## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your MP Mobile Pixels Trio 3 Triple Portable Monitor. Designed to expand your workspace with two additional 14.1-inch FHD 1080P screens, this monitor features a built-in kickstand, USB-C connectivity with 65W pass-through charging, and compatibility with both Mac and Windows laptops. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize your productivity.




Image: The Trio 3 monitor in use, providing a triple-screen setup for enhanced productivity.




Image: All components included with the Trio 3 monitor, laid out for inspection.

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The Trio 3 monitor is designed for quick and effortless setup. Follow these steps to begin using your portable monitor:

1. **Attach the Monitor:** Use the four provided laptop magnets to securely attach the Trio 3 monitor to the back of your laptop screen. Alternatively, utilize the built-in kickstand for a freestanding setup.




Image: Step 1 of setup, showing the monitor being attached to a laptop.

2. **Open and Secure the Bracket:** Once attached, open the Trio monitor and secure its integrated bracket or kickstand to provide stable support.




Image: The Trio 3 monitor with its integrated kickstand providing support.

3. **Connect Power and Data:** Connect the provided USB-C cable from the Trio 3 monitor to your laptop. For most modern laptops, a single USB-C cable will provide both power and video signal. If your laptop requires additional power, use the USB-C to USB-A adapter with the USB-C cable.

## OPERATING THE MONITOR

---

The Trio 3 monitor offers various display modes to suit different work scenarios and enhance your productivity.

### Display Modes

- **Portrait Mode:** Rotate the screens vertically for reading documents, coding, or viewing long web pages.

- **Three Screen Mode:** Utilize both portable monitors alongside your laptop screen for maximum workspace.
- **Eyecare Mode:** Adjust display settings to reduce blue light and eye strain during prolonged use.



## Connectivity and Power

The Trio 3 features dual USB-C ports. One port is used for connecting to your laptop for video and power. The second USB-C port supports 65W pass-through charging, allowing you to power your laptop through the monitor, reducing cable clutter. Ensure your laptop's USB-C port supports DisplayPort Alternate Mode for video output.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Trio 3 monitor, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the screen and exterior surfaces. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** When not in use, fold the monitors securely and store them in a protective sleeve or bag to prevent scratches and damage.
- **Handling:** Handle the monitor with care. Avoid dropping it or applying excessive force to the screens or hinges.

- **Cable Management:** Keep cables organized and free from kinks or sharp bends to prevent damage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Trio 3 monitor, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
<b>No Display / Black Screen</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Ensure the USB-C cable is securely connected to both the monitor and your laptop.</li> <li>◦ Verify your laptop's USB-C port supports DisplayPort Alternate Mode.</li> <li>◦ Check your laptop's display settings to ensure the external monitor is detected and enabled.</li> <li>◦ Try a different USB-C port on your laptop, if available.</li> <li>◦ Restart your laptop.</li> </ul>
<b>Flickering Screen</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Ensure the cable is not damaged and is securely connected.</li> <li>◦ Reduce the display resolution or refresh rate in your laptop's display settings.</li> <li>◦ Ensure your laptop's graphics drivers are up to date.</li> </ul>
<b>Monitor Not Receiving Power</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Confirm the USB-C cable is connected to a power-delivery enabled port on your laptop or an external power source if needed.</li> <li>◦ If using pass-through charging, ensure the power adapter is connected to the monitor's second USB-C port.</li> </ul>
<b>Incorrect Display Orientation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Adjust the display orientation in your operating system's display settings (e.g., Windows Display Settings or macOS System Settings &gt; Displays).</li> </ul>




Image: A visual summary of the Trio 3 monitor's technical specifications.
