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## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the MERACH UltraWalk W60 Walking Pad Treadmill. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new fitness equipment. The UltraWalk W60 is designed to provide a convenient and effective walking and light jogging experience with features like auto incline, Bluetooth connectivity, and a compact design.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

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Before using the MERACH UltraWalk W60, please review the following safety precautions to prevent injury or damage to the equipment.

- Consult your physician before starting any new exercise program.
- Place the walking pad on a flat, stable surface with adequate clearance around it (at least 2 feet on all sides).
- Keep children and pets away from the equipment during operation.
- Ensure the power cord is not pinched or damaged. Do not use if the cord is damaged.
- Wear appropriate athletic footwear.
- Do not step on or off the walking belt while it is in motion.
- Use the safety key/clip (if included) at all times.
- Do not attempt to service the walking pad yourself. Contact customer support for assistance.
- Maximum user weight capacity is 400 lbs. Do not exceed this limit.
- Unplug the walking pad when not in use or before cleaning/maintenance.

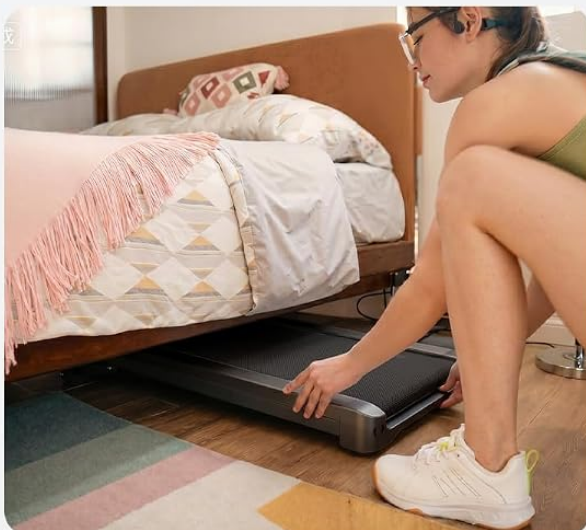

## 4. SETUP GUIDE

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The MERACH UltraWalk W60 is designed for minimal assembly. Follow these steps to prepare your walking pad for use.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the walking pad from its packaging. Place it on a flat, stable surface.
2. **Placement:** Ensure there is at least 2 feet of clear space behind and to the sides of the walking pad for safe operation.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into the walking pad's power port and then into a grounded electrical outlet.
4. **Remote Control:** The remote control is pre-paired. If not, refer to the troubleshooting section or the quick start guide for pairing instructions. The remote can be magnetically docked to the walking pad for convenient storage.
5. **App Connection:**
  - Download the MERACH App from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
  - Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device.
  - Open the MERACH App and follow the on-screen instructions to connect to your UltraWalk W60.

