- Pick a Placement Area: Pick a spot close to a reliable power supply, like an electrical outlet.

- Replace Parts as Needed: As time passes, you might need to swap out any worn-out components or the UV bulbs. To find out how to replace a part, refer to the user handbook.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Solution
The bug zapper is not turning o	Check the power cord connection and ensure the outlet is working.
No zapping sound	Ensure the zapper is plugged in and the UV bulbs are functioning.
Bulbs are not glowing	Verify the bulbs are properly installed or replace them if damaged.
Zapper is producing weak light	Clean the UV bulbs and check for any obstructions or dirt affecting them.
Insects are not being attracted.	Ensure the zapper is placed in a dark area and within the insects' flight pat h.
The electric shock when handli ng	Check if the protective grill is intact and properly installed.
Excessive noise	Make sure the trap is free of debris or bugs causing vibration.
Frequent need for cleaning	Increase the frequency of cleaning the tray, especially after heavy use.
Unit is overheating	Move the zapper to a well-ventilated area and avoid prolonged direct sunlig ht.
Not catching all flying insects.	Increase the number of zappers or position them closer to high-traffic area s.
