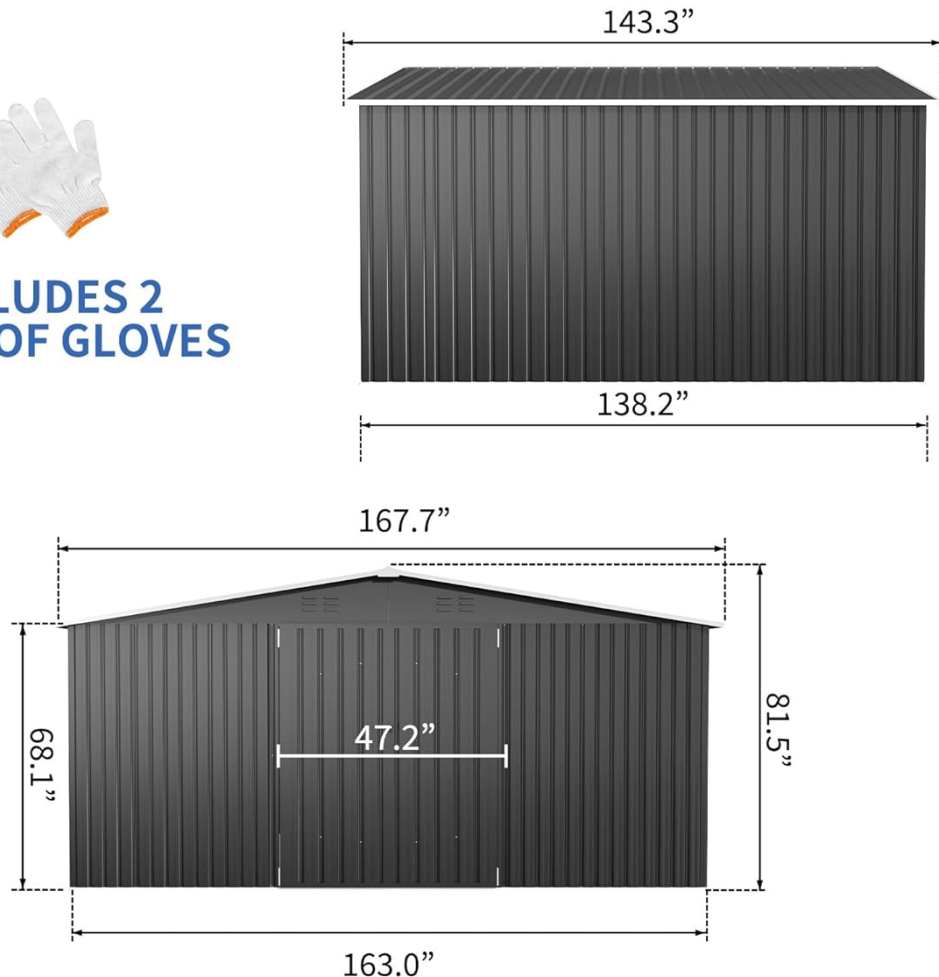

4. SITE PREPARATION

A solid, level foundation is crucial for the stability and longevity of your shed.

- Choose a flat, well-drained area.
- Clear the site of debris, rocks, and vegetation.
- Consider a concrete slab, wooden platform, or gravel base for the foundation. Ensure the foundation is slightly larger than the shed's base dimensions (138.2"D x 163"W).
- Ensure adequate clearance around the shed for assembly and future maintenance.

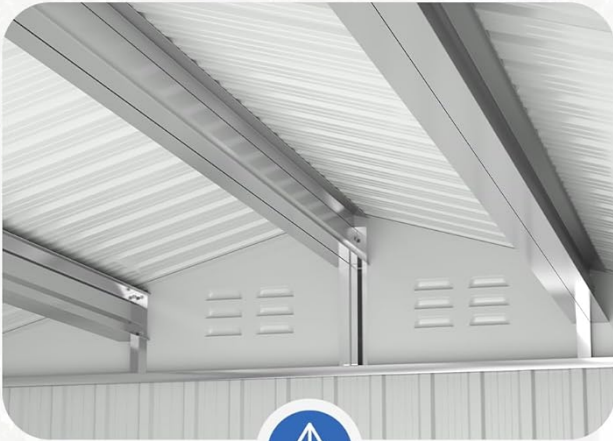
5. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

This shed is designed for straightforward assembly. We recommend two or more people for efficient and safe construction. Refer to the detailed diagrams in the included instruction booklet for visual guidance.

