1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your U-MAX 20'x 8' Lean-to Gazebo. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference. Proper installation and care will ensure the longevity and performance of your gazebo.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety during assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Two-Person Assembly:** Assembly requires at least two adults. Do not attempt to assemble alone.
- **Site Selection:** Choose a level, stable surface for installation. Ensure adequate clearance from power lines, trees, and other structures.
- **Wall Mounting:** This gazebo is designed to be wall-mounted. Ensure the wall structure is sound and capable of supporting the gazebo's weight and wind loads. Use appropriate fasteners for your specific wall material.
- **Anchoring:** Securely anchor the gazebo to both the wall and the ground as instructed to prevent wind uplift.
- **Weather Conditions:** While designed for snow and wind resistance, extreme weather conditions (e.g., severe storms, hurricanes, heavy snowfall exceeding 7 inches) may require additional precautions or temporary

disassembly.

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight and secure.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

The U-MAX Lean-to Gazebo is typically shipped in multiple parcels. Verify all components are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support.

TRIANGLE STRUCTURE



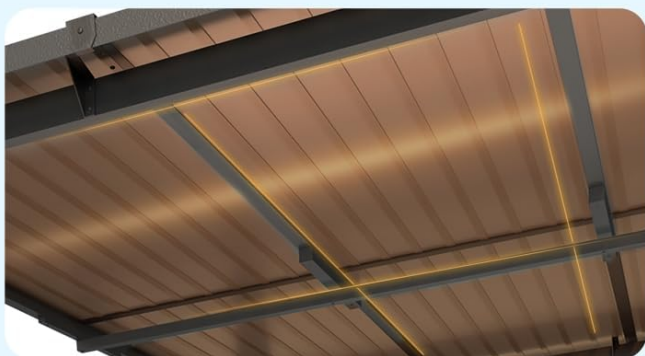
The triangular structure makes the hardtop gazebo much stable and sturdy.

4. SETUP (INSTALLATION)

Follow these steps for a successful and secure installation of your U-MAX Lean-to Gazebo. Refer to the detailed assembly diagrams provided in the separate assembly guide for visual assistance.

1. **Prepare the Site:** Clear the installation area of any debris. Ensure the ground is level and the wall where the gazebo will attach is structurally sound.
2. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all boxes and lay out the components, verifying against the parts list.
3. **Assemble Frame:** Begin by assembling the main aluminum frame according to the provided diagrams. The triangular structure and multi-frame support are designed for stability.
4. **Attach to Wall:** Position the gazebo frame against the chosen wall. Use the pre-drilled holes in the stable frame legs and metope fixed points to securely attach the gazebo to the wall. All necessary accessories for wall attachment are provided.
5. **Ground Anchoring:** Once attached to the wall, securely fix the gazebo's ground posts to the patio or deck surface using appropriate anchors. This step is critical for wind resistance.
6. **Install Roof Panels:** Carefully place and secure the polycarbonate roof panels onto the frame. Ensure all panels are properly seated and sealed to maintain waterproof performance.
7. **Final Inspection:** After assembly, perform a thorough inspection to ensure all connections are tight and the structure is stable.

5. OPERATING (USAGE)

Your U-MAX Lean-to Gazebo is designed to provide a comfortable and protected outdoor space.

- **Shade and UV Protection:** The polycarbonate roof panels offer comprehensive protection against harmful UV rays, blocking UPF 50+ and 99% UV.
- **Weather Resistance:** The inclined roof design and robust construction ensure waterproof performance and can withstand winds of approximately 70 mph. The hardtop roof is also capable of holding up to 7 inches of heavy snow (equivalent to 6 lbs/sq.ft).
- **Outdoor Living:** Utilize the 160 sq.ft covered area for dining, lounging, or other outdoor activities.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and structural integrity of your gazebo.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the frame and roof panels periodically with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish or polycarbonate. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- **Fastener Check:** Annually, or after severe weather, inspect all bolts, screws, and anchors. Tighten any loose fasteners to ensure continued stability.
- **Snow Removal:** While the roof is designed to handle 7 inches of snow, it is recommended to remove excessive snow accumulation to prevent undue stress on the structure, especially during prolonged periods of heavy snowfall.
- **Drainage:** Ensure the inclined roof's drainage paths remain clear of leaves and debris to maintain waterproof performance.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gazebo feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose fasteners; inadequate ground anchoring; improper wall attachment.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure ground anchors are fully secured. Verify wall attachment points are firm.
Water leakage from the roof.	Roof panels not properly seated or sealed; debris blocking drainage.	Inspect roof panels for proper installation and sealing. Clear any debris from the roof and drainage channels.
Difficulty during assembly.	Incorrect part orientation; missing hardware; unclear instructions.	Review the assembly guide carefully. Ensure parts are oriented correctly. Contact customer support for missing parts or clarification.

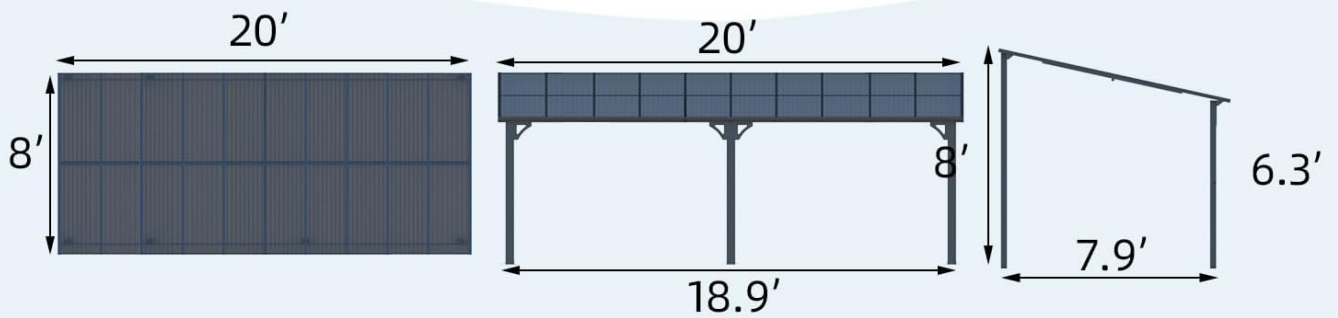


Image 8.1: Dimensional overview of the U-MAX 20'x 8' Lean-to Gazebo.
