1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the YOMILUVE 55 Inch Computer Desk. This desk is designed to provide a functional and organized workspace for your home office, study, or bedroom. It features a spacious desktop, ten storage drawers, and a built-in charging station with AC outlets, USB, and Type-C ports. This manual provides detailed instructions for assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure safe and efficient use of your new desk.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Assembly:** Assemble the desk on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Ensure all parts are present and undamaged before beginning assembly. Do not overtighten screws.
- **Stability:** Ensure the desk is placed on a level surface. Do not stand or sit on the desk.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not overload the desktop or drawers. Refer to specifications for maximum weight limits (if available, otherwise general caution).
- **Electrical Safety:** The built-in power strip is rated for 125V/12A. Do not exceed these limits. Use only with compatible devices. Keep liquids away from the power strip.
- **Children:** Keep small parts and packaging materials away from children. This product is not a toy.
- **Maintenance:** Regularly check all fasteners to ensure they remain tight.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all components are included and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Side Panels (for drawer cabinets)
- Back Panels
- Drawer Fronts, Sides, and Bottoms (10 sets)

- Drawer Slides (20 pairs)
- Built-in Power Strip (with 2 AC outlets, 1 USB, 1 Type-C port)
- Assembly Hardware (screws, dowels, cam locks, etc.)
- Assembly Tools (e.g., Allen wrench, screwdriver - may not be included, user typically provides)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly typically requires two people and approximately 1-2 hours. Follow the numbered steps provided in the included detailed instruction booklet. All parts are clearly marked for easy identification.

4.1 Preparation

- Clear a spacious area for assembly.
- Lay out all components and hardware.
- Gather necessary tools (e.g., Phillips head screwdriver, hammer).

4.2 Step-by-Step Assembly Overview

1. **Assemble Drawer Cabinets:** Begin by assembling the two drawer cabinet units. Attach side panels to the base and top panels using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are secure.
2. **Install Drawer Slides:** Attach the drawer slides to the interior sides of the assembled cabinets. Pay attention to the orientation of the slides (left/right, front/back).
3. **Assemble Drawers:** Construct each of the ten drawers by attaching the front, back, and side panels to the drawer bottom. Install the remaining drawer slide components onto the sides of each drawer.
4. **Insert Drawers:** Carefully slide the assembled drawers into their respective cabinet slots. Test each drawer for smooth operation.
5. **Attach Desktop:** Place the main desktop panel onto the assembled drawer cabinets. Secure the desktop to the cabinets using the designated fasteners from underneath.
6. **Install Power Strip:** Integrate the built-in power strip into the pre-cut opening on the desktop. Connect the power cord and ensure it is securely seated.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Using the Drawers

The desk features ten deep drawers, five on each side, designed for organizing various office essentials, files, books, and personal items. To open a drawer, gently pull the integrated handle. To close, push the drawer firmly until it is fully seated within the cabinet.

5.2 Using the Built-in Charging Station

The integrated power strip provides convenient access to power for your electronic devices. It includes:

- 2 AC Outlets (125V/12A)
- 1 USB Port (5V/2A)
- 1 Type-C Port (5V/2A)

To use, plug the desk's main power cord into a wall outlet. Then, plug your devices into the appropriate ports on the power strip. Ensure devices are compatible with the provided voltage and current ratings.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

The desk is made of engineered wood, which is resistant to scratches, stains, and wear. To clean, wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the finish. Promptly wipe up any spills.

6.2 General Care

- Avoid placing hot items directly on the surface; use coasters or protective pads.
- Keep the desk away from direct sunlight and extreme temperature changes to prevent warping or fading.
- Periodically check all screws and fasteners and tighten them if necessary to maintain stability.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during assembly or use, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Parts do not align during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts; pre-drilled holes misalignment; overtightened fasteners.	Review the instruction manual carefully for correct part orientation. Loosen fasteners, realign parts, then retighten. If holes are significantly misaligned, contact customer support.
Drawers do not slide smoothly or get stuck.	Drawer slides installed incorrectly; debris in slides; drawer not assembled squarely.	Ensure drawer slides are installed correctly and are free of obstructions. Check that the drawer box is assembled squarely. Apply a silicone-based lubricant to the slides if needed.
Power strip not working.	Desk power cord not plugged in; wall outlet not functional; overloaded circuit.	Verify the desk's power cord is securely plugged into a working wall outlet. Test the wall outlet with another device. Ensure the total power draw of connected devices does not exceed 125V/12A.
Desk feels wobbly.	Loose fasteners; uneven floor.	Tighten all assembly screws. Ensure the desk is on a level surface; use furniture glides or shims if necessary to stabilize.
