INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the DUMOS GSN-Z6Y3 Countertop Ice Maker. This manual provides essential information for the safe operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new ice machine. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not touch the evaporator when the unit is in use.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or any part of the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Supervise children when the appliance is in use.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Contact customer service for assistance.
- Use only potable water in the ice maker.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, level surface.
- Keep at least 4 inches of clearance around the appliance for proper ventilation.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or when not in use.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The DUMOS GSN-Z6Y3 is a compact countertop ice maker designed for convenience and efficiency. It produces bullet-shaped ice cubes and features a portable handle, smart operation, and a self-cleaning function.

Key Features:

- **Fast Ice Making:** Produces 9 bullet-shaped ice cubes in 6-8 minutes, up to 26 lbs daily.
- **Portable Design:** Equipped with a sturdy built-in handle for easy transport.

- **Smart Operation:** Features a responsive touch panel and infrared sensors for low water/full basket reminders.
- **Self-Cleaning:** One-touch self-cleaning cycle (30 minutes).
- **Ice Sizes:** Offers two ice cube sizes: Large (0.94") and Small (0.75").
- **Quiet Operation:** Runs below 40dB.

SETUP

1. Unpacking and Placement

- Remove all packaging materials and tape.
- Place the ice maker on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Ensure there is at least 4 inches (10 cm) of space around the unit for proper ventilation.
- Allow the unit to rest for at least 2 hours before plugging it in, especially if it was tilted during transport. This allows the refrigerant to settle.

2. Initial Cleaning

Before first use, clean the ice maker thoroughly:

1. Open the lid and remove the ice basket.
2. Clean the interior with a soft cloth and warm water with a mild detergent.
3. Rinse the interior thoroughly with clean water.
4. Drain the water by removing the drain plug located at the bottom of the unit.
5. Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth.

3. Adding Water

- Ensure the drain plug is securely closed.
- Open the lid and remove the ice basket.
- Fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line. Do not overfill.
- Replace the ice basket and close the lid.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Powering On and Selecting Ice Size

1. Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. Press the **POWER** button to turn on the unit. The Power indicator will illuminate.
3. Press the **SELECT** button to choose your desired ice cube size: **S** (Small) or **L** (Large). The corresponding indicator light will illuminate.

2. Ice Production Cycle

- The ice maker will begin its first ice-making cycle approximately 6-8 minutes after startup.
- The ice cubes will be released into the ice basket.
- When the ice basket is full, the **ICE FULL** indicator will light up, and the unit will pause ice production. Remove ice to resume.
- When the water level is low, the **ADD WATER** indicator will light up. Add water to the reservoir to resume ice production.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

1. Self-Cleaning Function

The DUMOS GSN-Z6Y3 features a convenient self-cleaning cycle:

1. Ensure the unit is empty of ice and water.
2. Add clean water to the reservoir up to the MAX fill line.
3. Press and hold the **POWER** button for 5 seconds. The unit will enter a 30-minute self-cleaning cycle.
4. Once the cycle is complete, drain the water from the unit by removing the drain plug.
5. Wipe the interior dry with a clean cloth.

emphasizes pressing and holding the power button for 5 seconds to initiate a 30-minute auto-cycle, which helps remove limescale, ensures fresh ice, and maintains hygiene.

2. Regular Cleaning

- Clean the ice basket and scoop regularly with warm, soapy water.
- Wipe down the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth.
- For thorough cleaning, a solution of water and vinegar (10:1 ratio) can be used to clean the interior, followed by several rinses with clean water.
- Ensure all parts are dry before reassembling and using the ice maker.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not working / Power indicator off	No power supply	Check if the unit is plugged in correctly. Check the circuit breaker.
"ADD WATER" indicator on	Water reservoir is empty or low	Add potable water to the reservoir up to the MAX fill line.
"ICE FULL" indicator on	Ice basket is full	Remove ice from the basket.
Ice cubes are too small or not forming	Ambient temperature too high; Water temperature too high; Insufficient water	Ensure the unit is in a cool environment. Use cold water. Check water level.
Ice melts quickly in the basket	This is a common characteristic of countertop ice makers, which are not freezers.	Transfer ice to a freezer or insulated container immediately after production.
Unusual noise during operation	Normal operation sounds (compressor, water pump); Unit not level	Ensure the unit is on a level surface. If noise is excessive or unusual, contact support.
