3. Safety Information

- Do not block ventilation openings. Ensure adequate airflow around the projector.
- Do not expose the projector to rain or moisture to prevent electric shock or fire.
- Avoid looking directly into the projector lens when the lamp is on, as it can cause eye damage.
- Use only the power cord provided with the device.
- Keep the projector away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the projector. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.

5. Setup

1. **Placement:** Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. Ensure there is enough distance from the projection surface (wall or screen) to achieve your desired image size (30 to 150 inches). The optimal throw distance ranges from 2.29 feet to 11.1 feet.
2. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided power cord to the projector's power input and then to a suitable AC 220V power outlet.
3. **Power On:** Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn on the device.
4. **Adjust Focus:** Rotate the front ring around the lens to achieve a sharp image.

5. **Keystone Correction:** The projector features automatic keystone correction. For fine adjustments, use the remote control to manually correct the image angle if needed.

6. Operating Instructions

6.1. Navigation and Android OS

The projector runs on Android OS, providing direct access to various applications. Use the remote control to navigate the interface, select apps, and adjust settings.

6.2. Built-in OTT Apps

Access popular streaming platforms directly from the projector without needing additional devices. Ensure the projector is connected to Wi-Fi (Wi-Fi 6 supported) for optimal streaming performance.

6.3. Connecting External Devices

Use the HDMI and USB ports to connect laptops, smartphones, tablets, or other compatible devices. Select the appropriate input source from the projector's menu.

6.4. Bluetooth Speaker Mode

The projector can function as a standalone Bluetooth speaker. Pair your smartphone or tablet with the projector via Bluetooth to play audio through its 20W speakers.

6.5. Miracast Functionality

Mirror the screen of your compatible smartphone or tablet to the projector using Miracast for a larger viewing experience.

6.6. Using Dual Microphones for Karaoke & Commentary

The projector comes with two microphones and 8 voice effects, ideal for karaoke parties or live commentary during sports events.

- **Dust Removal:** Regularly clean the projector's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Ensure ventilation openings are free from dust and debris.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the projector in a cool, dry place, protected from dust and extreme temperatures.

8. Troubleshooting

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Power cord not connected; Power outlet faulty	Ensure power cord is securely connected; Try a different power outlet.
No Image	Incorrect input source; Device not connected	Select correct input source (HDMI/USB); Check cable connections.
Blurry Image	Focus not adjusted; Keystone incorrect	Adjust the focus ring; Use keystone correction.
No Sound	Volume too low; Audio output settings	Increase volume; Check audio settings on projector and source device.
Remote Not Working	Dead batteries; Obstruction	Replace batteries; Ensure no obstruction between remote and projector.
