Safety Precautions

When using your earbuds, basic safety precautions should always be followed including:

1. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING YOUR EARBUDS.
2. Do not use the product near water. Do not put on wet surfaces.
3. Only clean using a soft, clean cloth.
4. Do not allow children to play with this product. This product contains small pieces that can be a choking hazard.
Parental supervision is advised.
5. Do not expose this product to excessive heat or fire.
6. Do not expose this product to temperatures above 100°F.
Keep out of direct sunlight.
7. Do not attempt to repair this product yourself. Contact a qualified service center if the product is in need of service.
8. Do not drop, crush, or expose this product to excessive physical force.
9. This product is not intended for commercial use.
10. When charging, keep all charging cables well ventilated.

Do not keep your charging cable in contact with flammable materials such as bedding, linens or synthetic fabrics.

Maintenance and Care

- Use a soft cloth or paper towel to clean your earbuds. Never use any harsh chemicals or detergents for cleaning. Make sure your earbuds are dry before charging.
- When your earbuds are not in use, they should be stored in a cool, dry place.
- Never tug or yank on a cable while it is connected to your charging case. Connect and disconnect cables as carefully as possible.
- Never expose your earbuds to high temperatures, or extreme cold.
- Please recycle or dispose of your earbuds properly based on the laws and rules of your municipality. Contact local recycling facilities and/or the manufacturer of your earbuds for further information.

