# Dapper Supply 6 Gallon Wall Mount Wet/Dry Vacuum Instruction Manual

## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

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The Dapper Supply 6 Gallon Wall Mount Wet/Dry Vacuum is a versatile cleaning solution designed for garages, workshops, cars, and jobsites. Featuring a powerful 5.5 Peak HP brushless motor, it delivers strong, consistent suction for both wet and dry debris. Its wall-mounted design saves floor space, and the integrated vacuum and blower functions provide comprehensive cleaning capabilities. The unit includes a 30-foot hose and various attachments for extended reach and specialized tasks.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety instructions before operating this appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, and/or serious injury.

- Always wear safety glasses when operating the vacuum.
- Do not operate the vacuum near flammable liquids, gases, or explosive dust.
- Never pick up hot ashes, coals, or other burning or smoking materials.
- Do not vacuum toxic, carcinogenic, or other hazardous materials.
- Unplug the vacuum from the power outlet before making adjustments, changing accessories, or storing the unit.
- Keep the hose and attachments away from your face and body, especially eyes and ears.
- Ensure the filter is properly installed for dry vacuuming to prevent motor damage.
- Do not use the vacuum if the power cord or plug is damaged.

- This appliance is for indoor use only.

### 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

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Verify that all items are present in the package:

- 30-ft Hose
- Crevice Tool
- Upholstery Tool
- Wall Mounting Bracket and Hardware
- Hose Storage Hook
- Cartridge Filter (pre-installed or separate)
- User Manual (this document)

### 4. SETUP

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#### 4.1 Wall Mounting

1. Select a suitable wall location near a standard electrical outlet, ensuring sufficient space for the vacuum unit and hose.
2. Using the provided wall mounting bracket as a template, mark the drilling points on the wall.
3. Drill pilot holes and securely fasten the mounting bracket to the wall using appropriate hardware for your wall type (e.g., studs, concrete anchors).
4. Attach the hose storage hook to the wall near the vacuum unit, ensuring it can support the coiled 30-ft hose.
5. Carefully lift the vacuum unit and slide it onto the wall mounting bracket until it locks securely into place.

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
Figure 4.1: Wall-mounted vacuum unit and hose storage.

## 4.2 Hose and Attachment Connection

1. Connect the 30-ft hose to the intake port on the front of the vacuum unit by twisting it clockwise until secure.
2. For vacuuming, attach the desired accessory (Crevice Tool or Upholstery Tool) to the end of the hose. Ensure a snug fit.
3. For blower function, disconnect the hose from the intake port and connect it to the blower port located on the side of the unit.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1 Powering On/Off

Plug the dedicated 5-ft power cord into a standard 120V AC outlet. Locate the power switch on the top of the unit. Flip the switch to the 'ON' position to start the vacuum and to the 'OFF' position to turn it off.

### 5.2 Vacuum Mode (Dry)

1. Ensure the cartridge filter is clean and properly installed for dry vacuuming.
2. Connect the hose to the intake port and attach the appropriate tool (Crevice Tool for tight spaces, Upholstery Tool for fabrics).
3. Turn the power switch to 'ON'.
4. Adjust the suction power using the variable speed control knob on the unit (MIN to MAX).

5. Begin vacuuming the desired area. The 30-ft hose allows for extensive reach without repositioning the unit.

### 5.3 Vacuum Mode (Wet)

1. **Remove the cartridge filter before wet vacuuming.** The filter is designed for dry use only.
2. Connect the hose to the intake port.
3. Turn the power switch to 'ON'.
4. Vacuum liquids. The tank has a 6-gallon capacity. Do not overfill.
5. When the tank is full, the float mechanism will automatically shut off suction. Turn off the vacuum and empty the tank.

### 5.4 Blower Mode

1. Disconnect the hose from the intake port.
2. Connect the hose to the blower port on the side of the vacuum unit.
3. Attach the desired tool to the end of the hose for directed airflow.
4. Turn the power switch to 'ON'.
5. Use the blower to clear leaves, dust, and debris from surfaces.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

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Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your vacuum.

### 6.1 Emptying the Tank

1. Unplug the vacuum from the power outlet.
2. Unlatch the clips securing the motor head to the tank.
3. Lift the motor head off the tank.
4. Carefully empty the contents of the tank into a suitable receptacle.
5. Clean the inside of the tank with water and mild detergent if necessary. Rinse thoroughly and allow to dry before reassembly.

### 6.2 Filter Cleaning and Replacement

The easy-clean cartridge filter system captures fine particles. For dry vacuuming, ensure the filter is clean and dry.

1. Unplug the vacuum. Remove the motor head.
2. Twist and pull the cartridge filter to remove it from the motor head.
3. Gently tap the filter to dislodge loose dirt. For a deeper clean, rinse the filter with water.
4. Allow the filter to air dry completely before reinstalling. Do not use the vacuum with a wet filter for dry applications.
5. Replace the filter if it is damaged or excessively worn.

### 6.3 Hose and Accessory Cleaning

Inspect the hose and accessories regularly for blockages or damage. Clear any obstructions and wipe down with a damp cloth as needed.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum does not turn on	No power; Damaged power cord/plug; Faulty switch	Check power outlet and circuit breaker; Inspect cord/plug for damage; Contact customer support if switch is faulty.
Low suction power	Clogged hose/filter; Full tank; Improperly sealed lid	Clear blockages from hose/attachments; Clean or replace filter; Empty tank; Ensure motor head is securely latched.
Water/debris leaking from unit	Tank overfilled; Improperly sealed lid; Damaged tank	Empty tank; Ensure motor head is securely latched; Inspect tank for cracks or damage.
Motor overheats/shuts off	Blocked airflow; Prolonged heavy use	Clear blockages; Allow motor to cool down; Ensure proper ventilation.
