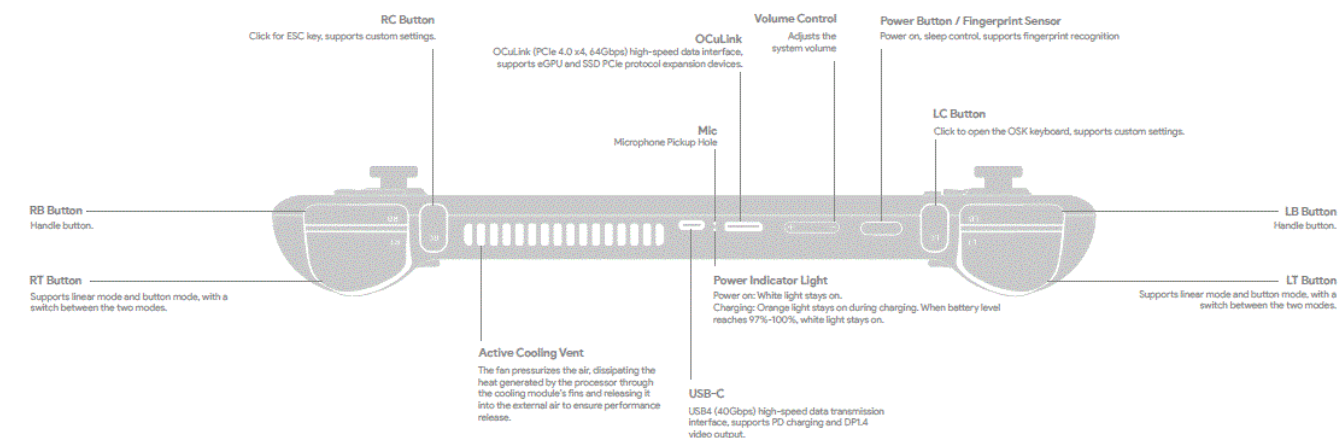

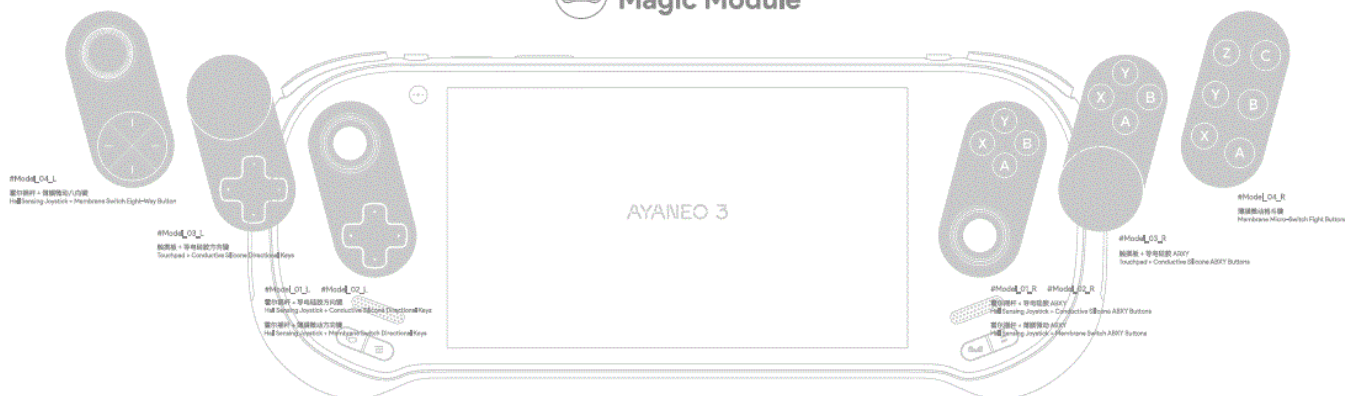
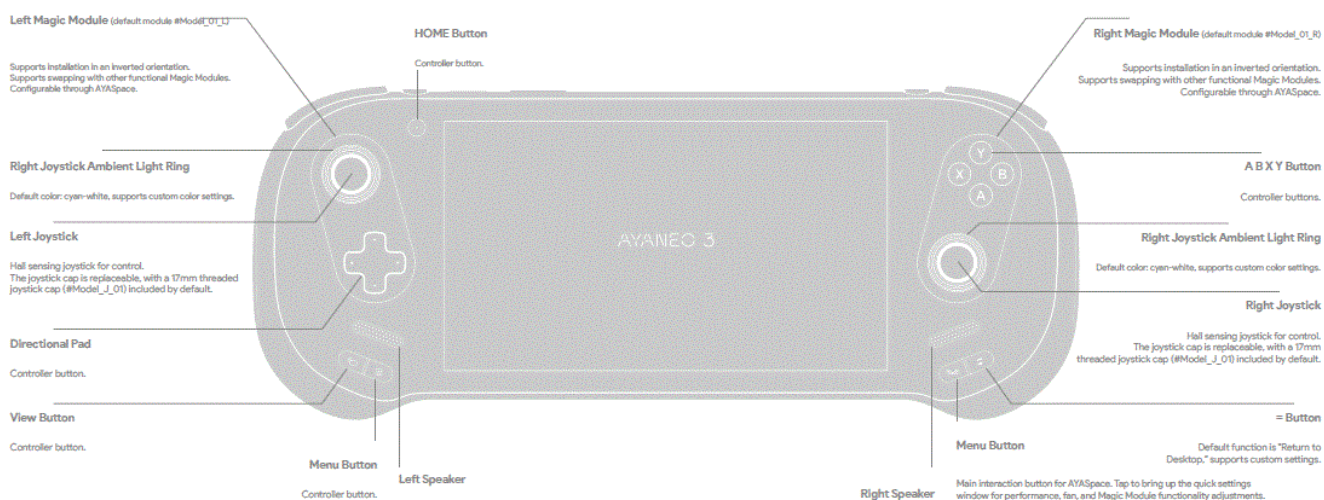
Specifications

- Dimensions: 278x109mm
- RC Button: Click for ESC key, supports custom settings.
- OCuLink: PCIe 4.0 x4, 64Gbps high-speed data interface, supports eGPU and SSD PCIe protocol expansion devices.
- Volume Control: Adjusts the system volume.
- Mic: Microphone Pickup Hole
- Power Button / Fingerprint Sensor: Power on, sleep control, supports fingerprint recognition.
- LC Button: Click to open the OSK keyboard, supports custom settings.
- RB Button: Handle button.
- RT Button: Supports linear mode and button mode, with a switch between the two modes.
- Active Cooling Vent: Ensures performance release by dissipating heat generated by the processor.
- Power Indicator Light: White light for power on, orange light for charging, white light for battery level reaching 97%-100%.
- USB-C: USB4 (40Gbps) high-speed data transmission interface, supports PD charging and DP1.4 video output.
- LB Button: Handle button.
- LT Button: Supports linear mode and button mode, with a switch between the two modes.
- Left Magic Module: Supports installation in an inverted orientation, configurable through AYASpace.
- HOME Button: Controller button.
- Right Magic Module: Supports installation in an inverted orientation, configurable through AYASpace.
- A B X Y Button: Controller buttons.
- Control Mode / Module Status Indicator Light: Controller Mode -White light, Keyboard-Mouse Mode – Blue light, Module Status – Red light flashes in case of error.
- Control Mode Switch Button: Tap to switch between controller mode and keyboard-mouse mode. Press and hold to unlock and eject both Magic Modules simultaneously.
- Dust Cover / Micro SD Card Slot: Supports installation and replacement of Micro SD memory cards.
- 3.5mm Headphone Jack: CTIA protocol, compatible with MIC extension.

