1. INTRODUCTION

This manual contains important information regarding the assembly, safe operation, and maintenance of your new garden bed. 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Read all instructions:** Ensure you understand all assembly steps and safety warnings before beginning.
- **Adult assembly required:** This product should be assembled by adults.
- **Use appropriate tools:** Only use the tools specified or recommended in the assembly instructions.
- **Secure placement:** Place the garden bed on a flat, stable surface. If placed in a windy area, consider securing it to prevent tipping, especially before filling with soil.
- **Weight capacity:** Do not exceed the stated weight capacity of the planter box (130 lbs) or the hanging crossbars.
- **Wood care:** Fir wood is a natural material. Regular maintenance, such as applying a water sealant, can prolong its lifespan and protect it from weather elements.
- **Splinter prevention:** The wood is smoothly finished, but always handle with care to avoid splinters.

5. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly typically requires one adult and basic hand tools (an Allen key is usually included). Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included user manual for detailed diagrams. The process involves assembling the planter box, attaching the lattice trellis panels, and securing the flat roof with crossbars.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out and compare them against the parts list in the separate user manual to ensure everything is present.
2. **Assemble the Planter Box:** Connect the side panels of the planter box using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are secure. The bottom panels are detachable for cultivating deep-rooted plants and promoting drainage.
3. **Attach Trellis Panels:** Secure the lattice trellis panels to the back of the planter box using the reinforced metal brackets and screws. Ensure the trellis is upright and stable.
4. **Install Flat Roof and Crossbars:** Attach the flat roof structure to the top of the trellis. Install the crossbars, which provide support for hanging items.
5. **Final Check:** Once assembled, gently shake the structure to ensure all connections are tight and the garden bed is stable.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This raised garden bed is designed for versatile planting and decoration.

- **Filling the Planter Box:** Fill the planter box with appropriate potting soil. The 4.8 cubic feet capacity provides ample space for various plants. If planting directly with loose soil, consider adding a liner to prevent soil from escaping through the bottom slats.
- **Planting:** Plant your desired vegetables, herbs, fruits, or flowers. The deep soil area supports healthy root growth.
- **Utilizing the Trellis:** The lattice trellis provides vertical support for climbing plants such as vines, roses, morning glories, and tomatoes. Guide young plants to grow along the trellis for optimal support and display.

- **Drainage:** The planter box features drainage holes and a detachable bottom to promote optimal water drainage and aeration, preventing root rot and ensuring a healthy growing environment.

7. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your garden bed.

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe down the wooden surfaces with a damp cloth to remove dirt and debris. Avoid harsh chemicals that could damage the wood finish.
- **Wood Protection:** The fir wood has a protective coating. To maintain its condition and protect against weathering, consider applying a wood sealant or stain annually, especially if exposed to harsh outdoor elements.
- **Drainage Check:** Periodically check the drainage holes to ensure they are not clogged with soil or roots. Clear any obstructions to maintain proper water flow.
- **Hardware Inspection:** Annually inspect all screws and connections for tightness. Tighten any loose hardware to ensure structural integrity.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Instability/Tipping:** If the garden bed feels unstable, especially when empty or in windy conditions, ensure it is placed on a level surface. For added security, it can be anchored to the ground or a

nearby structure. Filling the planter box with soil will also add significant weight and stability.

- **Poor Drainage:** If water is pooling in the planter box, check that the drainage holes are clear. Ensure the detachable bottom panels are correctly installed to allow water to pass through.
- **Wood Warping/Cracking:** Wood is a natural material and can react to environmental changes. Ensure proper maintenance with wood sealants to minimize warping or cracking due to moisture and sun exposure.
- **Missing/Damaged Parts:** If you encounter missing or damaged parts during assembly, refer to the contact information in the warranty section to request replacements.
