



GETTING STARTED

Take the Learning Cube out of the storage slot.



Battery Installation

The Learning Cube operates on 3 AAA (LR03) batteries:

- 1. Locate the battery cover of the unit and open it with a screwdriver.
- 2. Insert 3 AAA (LR03) batteries as illustrated.
- 3. Close the battery cover securely.


Start Playing

- Once batteries are installed, switch on the power from O to 0 or 0.
- Then press any of the buttons to play!

SLEEPING MODE

- If the Learning Cube is not active for more than 2 minutes, it will automatically go into sleeping mode to save power.
- Press any button to wake up the Learning Cube.
- We recommend switching the unit OFF when done playing with it.

Functional Buttons



ALPHABET

- Learn the alphabet A~Z and play the alphabet song.
- "A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O P Q R S and T U V W X Y and Z now I know my ABCs next time won't you sing along with me (now I know my ABCs next time won't you sing with me)"

NUMBER

- Learn the number 1~10 and play the number song.
- "I say one two three (you say one two three) you say four five six (I say four five six) the next is seven eight nine and ten we do the counting count together from one to ten let's do it again! (now we can count aloud!)"

COLOR

- Learn the colors as the LED lights up and play the color song.
- "red yellow green and blue-green and blue shiny orange and purple too all the colors that we know live up in the rainbow"

MUSIC

- Play 10 fun music.
- Tip: Play music with the musical instrument button or animal button at the same time to hold a little concert!

MUSICAL INSTRUMENT

- Play 12 instrument sounds.
- Drum, Shaker, Cymbal, Castanet, Triangle, Tambourine
- Tip: Hold on to the button, and discover more hidden sounds!

ANIMAL

- Play 15 entertaining animal sounds.
- Bird, Bear, Cat, Cow, Dog, Duck, Elephant, Frog, Horse, Leopard, Monkey, Owl, Rooster, Sheep, Tiger

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Keep products away from foods and beverages.
- Clean with a slightly damp cloth (cold water) and mild soap.
- · Never submerge the product in water.
- Remove batteries during prolonged storage.
- Avoid exposing the product to extreme temperatures.

BATTERY SAFETY

- · Batteries are small parts and choking hazards to children and must be replaced by an adult.
- Follow the polarity(+/-) diagram in the battery compartment.
- · Promptly remove dead batteries from the toy.
- · Dispose of used batteries properly.
- Remove batteries from prolonged storage.
- Only batteries of the same type as recommended are to be used.
- DO NOT incinerate used batteries.
- DO NOT dispose of batteries in a fire, as batteries may explode or leak.
- DO NOT mix old and new batteries.
- DO NOT mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH) batteries.
- DO NOT recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- DO NOT short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Symptom	Possible Solution
The toy does not turn ON or does not respon d.	 Make sure batteries are correctly installed. Make sure the battery cover is securely attached. Remove the batteries and put them back in. Clean the battery compartment by rubbing it lightly with a soft eraser and then wiping it with a clean dry cloth. Install new batteries.
Toy makes strange sounds, behaves erratica lly, or makes improper responses.	 Clean battery contacts per the above instructions. Install new batteries.