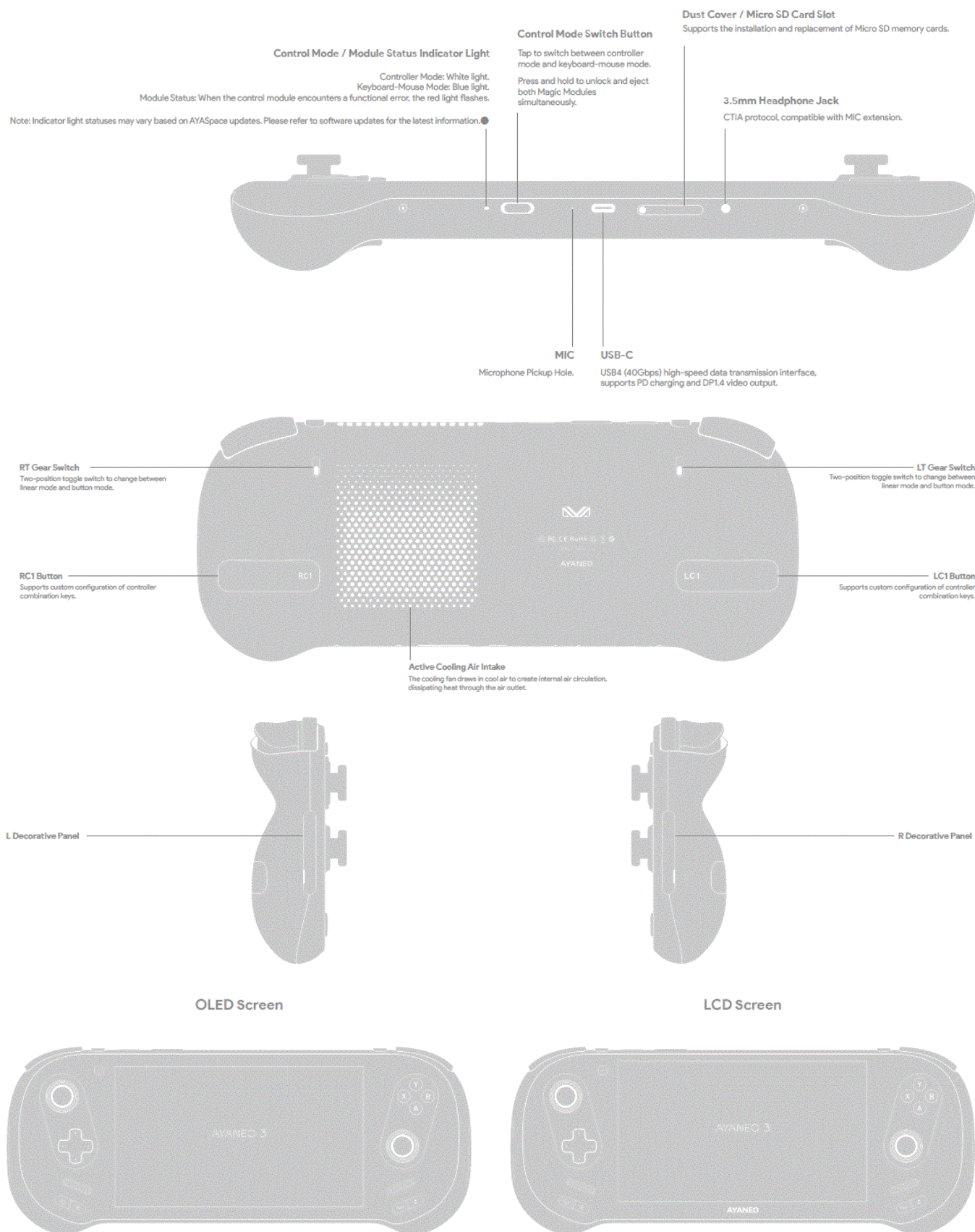






INSTRCUTIONSN FOR USE

Power On / Off / Restart




- **Power On**

When the device is off, press and hold the power button "" for about 2 seconds, then release it to start AYANEO 3.