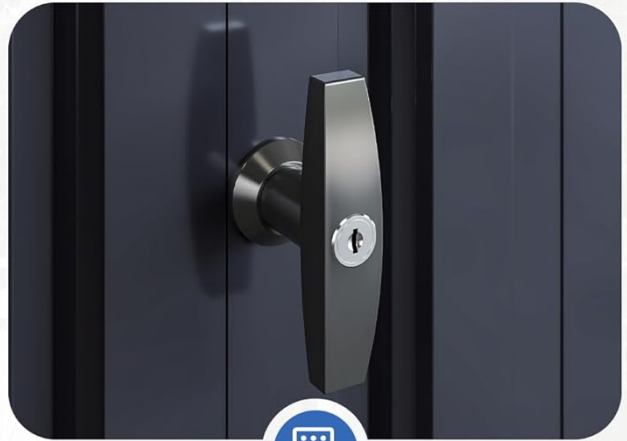
General Steps

1. **Unpack and Organize:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out according to the parts list. Separate hardware into labeled bags.
2. **Base Frame Assembly:** Assemble the base frame on your prepared foundation, ensuring it is square and level.
3. **Wall Panel Installation:** Attach the wall panels to the base frame, following the numerical sequence provided in your manual. Secure panels using the designated screws and fasteners.
4. **Door Frame Assembly:** Construct and install the door frame.
5. **Roof Structure Assembly:** Assemble the roof beams and supports.
6. **Roof Panel Installation:** Attach the roof panels, ensuring proper overlap for weather resistance.
7. **Door Installation:** Mount the lockable doors and adjust for smooth operation.
8. **Finishing Touches:** Install any remaining accessories, such as vents and corner trims.

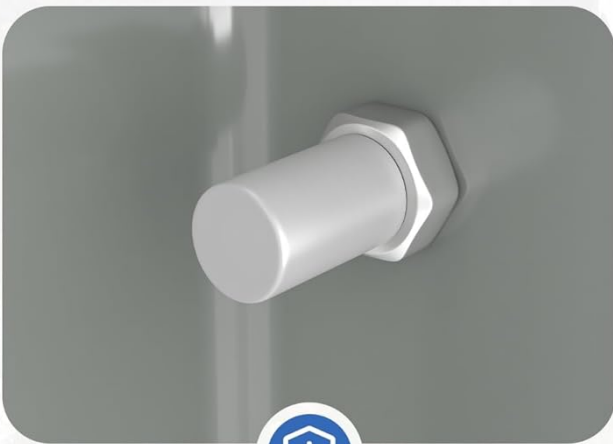

6. OPERATING YOUR SHED

Doors

The shed features lockable double doors for easy access and security.

- To open, unlock the door handle and pull outwards.
- To close, push the doors firmly shut and engage the lock.
- Ensure doors are fully closed and locked when not in use to protect contents from weather and theft.

Ventilation

Integrated air vents promote airflow, reducing condensation and maintaining a dry environment. Do not block these vents.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your AirWire shed.

- **Cleaning:** Wash the exterior panels periodically with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Rust Prevention:** Inspect the shed annually for any signs of rust, especially around fasteners and edges. Touch up any chipped paint or exposed metal with rust-inhibiting paint.
- **Door Mechanism:** Lubricate door hinges and the lock mechanism annually with a silicone-based lubricant to ensure smooth operation.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure vents remain clear of debris to maintain proper airflow.
- **Foundation:** Check the foundation for any settling or damage and address promptly.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Water Leakage	Improper panel overlap; damaged sealant; uneven foundation.	Check panel alignment and sealant application. Ensure the shed is on a level foundation. Apply silicone sealant to any gaps.
Doors Stick or Don't Close Properly	Uneven foundation; misaligned hinges; debris in track.	Verify the shed is level. Adjust door hinges. Clean door tracks. Lubricate hinges and lock.
Excessive Condensation	Blocked vents; lack of airflow.	Ensure all vents are clear and unobstructed. Consider adding a dehumidifier if necessary in very humid climates.

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Panels Appear Flimsy	Not fully secured; missing fasteners.	Ensure all screws and fasteners are tightened according to instructions. The shed's stability relies on complete assembly.
