Product overview

Gravio Zigbee Dongle Gen2 is a wireless command transmitter based on the zigbee protocol. It can interact with the wireless sensor in hex code based on the serial protocol and issue commands. This device supports operating systems such as windows10/mac/linux. Gravio Zigbee Dongle Gen2 adopts usb forward and reverse insertion design, and can be inserted into the usb interface on either side for normal use. You can send and receive information by using serial port software such as sscom. Complete the instructions.



Gravio Zigbee Dongle Gen2 is based on the certification-free protocol of organizations such as whql. It can be used without driver on windows10/mac/linux, just plug in the usb-A interface.




After inserting the device, windows10 will automatically load the driver and open the hardware manager. This interface appears. This means your device is ready to go.

Instructions for use

First open the serial debugging assistant, such as sscom, set the baud rate to 115200, open the serial port after 8N1. Send the command in hex:

• send: 00 00 01 00 00 AA

• receive: 00 01 01 08 02 00 03 AA



Scan to build a zigbee network

• send: 00 00 03 00 00 AA

• receive: 00 01 03 08 01 00 AA Read current network information

• send: 00 00 04 00 00 AA

 receive: 00 01 04 08 0E 36 3F 32 FE FF 9F FD 90 01 01 C0 76 0F 13 AA Open to allow devices to access the network

• send: 00 00 10 00 01 FF AA >> receive: 00 01 10 08 01 00 AA



Wireless Mini Switch



• press : 00 38 01 18 11 09 67 B0 02 00 8D 15 00 01 12 00 01 55 00 →21 01 00 AA

• long press : 00 39 01 18 11 09 67 B0 02 00 8D 15 00 01 12 00 01 55 00 21 10 \rightarrow 00 AA

• Long press release : 00 3A 01 18 11 09 67 B0 02 00 8D 15 00 01 12 00 01 55 00 21 11 \rightarrow 00 AA

Temperature and Humidity Sensor



This temperature and humidity sensor supports reporting temperature values, relative humidity, and atmospheric pressure, so there are three types of reported data:

• send: 00 40 01 18 11 6F FA 3C 02 00 8D 15 00 01 02 04 01 00 00 29 BD 0A AA

• send: 00 41 01 18 11 6F FA 3C 02 00 8D 15 00 01 05 04 01 00 00 21 02 22 AA

• send: 00 42 01 18 1A 6F FA 3C 02 00 8D 15 00 01 03 04 03 00 00 29 F2 03 14 →00 28 FF 10 00 29 7D 27 AA

Temperature and Humidity Sensor

(model: WSDCGQ01LM)



• send: 00 5A 01 18 11 06 AF 39 02 00 8D 15 00 01 02 04 01 00 00 29 B3 0A AA

• send: 00 5B 01 18 11 06 AF 39 02 00 8D 15 00 01 05 04 01 00 00 21 3C 21 AA

Door and Window Sensor (model: MCCGQ11LM)



• near send: 00 33 01 18 10 F9 68 04 02 00 8D 15 00 01 06 00 01 00 00 10 00 AA

• far away: 00 34 01 18 10 F9 68 04 02 00 8D 15 00 01 06 00 01 00 00 10 01 AA static post



There are three types of data reported by the static post, as follows:

• send data : 00 7A 01 18 15 FB 3B B2 02 00 8D 15 00 01 01 01 01 08 05 25 8A FF \rightarrow 1A 04 F9 00 AA

• send data: 00 7C 01 18 16 FB 3B B2 02 00 8D 15 00 01 01 02 55 00 21 02 00 →03 05 21 06 00 AA

• send data : 00 7E 01 18 11 FB 3B B2 02 00 8D 15 00 01 01 01 05 500 21 01 00 \rightarrow AA