- **Power Off**

When the device is on, click "" > a menu will appear, click "" > select " Shut down "↑ to shut down AYANEO 3.




Restart

Click "" in the window > a menu will appear, click "" > select " Restart "↑ to restart.


Note: When the device is on, pressing and holding the power button for about 8 seconds will forcefully shut down AYANEO 3. This operation is not recommended for normal use, as it may risk data corruption.

Sleep / Wake

- **Sleep**

Click "" in the window > a menu will appear, click "" > select " Sleep"↑ " to put AYANEO 3 to sleep.



- **Wake**

When in sleep mode, press the power button "" to wake up AYANEO 3. If fingerprint security login is configured in Windows Hello, after the screen lights up, gently touch the power button for fingerprint recognition to enter the OS interface without needing to input a PIN or password. Depending on the interface and scenario, it may take 1–3 seconds to complete the screen wake-up process, depending on the impact of background processes during sleep mode.




- **Fingerprint**

The power button integrates a fingerprint recognition function. After logging into a Microsoft account or setting up a local account with a password, enable Windows Hello biometric recognition to set up and use the fingerprint function.

- **Volume Adjustment**

Press the volume up button “  ” to gradually increase the volume, and press the volume down button “  ” to gradually decrease the volume. Press and hold the volume button to continuously increase or decrease the volume.

Quick Settings Menu

Click the “    ” area at the bottom-right corner of the Windows 11 desktop to open the quick settings menu, where you can manage WLAN network connections, configure Bluetooth settings, enable flight mode, adjust screen brightness, volume, and more.




Note: The attached image is for reference only. Please refer to the actual Windows system update for specific function settings.

CONNECTION


Network Connection

To connect to a WLAN network, click the “  ” area in the quick settings

menu > “  ” to enter the WLAN connection management interface. Select the desired network name > enter the corresponding network security key, and then connect to the network.

Bluetooth Connection

To connect a Bluetooth device, click the “  ” area in the quick settings

menu > “  ” to enter the Bluetooth device management interface. Under “New Devices,” find the device you want to connect to and follow the on-screen instructions to connect.

Brightness Adjustment



Slide the brightness slider in the quick settings menu to adjust the screen brightness.




Touch Keyboard / Text Input

Touch Keyboard Settings

On the Windows 11 desktop, long press the taskbar at the bottom of the screen, select “

“  Taskbar settings↑ ” from the pop-up menu to enter taskbar settings, and set the touch keyboard “  ” displaying it in the system tray at the bottom-right corner of the taskbar.

Text Input

When text input is needed, click the “  ” in the system tray to bring up the touch keyboard and use touch input to enter text.



Storage Expansion

The AYANEO 3 is equipped with a Micro SD card expansion slot. Press the " " on the slot to open the dust " " cover, allowing you to install or replace the Micro SD card.

Magic Module

AYANEO 3 Supports Magic Module Combinations with Classic Layout, Fighting, and Touch Functions.

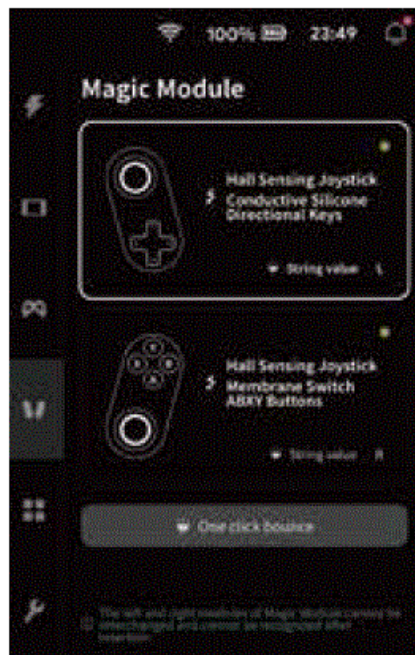
- **Module Types:** The Magic Modules are divided into left and right modules and cannot be swapped between sides.
- **Reversible Installation:** Modules support 180° rotation for single-side installation (the six-button module on the right side of the fighting module does not support upside-down installation).
- **Module Combinations:** Modules can be combined as needed. For example, you can install a classic directional pad and joystick module on the left and a touch module on the right (the touch module needs to be purchased separately).
- **ABXY Interchangeability:** The interchangeability function is only supported by modules containing ABXY buttons. The button caps can be removed and reattached using the included keycap puller. Adjust the positions of the ABXY buttons as needed. When the module is installed in a 180° reversed orientation, the A/Y and B/X button positions must be swapped accordingly.

