Important Safety Instructions



RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK DO NOT OPEN

Caution:

To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not remove cover (or back). No user serviceable parts inside. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel.

Explanation of Graphical Symbols:

Important Notes

- This safety and operating instruction should be retained for future reference.
- The apparatus should not be exposed to dripping or splashing or placed in a humid atmosphere such as a bathroom.
- Do not install the product in the following areas:
 - Places exposed to direct sunlight or close to radiators.
 - On top of other stereo equipment that radiate too much heat.
 - Blocking ventilation or in a dusty area.
 - Areas where there is constant vibration.
 - Humid or moist places.
- Do not place near candles or other naked flames.
- Operate the product only as instructed in this manual.
- Before turning on the power for the first time, make sure the power adaptor is properly connected.
- Plug-in the USB stick directly or use an USB-extension cable which is not longer than 25 cm.

For safety reasons, do not remove any covers or attempt to gain access to the inside of the product. Refer any servicing to qualified personnel.
Do not attempt to remove any screws, or open the casing of the unit; there are no user serviceable parts inside. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read Instructions – All the safety and operating instructions must be read before the product is operated.
2. Retain Instructions – The safety and operating instructions should be kept with the product for future reference.
3. Heed warnings – All warnings on the product and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.
4. Follow instructions – All operating and users' instructions should be followed.
5. Installation – Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
6. Power sources – This product should be operated only from the type of power source indicated by the marking adjacent to the power cord entry. If you are not sure of the type of power supply to your home, consult your product dealer or local power company.
7. Grounding or polarization – the product is not required to be grounded. Ensure that the plug is fully inserted into the wall outlet or extension cord receptacle to prevent blade or pin exposure. Some versions of the product are equipped with a power cord fitted with a polarized alternating line plug (a plug having one blade wider than the other). 27. ESD hints – If the product maybe reset or not reset to operation of control due to electrostatic discharge, just switch off and reconnect again, or move the product to another location.

After 30 minutes without any audio input, the device will automatically switch into standby mode. Follow up the instruction manual to resume the operation.

Important note:

This device is equipped with an energy saving mode: if no signal is given during 30 minutes the device will switch

automatically into standby mode in order to save energy (ERP 2 standard). Please note that low volume setting in the audio source may be recognized as “no audio signal”: this will affect the capability of signal detection from the device and can also originate an automatic switch into standby mode. If this happens please reactivate the audio signal transmission or increase the volume setting on the audio source player (MP3 player, etc.), in order to resume playback. Please contact the local service center if the problem remains.

WARNING

This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

1. Never use the device unsupervised! Switch off the device whenever you are not using it, even if this only for a short while.
2. The appliance is not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote control system.
3. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
4. Before operating this system, check the voltage of this system to see if it is identical to the voltage of your local power supply.
5. The unit should not be impeded by covering the ventilation opening with items such as newspaper, table-cloths, curtains etc. Make sure that there are at least 20 cm of space above and at least 5 cm of space on each side of the unit.

15. Depending on the electromagnetic waves used by a television broadcast, if a TV is turned on near this unit while it is also on, lines might appear on the TV screen. Neither this unit nor the TV is malfunctioning. If you see such lines, keep this unit well away from the TV set.
16. The mains plug is used as the disconnect device, the disconnect device must remain readily operable.
17. To prevent possible hearing damage, do not listen at high volume levels for long periods.

