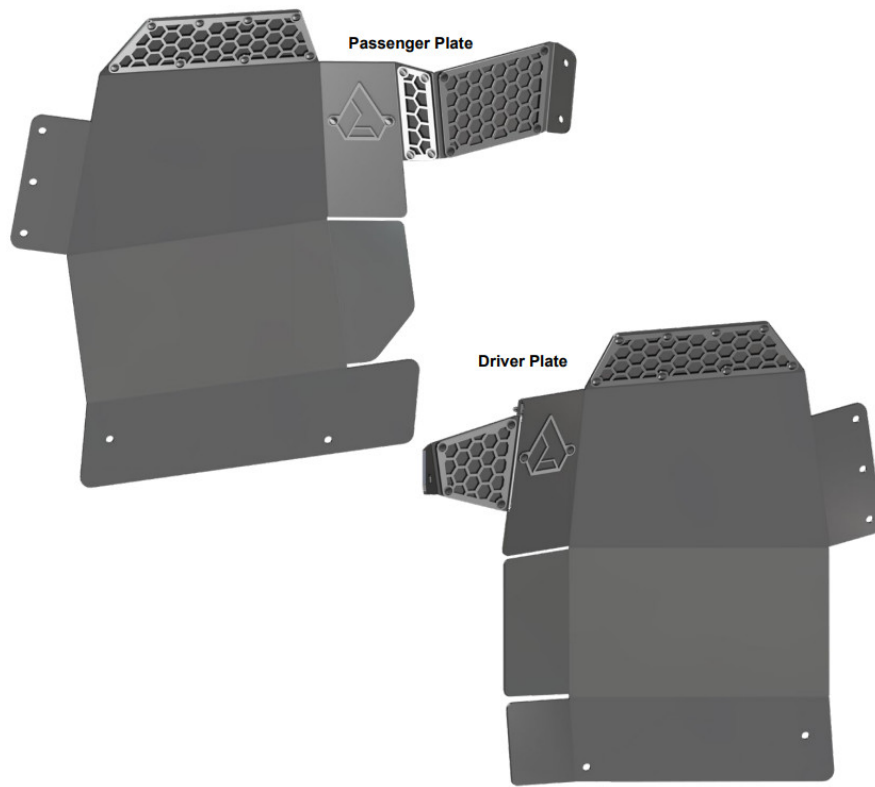

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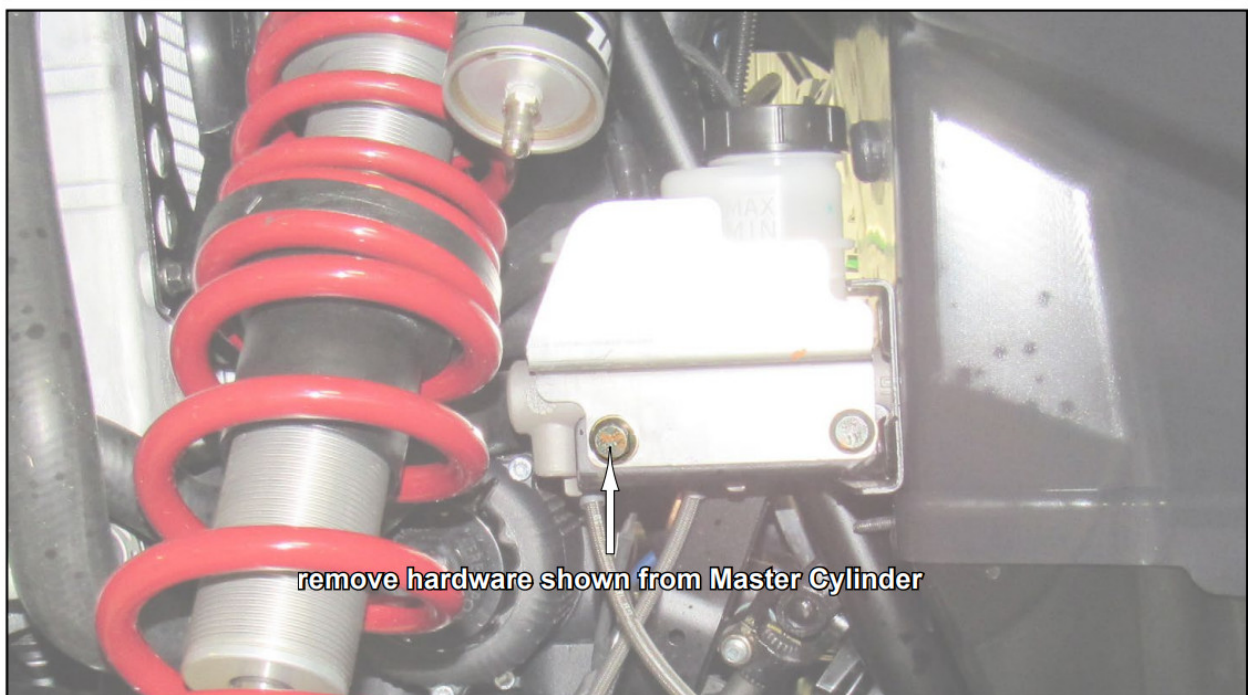
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Machines with SuperATV Full Skid Plates must remove Splash Guards; will not be reinstalled .



