Product Usage Instructions

Connect Tablet to Wi-Fi

1. On the device home screen, tap Settings > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi.

2. Slide the Wi-Fi switch to ON.

Connect Carside Device

Ensure your asTech app and Link have the most recent software update.

Login to asTech App

- 1. Ensure the car is in the Key-ON, Engine-OFF state.
- 2. Plug in the asTech LINK.
- 3. Select Remote Diagnostics.
- 4. Select WLAN.
- 5. Select Connect.

Start New Request

- On your tablet, tap the center blue asTech button to open the app and log in using your credentials.
- You can now select your vehicle and click New Request.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: What should I do if I encounter connectivity issues?

• A: If you encounter connectivity issues, make sure your tablet is connected to Wi-Fi and that the car side device is properly connected with the most recent software updates for the asTech app and Link.

Q: How do I troubleshoot if the app is not responding?


- A: If the app is not responding, try restarting the app or restarting the tablet.
- Ensure that all connections are secure and that the software is up to date.

Connect the tablet to Wi-Fi



- On the device home screen, tap Settings > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi. Slide Wi-Fi switch to ON.
- All-In-One tablet VCI Link
- Ensure your asTech app and Link have the most recent software update.


Connect carside device



- 1. Ensure the car is in the Key-ON, Engine-OFF state.
- 2. Plug in the asTech LINK.
- 3. Select Remote Diagnostics.
- 4. Select WLAN.

5. Select Connect.
