august ASL-08 iO Smart Lock



Product Information

The product is the August Smart Lock iO Model: ASL 08. It is a smart lock device that allows users to control and monitor their door locks remotely using the August HomeTM app.

The product dimensions are as follows:

Front: 58mmBack: 132mmWidth: 70mmHeight: 174mm

The product complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules and Industry Canada licence-exempt RSS standard(s). It is designed to not cause harmful interference and to accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.


- The product's FCC ID is 2AB6U ASL08 and its IC ID is 12163A ASL08.
- The product comes with a caution that any changes or modifications not approved by the responsible party may void the user's authority to operate the equipment.
- The product also includes a battery, and it is important to follow the battery safety instructions provided to avoid explosions or leakage of flammable liquid or gas.
- The product complies with FCC and Canada radiation exposure limits and should be installed and operated with a minimum distance of 20cm between the radiator and the user's body. It should not be co-located or operated with any other antenna or transmitter.

Product Usage Instructions

- 1. Download the August HomeTM app from your app store to begin the setup process.
- 2. If you are already an August user, open the August HomeTM app and select "Set Up Device" from the menu.
- 3. In the app, scan the QR code provided when prompted.