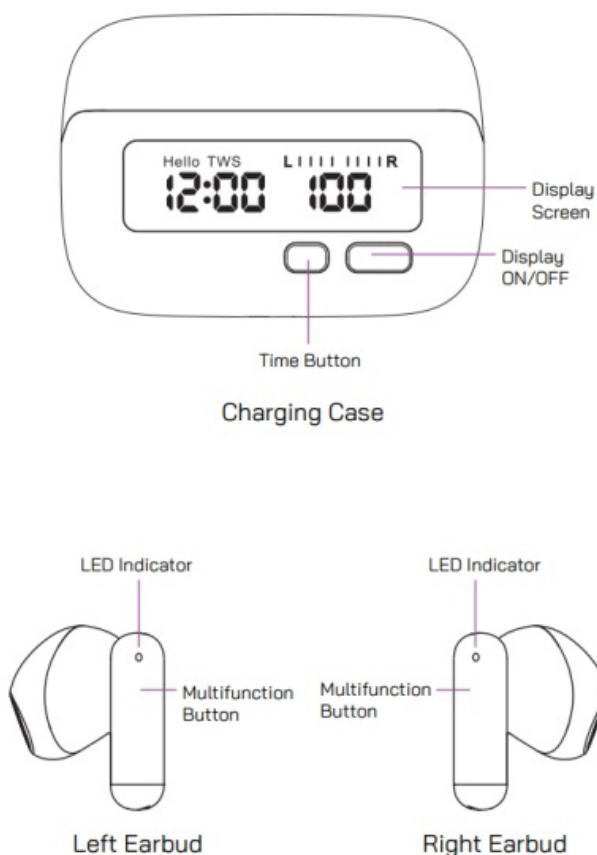

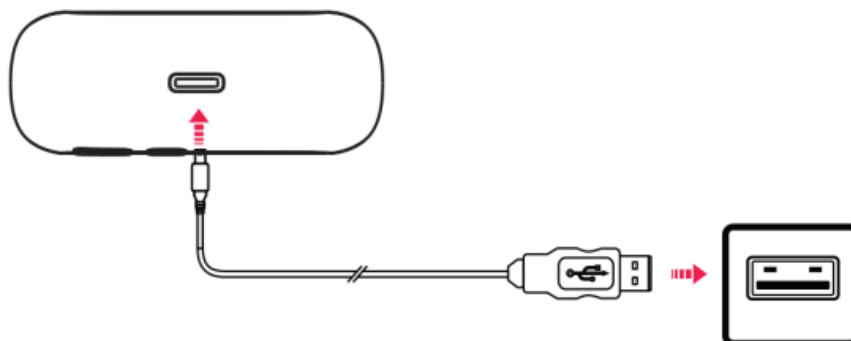

A Closer Look

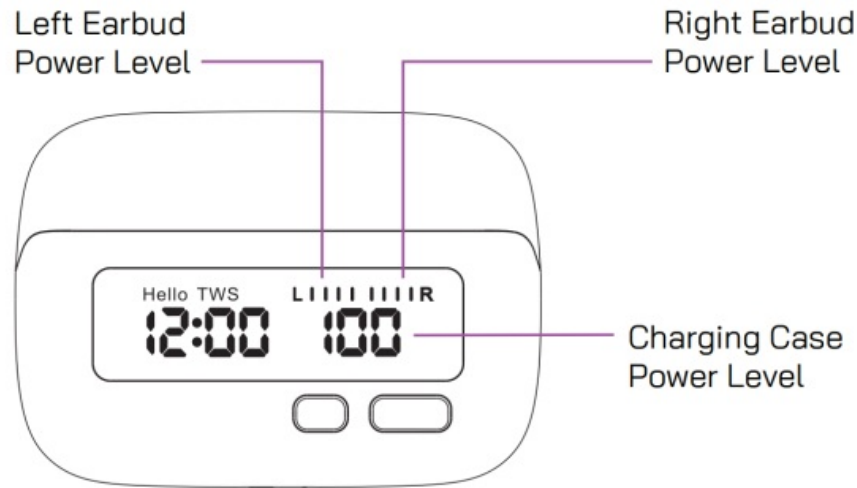


Charging

1. To power the charging case, insert one end of the USB-C cable into the charging port located on the bottom of the charging case.
2. Insert the other end of the cable into any suitable USB power adapter.



3. While the charging case is plugged in, the number on the display screen will increase from 0-100 to show the case's charge level.
4. While the earbuds are inserted in the charging case the Right and Left Earbud Power Level icons will flash as the earbuds charge.

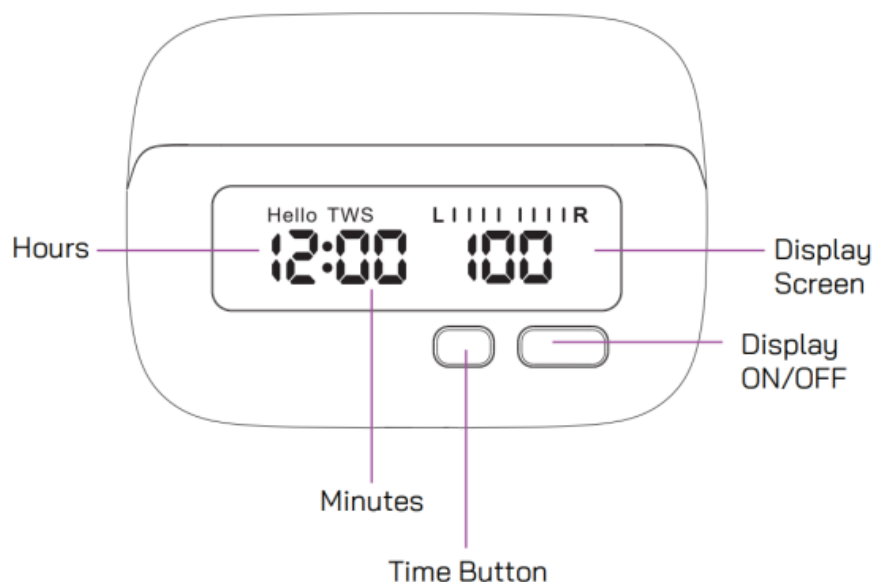


Setting the Time

1. Press the Display ON/OFF button to turn on the charging case's display screen. Press and hold the Display ON/OFF button for 3-4 seconds to turn off the charging case's display screen.
2. With the charging case's display screen powered on, press and hold the Time Button for 3-4 seconds to go into time setting mode.
3. With the hours flashing on the display screen, press the Time Button repeatedly to select the hour. Then press the Display ON/OFF button to enter your setting.
4. Next the minutes will flash on the display screen. Press the Time Button repeatedly to select the minute (press and hold the button will go back to the hour setting). Then press the Display ON/OFF button to enter your setting.

