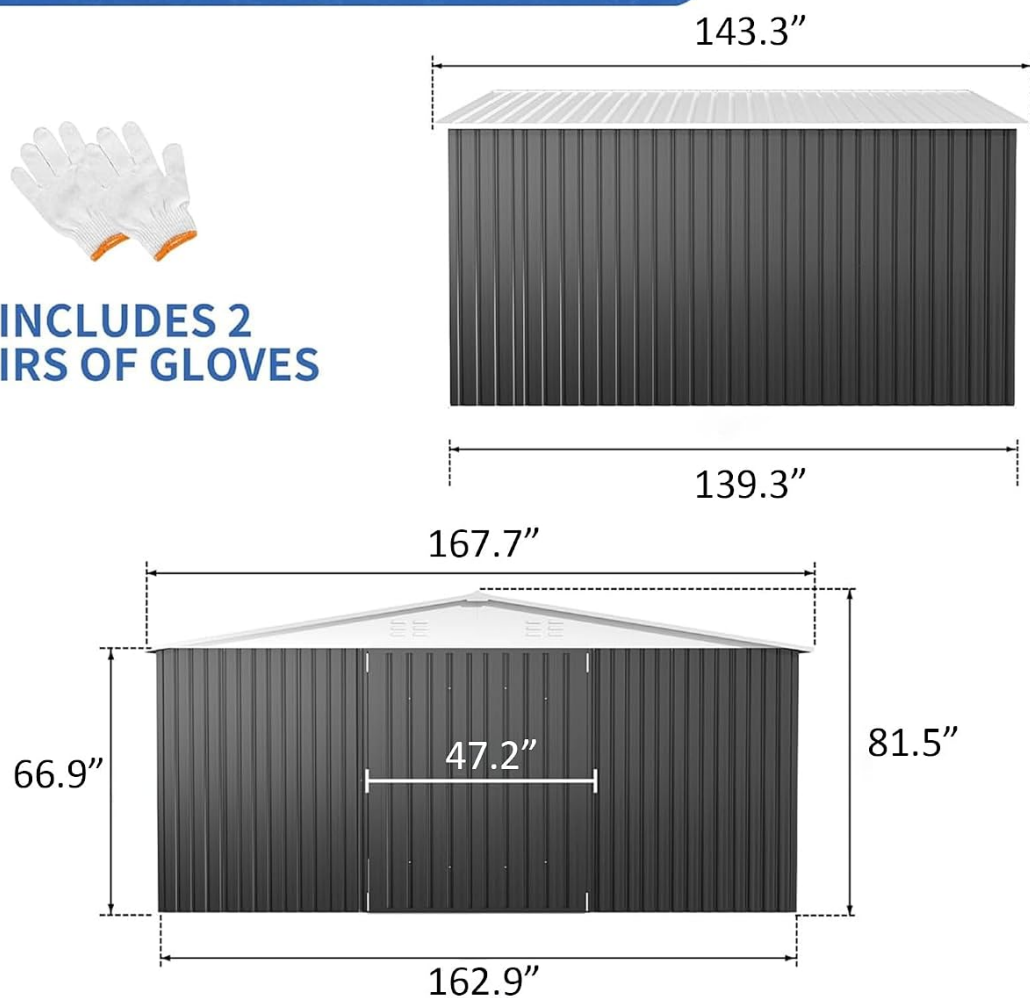

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The AirWire storage shed features a modular design for straightforward assembly. While no professional skills are needed, two people are recommended for efficient and safe installation.

4.1 Site Preparation

1. Choose a level, firm, and dry location for your shed. A concrete slab or a well-compacted gravel base is ideal.
2. Clear the area of any debris, rocks, or vegetation.
3. Ensure adequate space around the shed for assembly and future access.

4.2 Assembly Steps

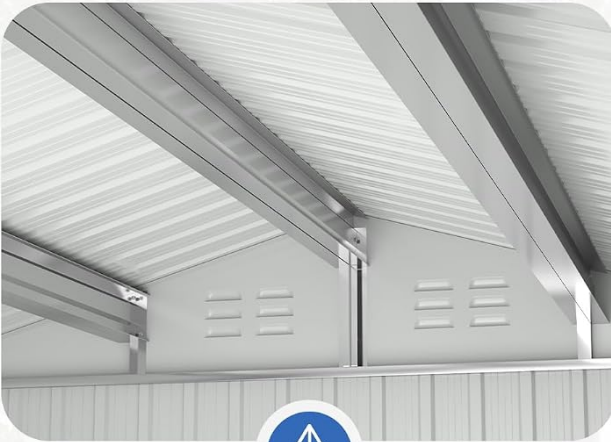
Refer to the detailed step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly manual included with your product. Key steps generally include:

3. **Roof Frame and Panel Installation:** Assemble the roof frame, including the sturdy beams, and then attach the roof panels. Ensure all connections are secure to provide weather resistance.
4. **Door Installation:** Mount the lockable doors and ensure they open and close smoothly.
5. **Final Checks:** Tighten all screws and bolts. Verify the shed is stable and all panels are properly secured.

