed

The treadmill offers speeds up to 12.5 miles per hour. Use the **Speed +** and **Speed -** buttons on the control panel to increase or decrease the running belt speed. Quick speed buttons may also be available for preset speeds.

5.4 Adjusting Incline

The FAGUS H TR2024-BLK-RS features an auto-adjust incline system, ranging from 0% to 15%. Use the **Incline +** and **Incline -** buttons to change the incline level. Quick incline buttons may also be available for preset incline levels.

5.5 Smart Screen Connectivity and Projection

5.6 Shock Absorption System

The treadmill is equipped with a 6-zone suspension system and anti-slip stabilizers designed to reduce joint stress during workouts. This system minimizes knee pressure by over 35% compared to standard models, providing a more comfortable and safer exercise experience.

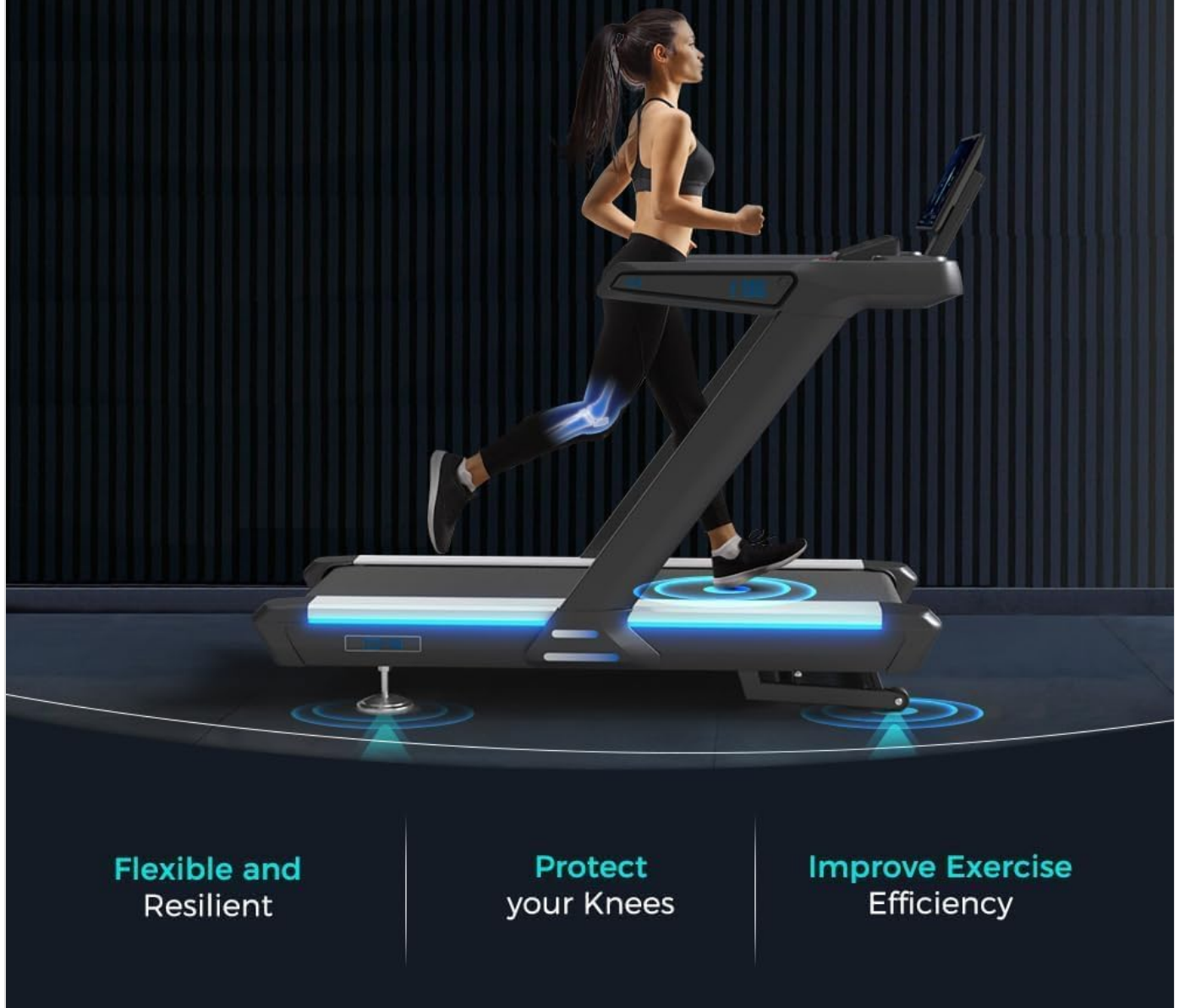


Image 5.4: Visual representation of the treadmill's 6-zone shock absorption system, designed to enhance flexibility, resilience, and protect user's knees.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your treadmill.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the console and other surfaces with a damp cloth after each use. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Belt Lubrication:** The running belt requires periodic lubrication. Refer to the specific instructions provided with your treadmill's lubricant kit or contact customer support for guidance.
- **Belt Tension and Alignment:** Check the running belt tension and alignment regularly. If the belt slips or drifts to one side, adjust it according to the instructions in the full manual or contact service.
- **Motor Cover:** Periodically vacuum under the motor cover to remove dust and debris. Ensure the treadmill is unplugged before performing this task.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your treadmill, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Treadmill does not power on	Power cord unplugged, circuit breaker tripped, safety key not in place.	Check power cord connection, reset circuit breaker, ensure safety key is fully inserted.
Running belt slips	Belt tension too loose, belt worn.	Adjust belt tension (refer to full manual), or contact customer support for belt replacement.
Unusual noise during operation	Loose parts, motor issue, belt friction.	Check for and tighten any loose bolts. Lubricate belt if necessary. If noise persists, contact customer support.
Incline not adjusting	Incline motor issue, obstruction.	Check for any obstructions under the treadmill. If problem continues, contact customer support.