NOTES:

The Time Button can only increase the hour and minute digits.

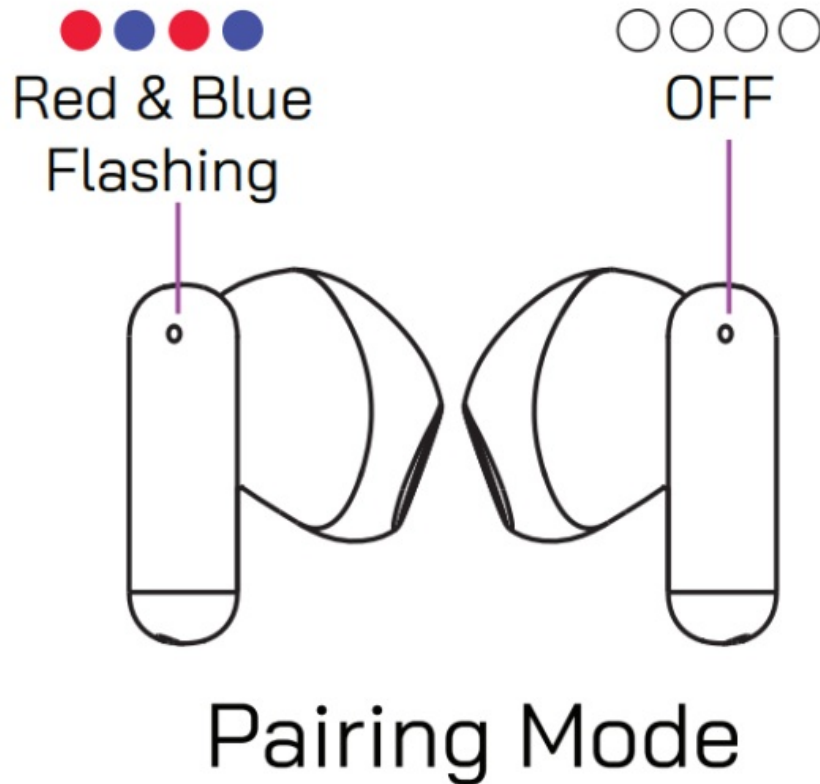


Bluetooth Pairing

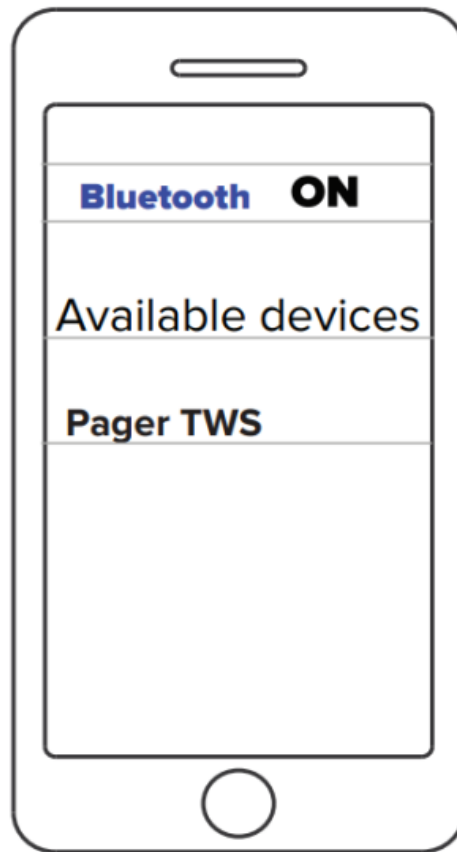
1. Remove the earbuds from the charging case and they will turn on automatically.

NOTE: If the earbuds are already out of the charging case, put them in the case and then take them out again to turn them on.

2. When in pairing mode, one earbud's indicator light will flash red and blue, and the other earbud's indicator light turn off.