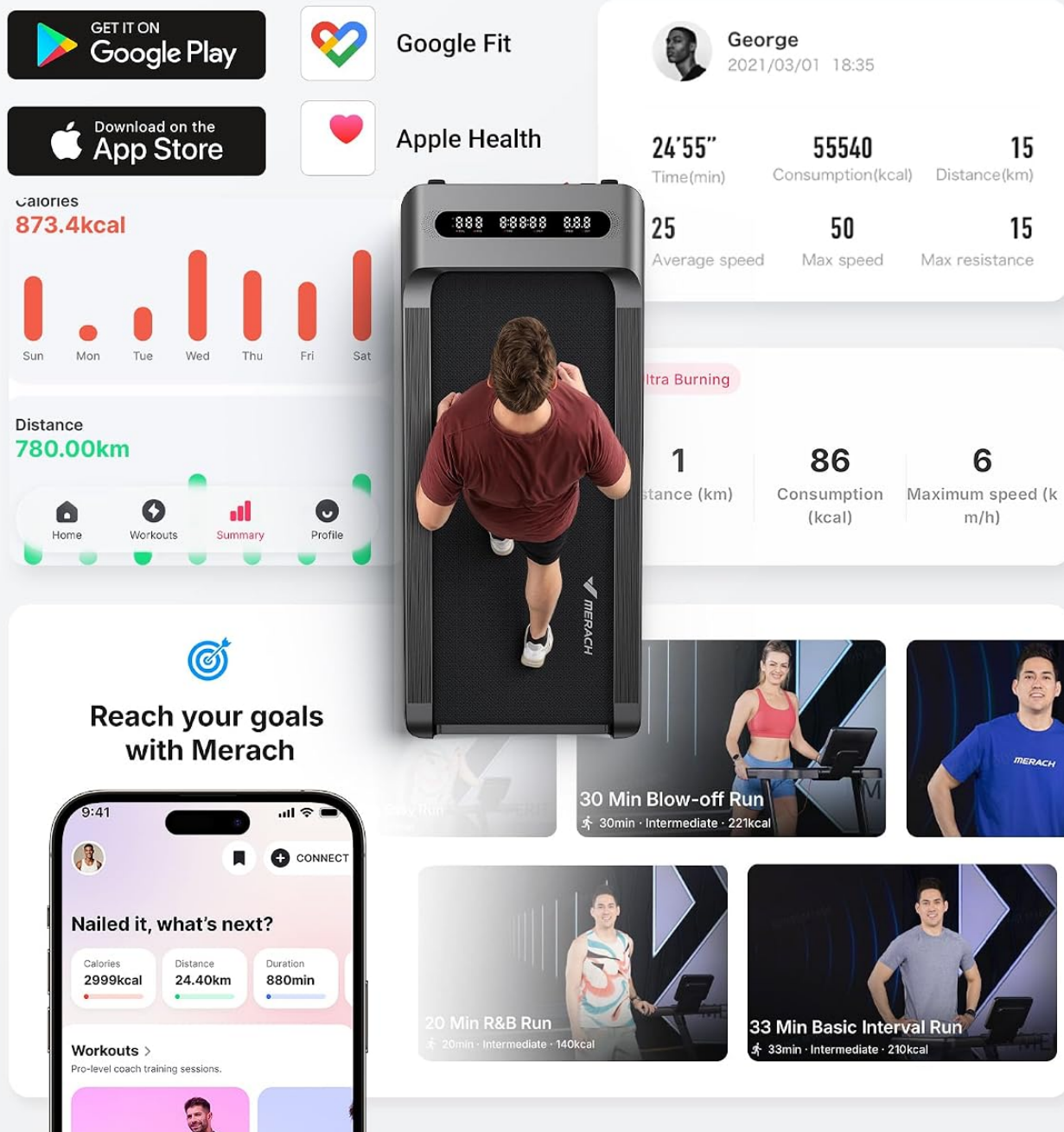


Image: The MERACH App interface, demonstrating workout tracking and smart control features.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the controls and features of your UltraWalk W60.

### 5.1 Basic Operation

- **Power On/Off:** Press the power button on the remote control or the walking pad to turn it on or off.
- **Start/Stop:** Press the Start/Stop button on the remote or app to begin or end a workout.

- **Speed Adjustment:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons on the remote or the app to adjust the walking speed. The speed range is typically 0.6 to 4.0 MPH.
- **Auto Incline:** The UltraWalk W60 features 12 levels of auto incline. Use the incline buttons on the remote or app to adjust the incline percentage (up to 12%).
- **Display:** The integrated LED display shows time, speed, distance, calories, steps, and incline level.

- **Bluetooth Speaker:** Connect your mobile device via Bluetooth to the walking pad's integrated speaker to enjoy music during your workout.
- **RGB Lighting:** The walking pad features RGB lighting for an enhanced user experience.
- **Child Lock:** For safety, the walking pad includes a child lock function. Refer to the app or quick start guide for

activation/deactivation.

| Belt slips or hesitates.           | Belt too loose, insufficient lubrication.                 | Adjust the walking belt tension (refer to manual for specific steps). Apply lubricant if needed.            |
| Remote control not responding.     | Low battery, remote not paired.                           | Replace remote control batteries. Re-pair the remote control (refer to quick start guide).                  |
| App cannot connect to walking pad. | Bluetooth off, app issue, walking pad not powered on.     | Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Restart the app and walking pad.                                |

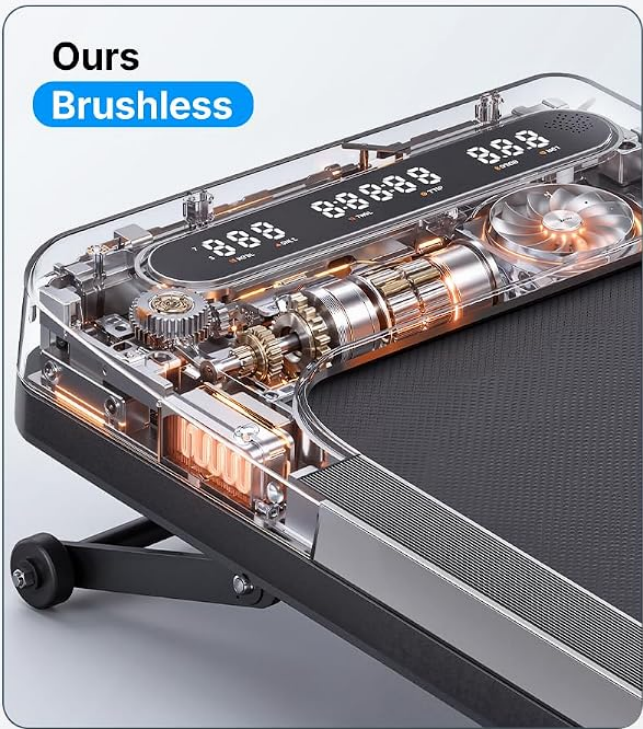

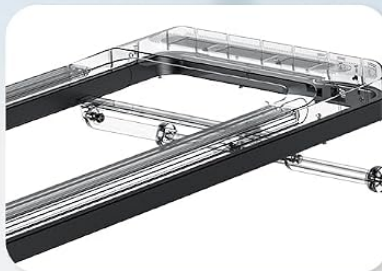
