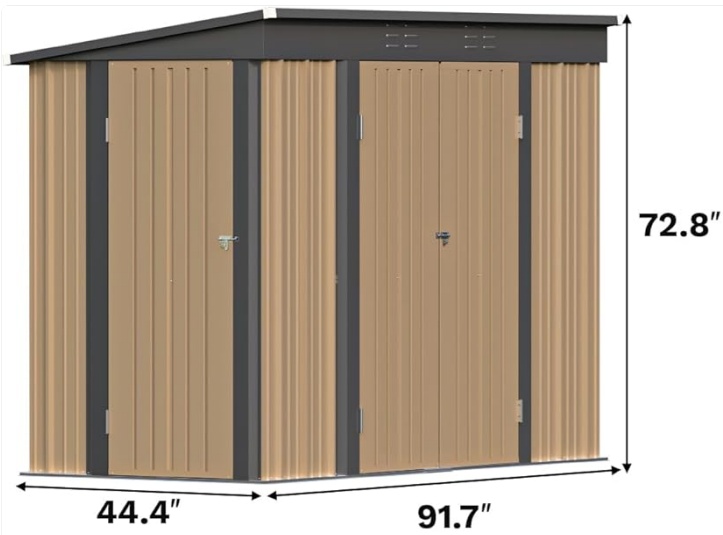
4.1 Site Preparation

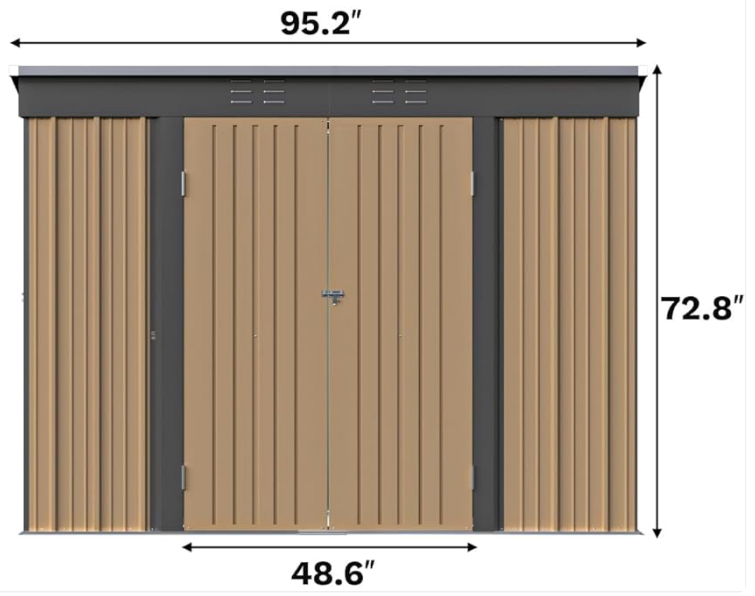


Image 4.1: Dimensional diagram of the Patiowell 8x4 FT storage shed, illustrating its length, width, and height.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Patiowell storage shed is designed for convenient and secure storage.

5.1 Door Operation

The shed features a practical triple-door setup for enhanced access. The wide openings allow for easy storage and retrieval of bulky items like lawnmowers or large tools. For smaller items, opening a single door helps minimize dust intrusion and maintain internal conditions.

- To open, unlock the metal latch and pull the door handle.
- To close, push the door firmly until it aligns with the frame, then secure the lockable latch.

5.2 Ventilation

The shed is equipped with 4 vents to promote air circulation, helping to keep the interior dry and prevent moisture buildup. Ensure these vents are not obstructed.