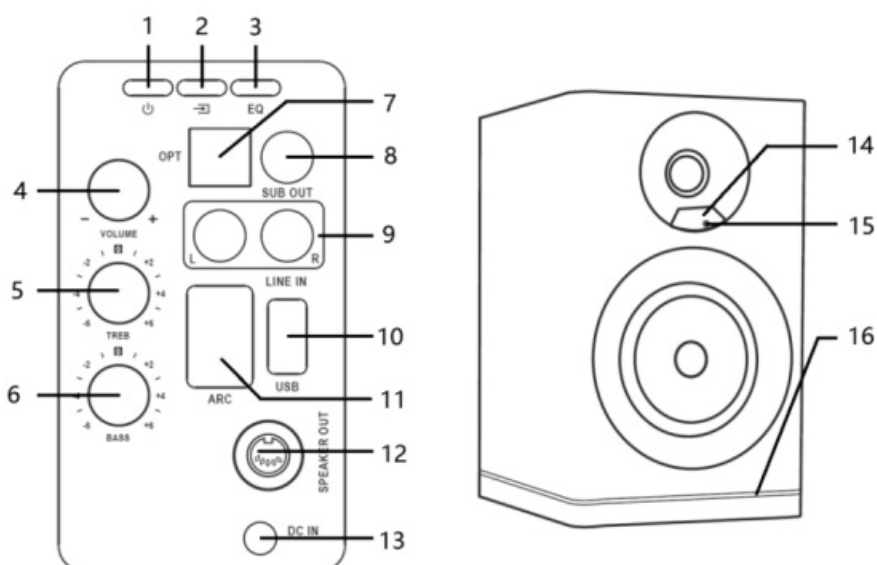

Control panel



1. Power button: short press it to power on the unit after connect with power adaptor; long press 3 seconds to

standby off the unit; Short press it repeatedly to switch the LED light color.

2.Mode button: short press it repeatedly to switch the play mode between Bluetooth/Optical/HDMI ARC/USB/Line in.

3.EQ button: short press it repeatedly to switch preset equalizer in movie/music/dialog mode.

4. Main volume knob: rotate it to increase or decrease the volume level.

5-6. Treble/bass control knob: rotate it to adjust the treble/bass output.

7.Optical input jack.

8. Subwoofer out jack: connect with active subwoofer.

9. RCA line in jack.

10. USB port.

11. HDMI ARC input port.

12. Speaker out terminal: connect to satellite speaker as stereo.

13. DC input power jack.

14-15: IR sensor for remote controller and signal LED window.

RED color: in standby mode.

Blue color: In Bluetooth mode.

White color: in optical mode.

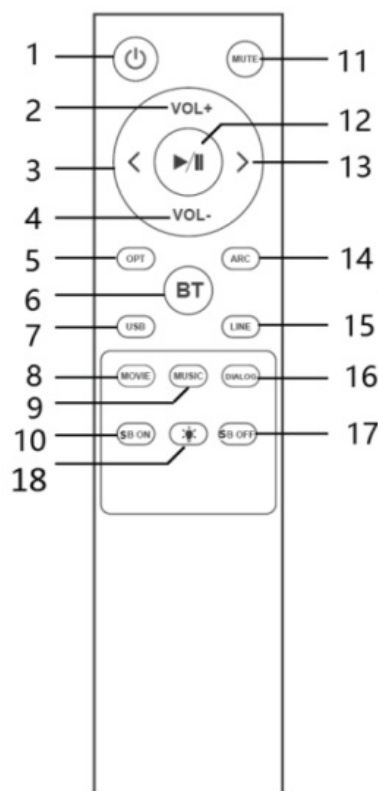
Pink color: in USB playback mode.

Yellow color: in line in mode.

Light blue: in HDMI ARC mode.

16. Colorful LED light bar.

Remote controller:



1-Power button: press it to standby on/off the unit.

2,4-Volume+/- button: press it to adjust the output volume.

3,13- Previous/next button: press it to switch previous/next track in Bluetooth or USB mode. Press and hold it to fast-forward or fast-rewind current track in USB mode.

5,6,7,14,15-Optical/Bluetooth/USB/HDMI ARC/LINE IN button: press it skip to relevant play mode directly.

8,9, 16-Movie/music/dialog button: press it skip to relevant preset equalizer.

10,17-Super bass on/off button: press it to turn on or off super bass function.

