Simple instructions

The headset is on/off:

- 1. Power on: open the cover charge storehouse, remove the headset, automatically switches on.
- 2. Turn off: charging directly into the warehouse to turn it off.

Pairing:

Automatic pairing is performed when the device is powered on. After the pairing is successful, a beep tone is displayed

(**Note:** If there is no pairing, you need to put it back into the charging bay, close the cover, and then open the cover, hear the "beep" pairing success.)

S & Andro ID systems connect the headset:

• Open the phone "Settings" – turn on the Bluetooth search – find the "DW39" pairing name, click Connect – display"Connected". When the phone connection is completed once, use the first point again, and the ear will automatically connect with the phone.

Call rejection	Press and hold either side for 2 seconds when an incoming call is placed

Play \ pause	Touch either side 1 time		
Previous song	Touch left ear 2 times		
Next song	Touch right ear 2 times		
Add volume	Touch left ear 3 times		
Reduce the volume	Touch right ear 3 times		

Voice assistant

Apple system	Wake up sirl': Press and hold any edge for 2 seconds	
Android system	Support to wake up the voice assistant, long press any edge for 2 seconds
