Product Usage Instructions

Getting Started:

1. Connect the UltraBoard 960 Standard Compact Keyboard to your PC using the integrated USB plug (USB-C/USB-A).
2. This keyboard is plug & play, so wait a few seconds for your computer to detect the device.
3. Your operating system will automatically install the required driver the first time you connect the keyboard.

Use of Function Keys:

Key	Function
F1	Previous track
F2	Play/pause
F3	Next track
F4	Mute
F5	Volume down
F6	Volume up

Maintenance:

When storing or transporting the keyboard, it is recommended to use the supplied fabric cover to extend its life.

FAQs:

Q: How do I know if the CapsLock or NumLock is active?

A: The LED indicators on the keyboard will show a solid green light when CapsLock or NumLock is active.

Q: Is the UltraBoard 960 V2 compatible with both USB-C and USB-A ports?

A: Yes, the keyboard comes with a USB-C to USB-A adapter for compatibility with both types of ports.

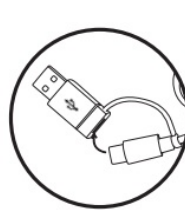
Q: How can I recycle the UltraBoard 960 V2 at the end of its life?

A: The resources used in the device can be recycled by disposing of it with electronic waste.

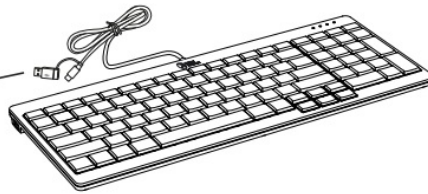

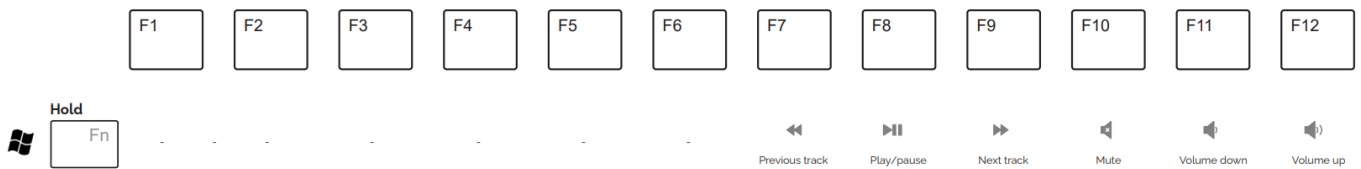
Getting Started

1. Connect the UltraBoard 960 Standard Compact Keyboard to your PC with the integrated USB plug (USB-


C/USB-A).

- This keyboard is “plug & play” so wait for a few seconds for your computer to detect the device and then you’re free to start typing. (Please note that the first time you connect your new keyboard, your operating system automatically installs the required driver. This process can take a few seconds.)
