Installing the batteries

- 1. Insert the batteries (one AAA battery for keyboard and one AA battery for mouse) into the battery slots of your keyboard and mouse.
- 2. Insert the bundled USB dongle into your computer's USB port. It takes about ten seconds for the system to automatically connect to your wireless keyboard and mouse. Your keyboard and mouse is set at the factory to automatically connect to the system. You do not need to press the Connect button on your keyboard and mouse to manually connect to the system.

FAQ

· Can I connect the keyboard and mouse to multiple devices?

The keyboard and mouse can only be connected to one device at a time.

· What is the operating temperature range for the keyboard and mouse?

The operating temperature range is not specified in the user manual.

· Can I use rechargeable batteries with the keyboard and mouse?

Yes, you can use rechargeable batteries as long as they meet the required voltage and size specifications (AAA for keyboard, AA for mouse).




1. Insert the batteries (one AAA battery for keyboard and one AA battery for mouse) into the battery slots of your keyboard and mouse.

- Please replace the battery when the low battery indicator flashes red.
- 2. Insert the bundled USB dongle into your computer's USB port. It takes about ten seconds for the system to automatically connect to your wireless keyboard and mouse.

Your keyboard and mouse is set at the factory to automatically connect to the system. You do not need to press the Connect button on your keyboard and mouse to manually connect to the system.