– Secure Driver Plate to Master Cylinder and Frame with hardware shown; tighten.

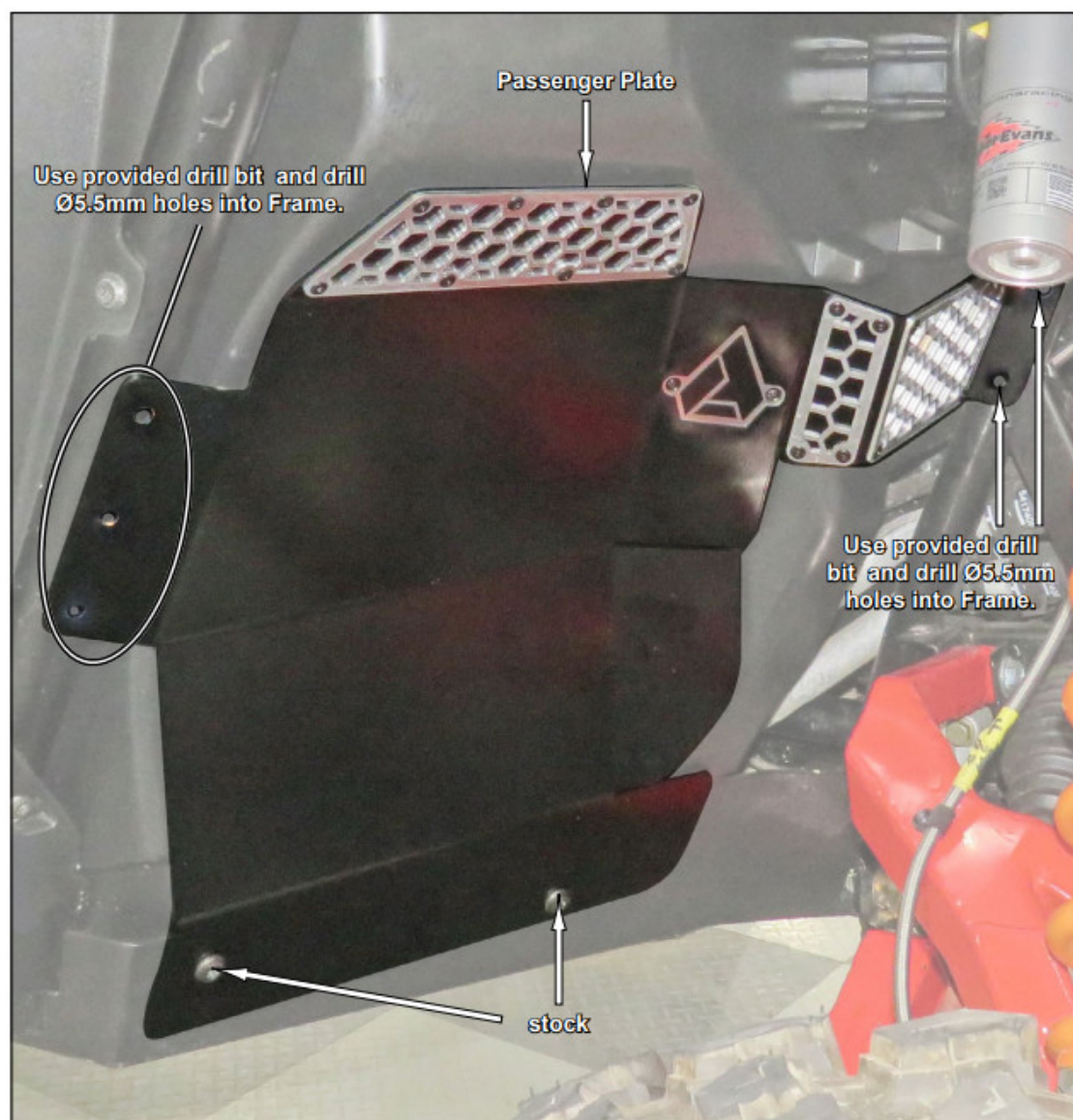
- Drill holes into Frame.