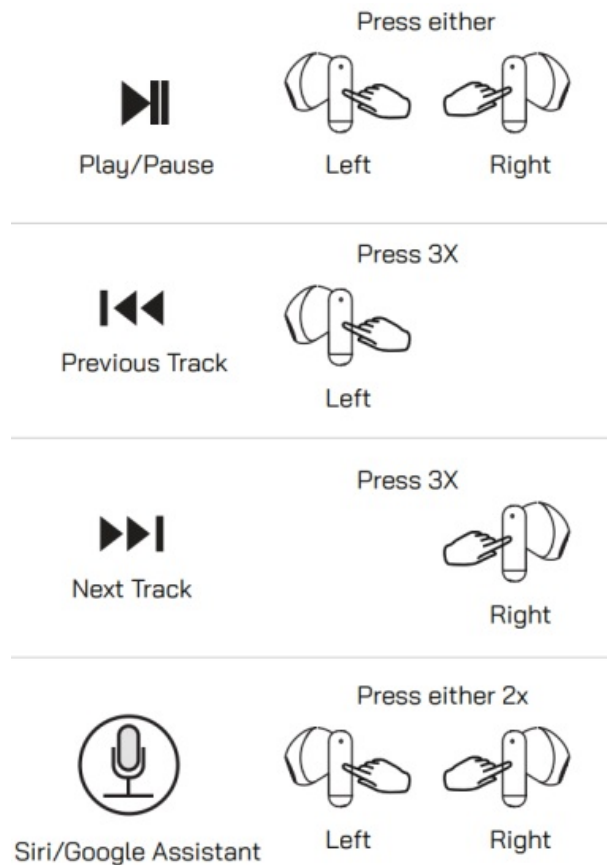


3. Go to the Bluetooth page in the settings app on your phone. Make sure Bluetooth is ON before connecting to the available device 'Pager TWS'.



4. Both earbuds' indicator lights will turn off once paired to your phone.

Listening to Music

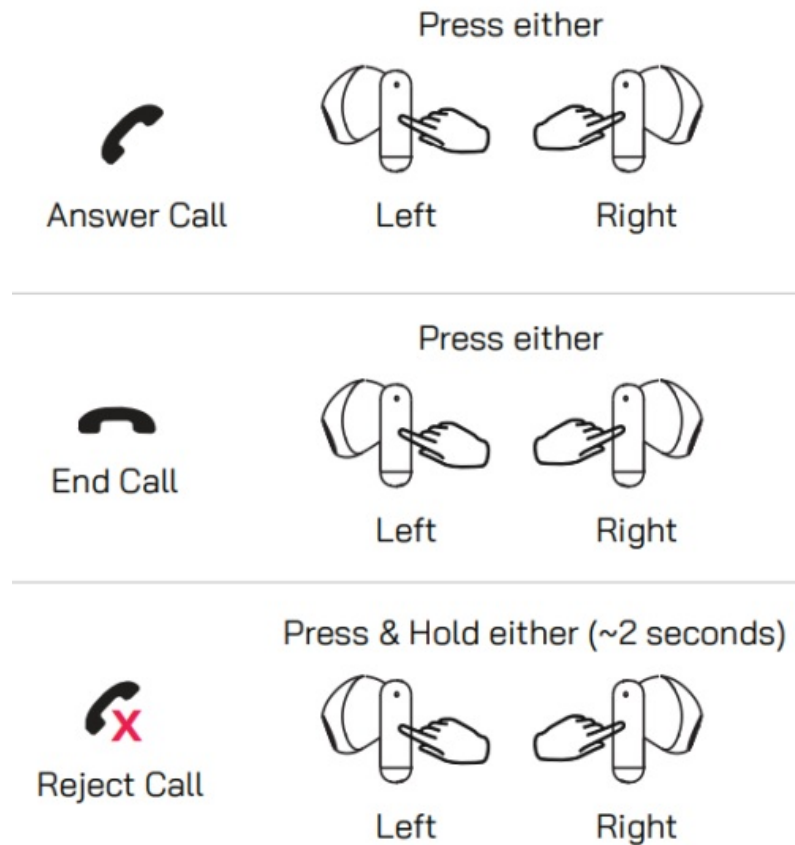


NOTES:

Your earbuds can be used independently. One earbud can be used when the other is off, as long as connected to Bluetooth.

Put the earbud into charging case so it will turn off automatically, or press and hold the Multi-function button for 3 seconds to turn it off.
