3. SETUP

3.1 Base Assembly

1. Carefully remove the air cooler unit and all accessories from the packaging.
2. Connect the two halves of the base together.
3. Align the assembled base with the bottom of the main unit.
4. Secure the base to the unit using the provided screws.

5. Place the unit on a flat, stable surface.

3.2 Filling the Water Tank

The unit features a 4.2-gallon water tank that can be filled from the top or by pulling out the bottom tank. For optimal cooling, ensure the water level is between the MIN and MAX indicators.

1. Open the top lid of the unit.
2. Carefully pour clean water into the reservoir until it reaches the MAX line on the visible water level indicator.
3. Alternatively, pull out the bottom water tank, fill it, and slide it back into place.
4. For enhanced cooling, place the 4 included ice packs (after freezing them) into the top water reservoir.
5. Close the top lid securely.

3.3 Power Connection

Plug the power cord into a standard 120V electrical outlet.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Uthfy Evaporative Air Cooler can be operated using the touch control panel on top of the unit or the included remote control.

Control at Your Fingertips: LED Panel & Remote

Cool the entire room, right from your couch

4.1 Power On/Off

- Press the **ON/OFF** button on the control panel or remote to turn the unit on or off.

4.2 Adjusting Fan Speed

The unit offers 3 fan speeds:

- Press the **SPEED** button repeatedly to cycle through Low, Medium, and High fan speeds.

4.3 Selecting Operating Mode

Choose from 4 distinct operating modes:

- Press the **MODE** button repeatedly to select Normal, Natural, Cooling, or Sleep mode.
- **Normal Mode:** Provides a consistent airflow.
- **Natural Mode:** Simulates natural wind patterns with varying speeds.
- **Cooling Mode:** Activates the evaporative cooling function, using water and ice packs for cooler air.
- **Sleep Mode:** Operates quietly with reduced fan speed and dimmed display for undisturbed rest.

4.4 Activating Oscillation (Swing)

- Press the **SWING** button to activate the 120° oscillation feature, distributing air across a wider area. Press again to stop.

4.5 Setting the Timer

- Press the **TIMER** button repeatedly to set the auto-off timer from 1 to 12 hours. The unit will automatically turn off after the set time.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your Uthfy Evaporative Air Cooler.

5.1 Water Tank Cleaning

To prevent mold and mildew, clean the water tank regularly, especially if the unit is not used for an extended period.

- Unplug the unit from the power outlet.
- Locate the drainage port at the bottom rear of the unit.
- Uncap the drainage port to empty any remaining water from the tank.
- Wipe the inside of the tank with a soft cloth and mild detergent, then rinse thoroughly.
- Ensure the tank is completely dry before recapping the drainage port and refilling.

5.2 Cooling Pad/Filter Cleaning

The cooling pad and filter should be cleaned periodically to maintain efficient airflow and cooling performance.

- Unplug the unit.
- Gently remove the rear panel to access the cooling pad/filter.
- Rinse the cooling pad/filter under running water to remove dust and debris. For stubborn dirt, use a soft brush.
- Allow the cooling pad/filter to air dry completely before reinserting it into the unit.
- Reattach the rear panel securely.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Uthfy Evaporative Air Cooler, please refer to the following common

problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on	No power supply; Power button not pressed.	Check power cord connection; Ensure outlet is functional; Press ON/OFF button.
No cool air / Weak cooling	Water tank empty; Cooling function not activated; Ice packs not used; Cooling pad dirty.	Fill water tank; Activate Cooling Mode; Add frozen ice packs; Clean cooling pad.
Weak airflow	Low fan speed selected; Air filter/cooling pad dirty.	Increase fan speed; Clean air filter/cooling pad.
Unusual noise	Unit not on a flat surface; Internal obstruction.	Place unit on a stable, flat surface; Check for and remove any obstructions.