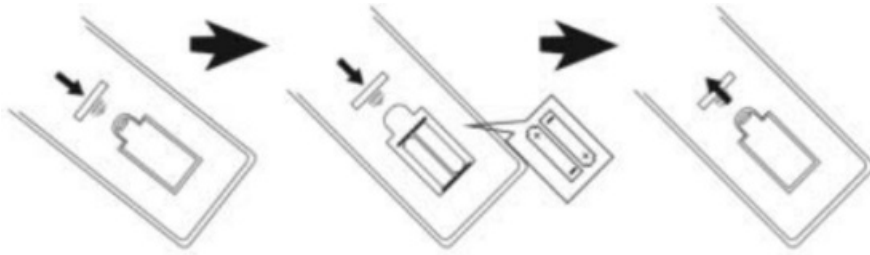
11-Mute button: press it to silence the speaker, press again to resume the output.

12-Play/pause: press it to play or pause the sound output in Bluetooth or USB mode.

18-LED light button: press it to switch LED light mode (total: 7 types and off).

Remote control battery installation

Open up the battery door and insert 2 x AAA dry battery (included) into the compartment; please make sure the polarity of battery will aim and correspond to the positive and negative silkscreen-printed symbol in the compartment. Then close the battery door.



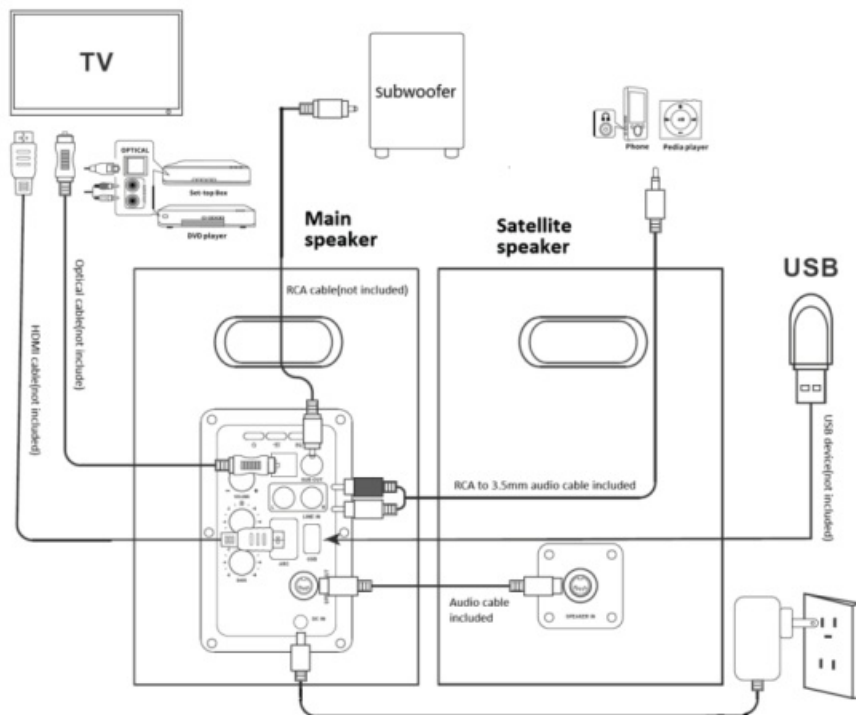
Notes:

- The best working distance of remote control is within 5 meters without any obstacle in between. Please aim to the remote control sensor located on the front of unit during operation.
- The sensitivity of remote control will become weak when the battery power is exhausted. Please replace it with a fresh one for operation.
- Please take out the battery in case of non-operation in a long time.
- Please dispose the battery in an environment friendly way. Please reference the local government requirement for the detail.

Speaker grill: there is a built-in magnetic button inside of the grill, just touch the speaker front panel by the grill can attach and mount on.

Main and satellite speaker connection: Before power on the unit, please kindly connect the unit first. Using the supplied 5pin audio cable connect the speaker out and speaker in terminal on rear panel between main and satellite speaker. Then the speaker will get stereo output.

Power setting and power on/off: Plug in the supplied AC/DC power adaptor to an AC household outlet in order to get power source, and plug the DC connector of power adaptor to power jack on the rear panel of main unit. Then the unit will enter to standby mode, and ready work for you. Short press the power button from rear panel of main unit or remote controller can power on the speaker. Long press (3 seconds) the power button from rear panel, or short press power button from remote controller can standby off the unit.