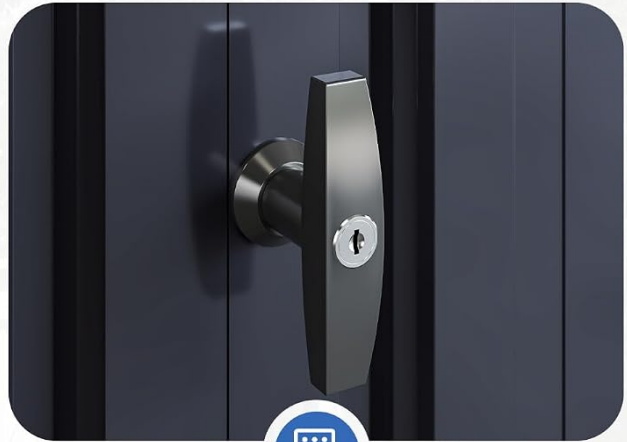


Image: Assembled AirWire storage shed, demonstrating its spacious interior and potential for organization.

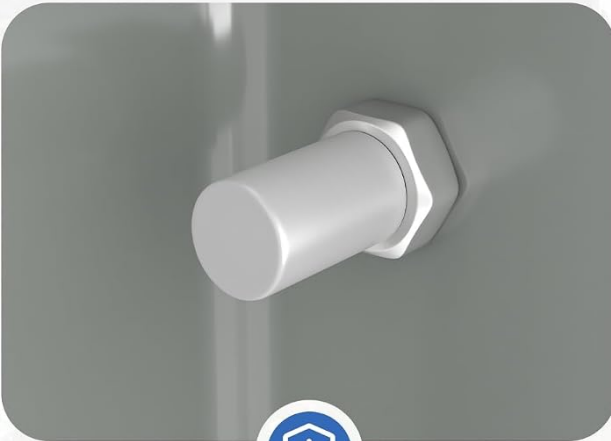

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Door Operation and Security

The shed is equipped with lockable doors for enhanced security. To open, unlock the door handle and pull. To close, push the doors shut and engage the lock. Always ensure the doors are securely locked when the shed is unattended to protect your valuables.

5.2 Ventilation

Integrated vents ensure optimal airflow, preventing dampness and stuffiness inside the shed. Ensure these vents are not obstructed by stored items or external debris to maintain proper air circulation and protect stored items from moisture buildup.

5.3 Storage Capacity

Utilize the generous 12x14 FT interior space for various items. Consider adding shelving or hooks to maximize vertical storage and maintain organization. Avoid overloading the shed or placing excessively heavy items against the walls.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your AirWire storage shed.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the exterior and interior surfaces periodically with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the galvanized finish.
- **Inspection:** Annually inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as necessary. Check for any signs of rust or damage to the panels and frame.
- **Ventilation:** Keep the integrated vents clear of obstructions to ensure continuous airflow.

- **Snow Removal:** In areas with heavy snowfall, regularly remove accumulated snow from the roof to prevent excessive weight and potential damage.
- **Door Lubrication:** Lubricate door hinges and locking mechanisms annually with a silicone-based spray to ensure smooth operation.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your storage shed.

- **Shed feels flimsy after assembly:** Ensure all screws and bolts are fully tightened. The shed's rigidity is primarily provided by the fully assembled and secured panels and frame. A solid, level foundation is crucial for overall stability.
- **Dampness inside the shed:** Verify that the vents are clear and unobstructed. Ensure the shed is properly sealed at the base and around the doors. Check for any gaps in panel connections.
- **Doors do not close or lock smoothly:** Check for any obstructions in the door tracks or hinges. Ensure the shed

is level, as an uneven foundation can cause door misalignment. Lubricate hinges and locking mechanisms if needed.

- **Missing or damaged parts:** Refer to the package contents list. If parts are missing or damaged upon delivery, contact AirWire customer support with your purchase details.
