Product Usage Instructions

Connect tablet to Wi-Fi:

On the device home screen, tap Settings > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi. Slide the Wi-Fi switch to ON.

Connect carside device:

Ensure your asTech app and Link have the most recent software update.

Login to asTech App:

1. Connect to the car and click Remote Diagnostic Mode.
2. Select WLAN.
3. Select your Wi-Fi network.
4. Login and connect to your Wi-Fi network.
5. Once the screen shows with 2 blue checks, you are ready to go!

Start New Request:

On your tablet, tap the center blue asTech button to open the app and log in using your credentials. You can now select your vehicle and click New Request.

FAQ

Q: How do I ensure my asTech app and Link have the most recent software update?

A: To update your asTech app and Link, check for updates in the respective app stores or contact customer support for assistance.

Q: What should I do if I encounter connectivity issues during the login process?

A: Make sure you are within range of a stable Wi-Fi connection and verify that the correct Wi-Fi network is selected on both the tablet and carside device. If issues persist, restart both devices and try the login process again.


Connect tablet to Wi-Fi



On the device home screen, tap Settings > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi. Slide the Wi-Fi switch to ON.