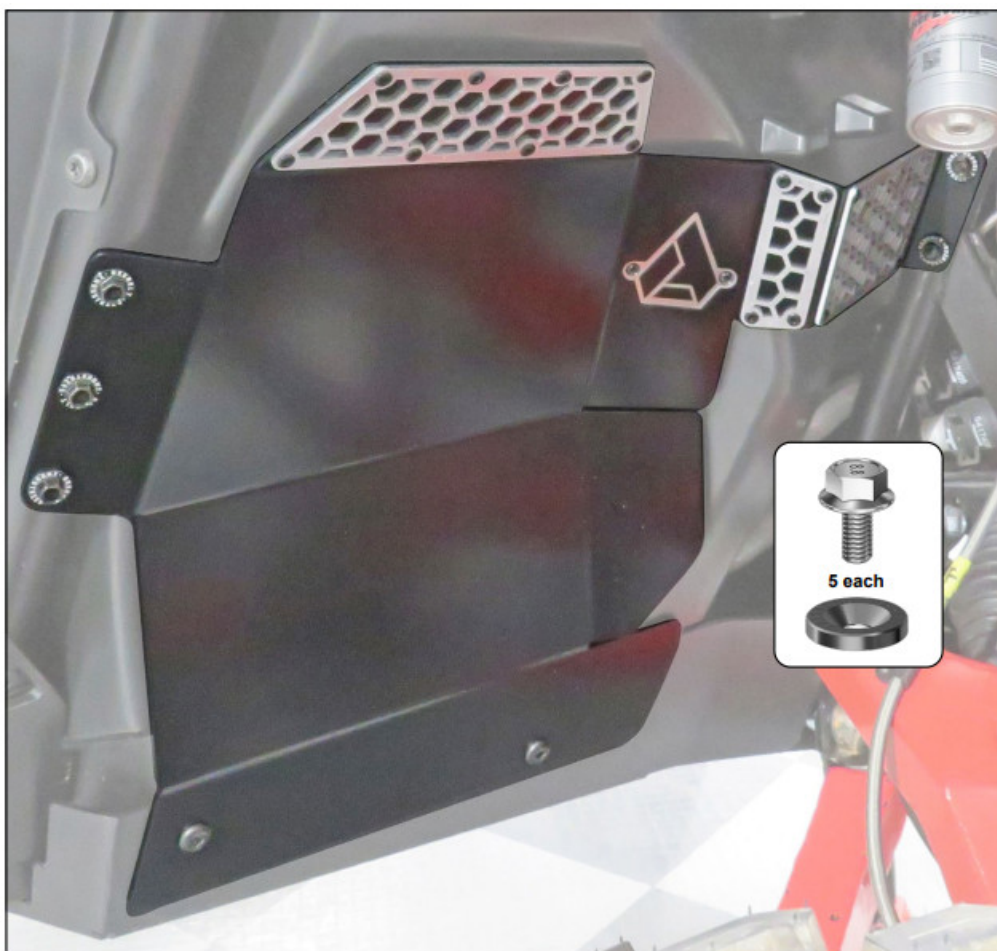
- Secure Driver Plate with hardware shown; tighten.