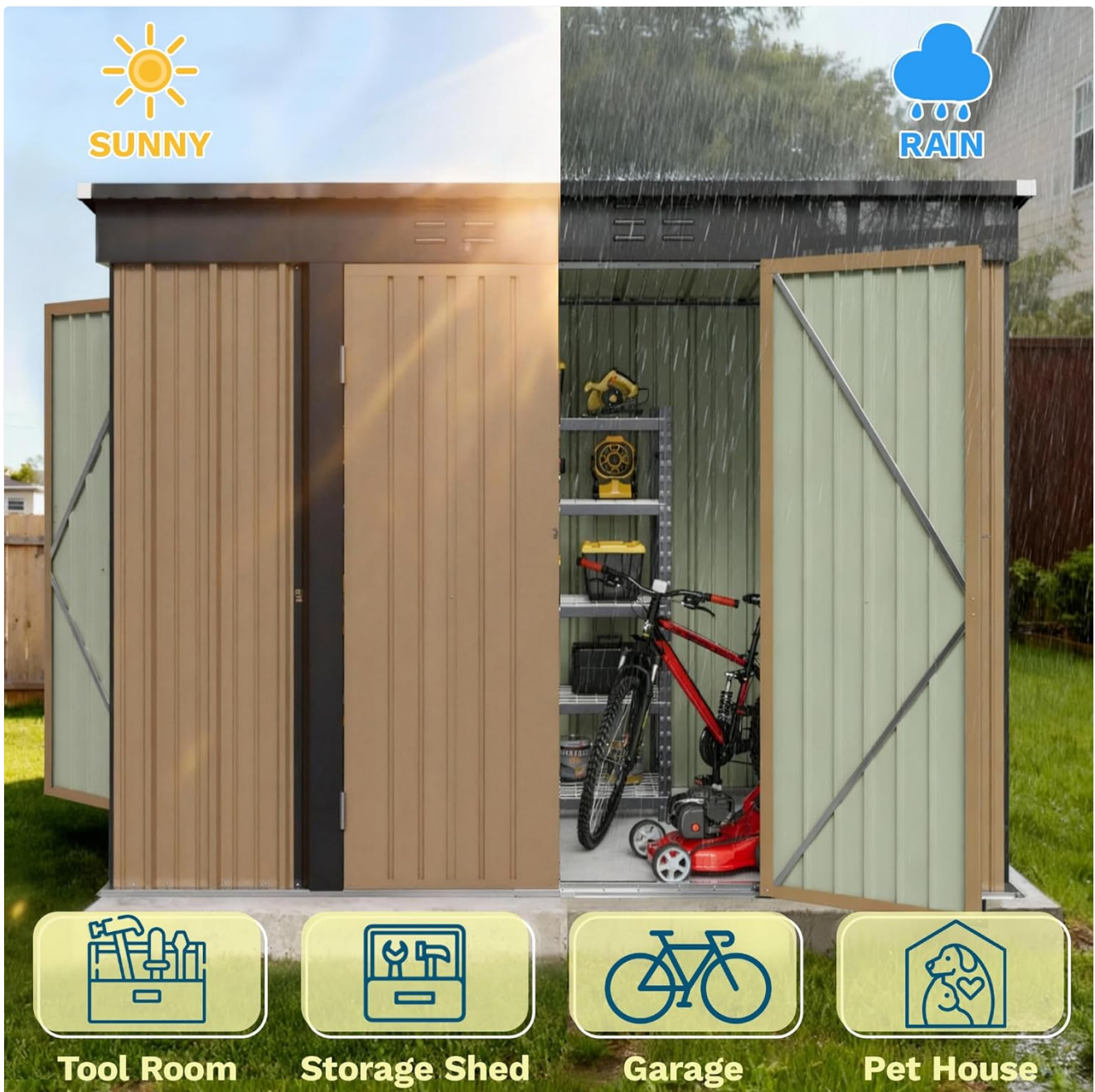


Image 5.4: The shed's robust construction provides reliable protection for stored items in both sunny and rainy weather conditions.

6. MAINTENANCE

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Doors do not close properly or are misaligned.	Uneven foundation; loose fasteners; bent panels.	Ensure the shed is on a level surface. Check and tighten all assembly fasteners. Gently realign any bent panels if possible.
Water leakage inside the shed.	Improperly sealed joints; damaged roof/panels; obstructed drainage.	Inspect all seams and joints for proper sealing. Check roof and wall panels for damage. Clear any debris from the roof and surrounding drainage areas.
Shed feels unstable or wobbly.	Incomplete or incorrect assembly; lack of anchoring; uneven ground.	Review the assembly manual to ensure all steps were followed correctly. Verify all fasteners are tight. Ensure the shed is on a level foundation and consider anchoring it.
