Product Usage Instructions

Easy Access on Buses:

All buses have no steps at the entrance, making getting on and off easier. Low floor buses have a ramp for access and a dedicated space for wheelchairs and pushchairs inside the bus. Ask the driver for any assistance you require.

Using the Timetable:

Timetables show the direction of travel, bus numbers, and the days of the week. Main stops on the route are listed on the left. Where no time is shown against a particular stop, it means the bus does not stop there on that journey. Check any letters against the key at the bottom of the page.

Service Changes Information:

Visit beenetwork.com or download the Bee Network app for information about service changes. Check service change posters displayed in the bus station or pick up a service change leaflet from various locations.

Lost Property:

For lost property information, visit beenetwork.com/lost-property.

Using the 24-hour Clock:

Times are shown in four figures. The first two are the hour, and the last two are the minutes. For example, 0753 is 53 minutes past 7 am in the morning, and 1953 is 53 minutes past 7 pm in the evening.

There's a range of tickets to use on buses and multi-modal tickets for buses, trams, and trains. Visit beenetwork.com or download the Bee Network app for more information on tickets.

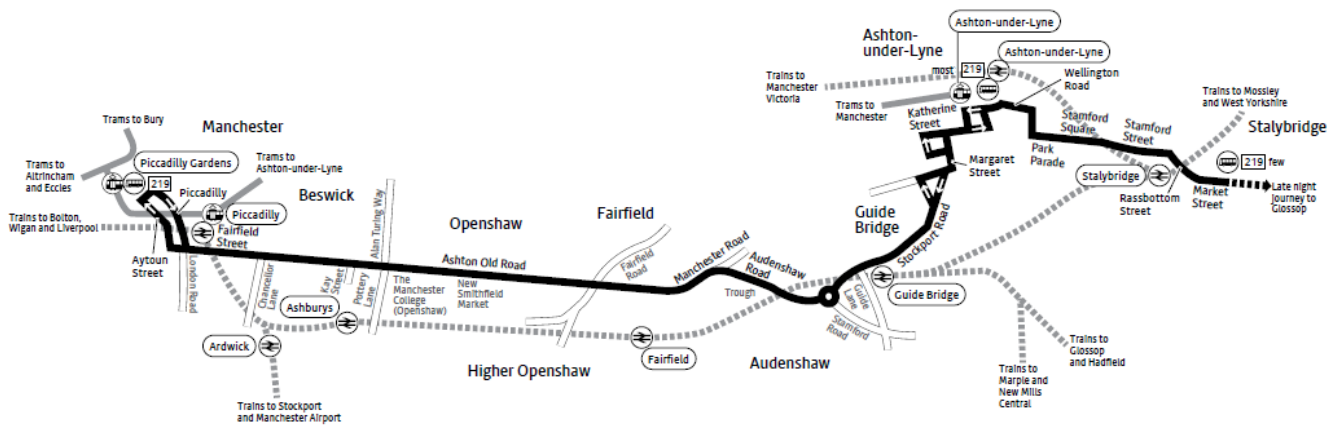

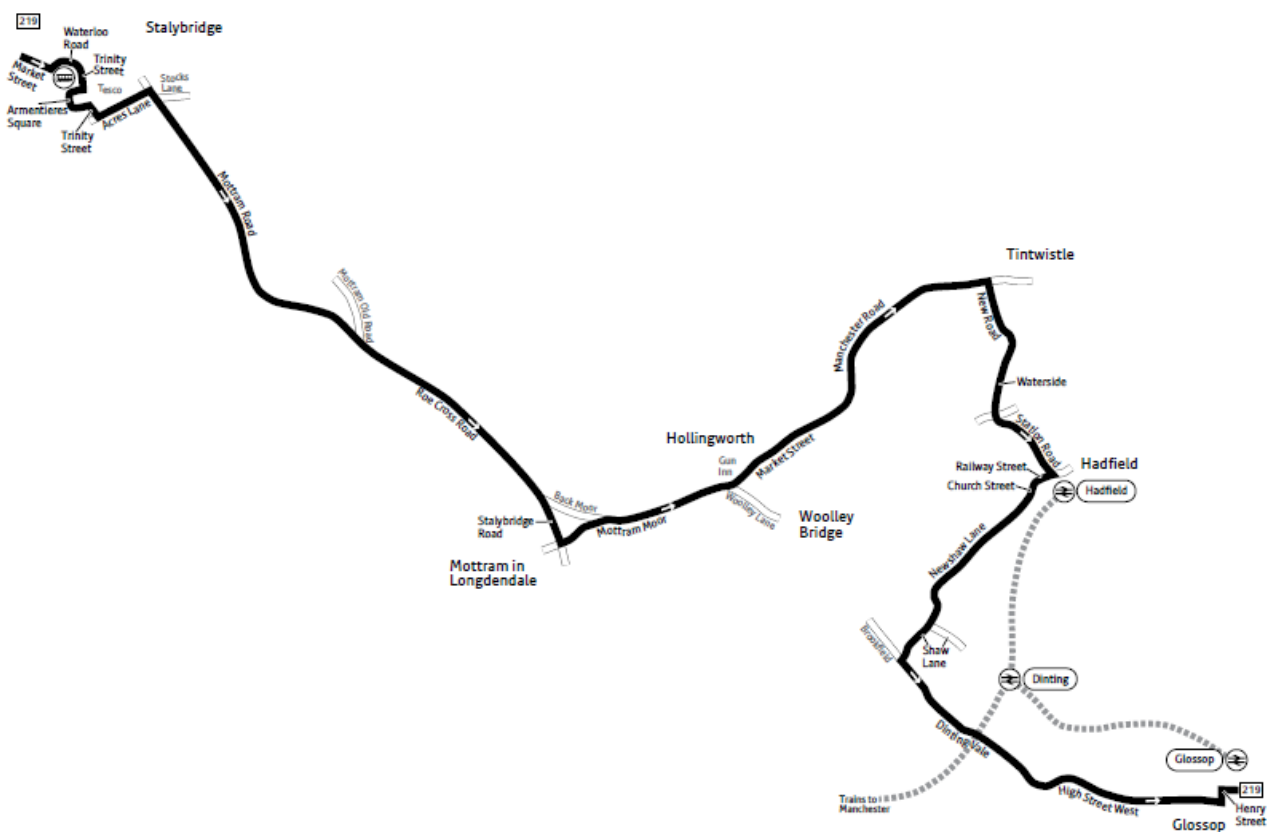