Magic Module is managed and interacted with through AYASpace, which identifies the type of installed modules and provides corresponding function configurations.

- **Module Unlocking:** Before unlocking the modules, ensure the AYANEO 3 is placed horizontally. Short press the AYA button in the bottom-right corner of the device to

open the AYASpace quick settings window, allowing you to quickly unlock and replace Magic Modules. You can unlock both modules simultaneously with one click or unlock a single module. Alternatively, long press the mode switch button at the bottom of the device to quickly unlock and eject the Magic Modules.

- **Module Installation:** To install a new module, unlock and remove the existing module, place the new module into the corresponding slot, and press it down. The module will lock automatically once properly installed.



Note: The pre-installed Magic Module features a classic layout with a hall joystick and conductive silicone trigger buttons (#Model_01_L / R). Other combinations, such as the hall-effect joystick with thin-film microswitch buttons, the six-button fighting module, and the touchpad module, must be purchased separately. The management and functional configurations of Magic Modules may vary with updates to AYASpace versions. Please refer to the actual situation for details.

Important Notes

Operating System

The AYANEO 3 operates on Windows 11 64-bit Home Edition from Microsoft, and basic operations of Windows can be performed via the touchscreen.

Magic Module

- The AYANEO 3 Magic Module supports flexible combinations. Modules are categorized as left and right types, which are not interchangeable. Single-side modules support 180° reversible installation (the six-button module on the right side of the fighting module does not support reversible installation).
- Magic Modules are configured, managed, and interacted with through AYASpace. For the latest features and updates, please refer to the AYASpace version iterations.
- Magic Modules are ejected via a motorized unlocking mechanism. When unlocking and replacing a module, ensure the AYANEO 3 is placed horizontally. Operating at improper angles may cause the module to drop and result in damage.
- AYANEO 3 requires both left and right slots to be correctly fitted with Magic Modules for the controller functions to operate properly. Installing only a single module will disable the controller functions.

Charging Instructions

Please use the included adapter and USB-C cable for charging. Do not use uncertified adapters for charging, as this may damage internal components and pose unpredictable risks.

Battery Replacement Warning

Do not attempt to replace the AYANEO 3 battery yourself, as you may damage the battery, leading to overheating, fire, or personal injury risks. The lithium-ion battery in the AYANEO 3 should only be serviced or recycled by AYANEO. It must be recycled separately from household waste, in accordance with local environmental regulations. The battery can only be replaced by AYANEO or authorized service providers. Replacing the battery with an incorrect model could result in an explosion risk.

Heat and Noise Warning

During use, this product may generate heat and fan noise, which is normal. The actual temperature and noise levels may vary depending on performance. You can adjust the performance strategy in AYASpace according to your current environment and needs.

Software Updates

Please refer to the updates provided by AYANEO for the latest software features.

Cleaning Instructions

Use a lint-free cloth to clean the device. Do not use any chemical solvents or abrasives for cleaning.

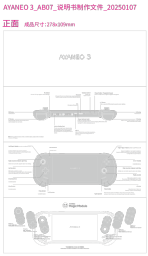
