WARNING: Maximum load capacity for this cabinet is 300 lbs (136 kg). Do not exceed this weight.

- Assembly may require tools and caution. Always use appropriate safety gear.
- Ensure all connections are secure before use.
- To prevent tipping, especially in households with children, it is highly recommended to secure the cabinet to a wall using the provided anti-tip kit.
- Keep small parts and hardware away from children during assembly.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the ONBRILL Sideboard Buffet Cabinet requires patience and careful attention to the included visual manual. It is recommended to have a second person assist with certain steps.

- Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Identify each part using the labels and the visual manual.
- Assemble the Base:** Begin by connecting the base panels and legs as indicated in the instructions. The cabinet features 5 thickened legs for stability.
- Construct the Main Frame:** Attach the side panels, back panel, and top panel to form the main structure. Ensure all internal steel joints are securely fastened.
- Install Drawer Slides:** Mount the drawer slides to the cabinet frame according to the visual guide.
- Assemble Drawers:** Put together the two drawers, ensuring the upgraded rails are correctly installed for smooth operation.
- Install Doors:** Attach the three doors using the provided hinges. The knife-edge door paths are designed for smooth movement.
- Insert Adjustable Shelves:** Place the three adjustable shelves into the desired positions within the cabinet compartments.
- Attach Handles:** Securely fasten the handles to the drawers and doors.
- Secure with Anti-Tip Kit:** For safety, especially in homes with children, attach the anti-tip kit to the back of the cabinet and secure it to a wall stud.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your ONBRILL Sideboard Buffet Cabinet is designed for versatile storage.

- **Drawers:** The two top drawers operate on upgraded rails for smooth opening and closing. Pull the handles gently to access.
- **Doors:** The three cabinet doors feature knife-edge paths for smooth access. Open by pulling the handles. The doors are equipped with soft-close hinges for quiet operation.
- **Adjustable Shelves:** The three internal shelves can be adjusted to different heights in 2.5-inch increments to accommodate various item sizes. To adjust, remove the shelf, reposition the shelf pins to the desired holes, and reinsert the shelf.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your ONBRILL Sideboard Buffet Cabinet, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Clean spills immediately to prevent staining or damage to the engineered wood.
- **Sunlight:** Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight to prevent fading.
- **Heat and Moisture:** Keep the cabinet away from excessive heat and moisture sources. Use coasters under hot or wet items placed on the top surface.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Tighten if necessary.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your cabinet, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Wobbly Cabinet:** Ensure all cam locks and screws are fully tightened. Verify the cabinet is on a level surface. Adjust leg levelers if present.
- **Misaligned Doors/Drawers:** Hinges and drawer slides often have adjustment screws. Refer to the visual manual for specific instructions on how to adjust them to achieve proper alignment. Patience is key for fine-tuning.
- **Drawers Not Sliding Smoothly:** Check that the drawer slides are correctly installed and free of obstructions. Ensure all screws on the slides are tight.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts are missing or damaged upon arrival, contact customer support for prompt hardware replacement.
