Cord Lock System: A cord lock system is integrated to secure the power cord connection, preventing accidental disconnection during operation. This ensures continuous power supply and reduces the risk of interruptions or electrical hazards.

The EWORK Electric Dethatcher and Scarifier is a versatile 2-in-1 tool designed for comprehensive lawn maintenance. It features a powerful motor and adjustable settings to effectively remove thatch and aerate soil.

- **5-Position Depth Adjustment:** Allows precise control over working depth to suit various lawn conditions and seasonal needs.
- **9.2 Gallon Collection Bag:** Detachable bag efficiently gathers debris, minimizing manual cleanup.
- **User-Friendly Design:** Features smooth-rolling wheels for maneuverability, a foldable handle for compact storage, and tool-free operation for quick setup and mode switching.

Components

ASSEMBLY

The EWORK Electric Dethatcher and Scarifier is designed for quick and tool-free assembly.

Handle Assembly

1. Unfold the handle sections and align them with the main unit.
2. Secure the handle sections using the provided quick-lock knobs. Ensure all connections are tight.
3. Attach the cable clips to the handle to manage the power cord.

Grass Catcher Attachment

1. Assemble the grass catcher bag by inserting the frame into the fabric bag.
2. Hook the assembled grass catcher onto the rear of the main unit. Ensure it is securely attached to prevent detachment during operation.

OPERATION

Proper operation ensures effective lawn treatment and extends the life of your machine.

Selecting Dethatcher or Scarifier Mode

The machine comes with two interchangeable cylinders: one for dethatching and one for scarifying. To switch between modes:

1. Ensure the machine is unplugged from the power source.
2. Carefully turn the machine on its side to access the cylinder.
3. Utilize the tool-free quick swap mechanism to remove the currently installed cylinder.
4. Insert the desired cylinder (dethatcher or scarifier) and secure it in place.

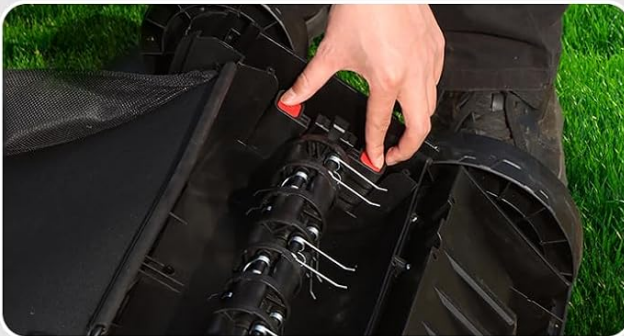

Figure 5: 2-in-1 Functionality. The machine allows for a tool-free quick swap between the dethatcher cylinder (for removing thatch) and the scarifier cylinder (for loosening soil).

Adjusting Working Depth

The machine features a 5-position depth adjustment lever to customize the working depth according to your lawn's condition and desired results.

1. Locate the depth adjustment lever on the side of the machine.
2. Move the lever to select one of the five available depth settings. Refer to the markings on the machine for specific depth indications.
3. Start with a higher setting for initial passes and adjust to a lower setting if more aggressive treatment is needed.

Starting and Operating the Machine

1. Connect the power cord to a suitable outdoor extension cord, ensuring the cord lock system is engaged.
2. To start, press and hold the safety button, then pull the bail switch lever towards the handle. Release the safety button once the motor starts.
3. Push the machine forward at a steady pace, overlapping slightly with each pass to ensure even coverage.
4. To stop the machine, release the bail switch lever.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your dethatcher and scarifier.

Emptying the Collection Bag

The 9.2 Gallon collection bag should be emptied regularly to maintain efficient debris collection and prevent clogging.

1. Turn off the machine and disconnect it from the power source.
2. Carefully detach the collection bag from the main unit.
3. Empty the collected thatch and debris into a suitable receptacle.
4. Reattach the bag securely before resuming operation.

Cylinder Replacement and Cleaning

Inspect the dethatcher tines and scarifier blades periodically for wear or damage. Replace cylinders as needed using the tool-free quick swap mechanism.

1. Always disconnect power before inspecting or replacing cylinders.
2. Remove the cylinder as described in the "Selecting Dethatcher or Scarifier Mode" section.
3. Clean any accumulated grass or debris from the cylinder and the housing area.
4. Install a new or cleaned cylinder.

Storage

After each use, clean the machine thoroughly. The foldable handle allows for compact storage in a dry, secure location.

Troubleshooting

This section addresses common issues you might encounter during operation.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start	Power cord not connected; Safety switch not engaged; Circuit breaker tripped.	Check power connection; Ensure dual safety start is correctly activated; Reset circuit breaker.
Machine stalls during operation	Cylinder clogged with debris; Operating depth too low for conditions; Overload.	Disconnect power and clear debris; Adjust to a higher depth setting; Reduce operating speed.
Ineffective thatch removal/scarifying	Incorrect depth setting; Worn tines/blades.	Adjust to a lower depth setting; Inspect and replace cylinder if tines/blades are worn.
Collection bag detaches or does not collect effectively	Bag not securely attached; Bag is full; Bag damaged.	Ensure bag is properly hooked; Empty the bag; Inspect bag for damage and replace if necessary.