Speaker connect with outsourcing devices like TV, TV set-top, DVD, Blue-ray DVD player, MP3 player etc.

The speaker has included digital (optical & HDMI(ARC)) and analogue (Line in) inputs for different source. You can reference below instruction and above drawing for the connection depends on what input jack has on your

device.

Remove the protective cap of the OPTICAL socket, and then using an OPTICAL cable (not included) to connect between the TV's OPTICAL OUT jack and the OPTICAL input jack of speaker.

Using the same method and reference above drawing to connect other device like TV set-top box, DVD player, Blue-ray DVD player, MP3 player etc.

Important notes:

1. If there is no sound come out of the speaker in optical/ HDMI mode. Make sure the audio setting of your source player (e.g. DVD player, game player, TV) is set to "PCM stereo" or "stereo 2.0" with digital output. Please reference your TV or player manual for this operation.
2. HDMI(ARC): The speaker supports HDMI with Audio Return Channel (ARC). If your TV has HDMI ARC compliant (reference your TV user manual for details), you can hear the TV audio through your speaker by using a single HDMI cable (not included). The HDMI ARC connector on the TV may be labelled differently, please pay attention to check your TV's manual.
3. When you select and buy HDMI cable for connection, please make sure the HDMI cable can support HDMI V1.3 and above, and it is 19-cores matching cable.
4. In case of no sound or intermittent output, please double check above notes, and make sure there will have correct and proper connection between Bookshelf speaker and other device.
5. The output sound of optical and HDMI mode may louder than Line in etc. which is normal, because the digital audio signal input and output level is different on audio source player (like DVD player, TV etc).
6. In case finished above connection and setting, you can start to operate the Bookshelf speaker according to this manual, and entertainment.

Bluetooth operation

This product includes Bluetooth function which can wireless playback the music from other Bluetooth device (like smart phone, tablet, TV etc).

1. Power on the unit, press mode button repeatedly on rear panel or Bluetooth button from remote controller to enter Bluetooth mode. The blue color LED will flare on the signal LED window which means the unit is ready to pair.
2. Enable the Bluetooth function on your device, and search the available device (please reference your device manual for operation), then check the available Bluetooth device on the list. Select "BP BS60" for pairing, and the blue color signal LED will become stable after paired successful.
3. Select and play the music from your Bluetooth device, adjust the volume level properly, then the sound will come out from the speaker.
4. In Bluetooth mode, you can do operation like previous/next track selection, play/pause, mute etc. by pressing relevant button from remote controller.

Notices:

- a. All Bluetooth devices are not guaranteed for pairing successfully due to different design and brand.
 - b. The best working distance of Bluetooth is within 10 meters without any obstacle in between.
 - c. The unit only can pair and work with one Bluetooth device in one time.
 - d. In case of an incoming phone call during Bluetooth playback; the music will stop temporary, and resume to playback after end the phone call.
- Bluetooth connect with TV: In case of your TV device has Bluetooth function, the Bookshelf speaker can wireless playback with your TV as well. You have to turn on the Bluetooth function on your TV screen and searching "BP

BS60" for connection. Please reference your TV's manual for the details.

USB playback operation

The product includes USB playback function which can decode and playback the music from a USB storage device. Before start the operation, please copy the MP3 format music into the device; and insert the device into the unit first, Then the unit will detect and play the inside MP3 music automatically.

In USB playback mode, you can get track selection/play/pause/preset EQ adjustment function etc. by press relevant button from remote controller.

Notes:

- a. Connect the USB stick by a USB extension cable for playback is not recommended which may produce noise or intermittent sound due to audio data loss during transfer.
- b. Decode and playback all MP3/WAV/WMA format music is not guaranteed.
- c. The max supported storage device is up to 32GB.
- d. Some different device and brand may take a little long time to playback; please kindly note this is not malfunction.

Trouble shooting

1. The speaker cannot turn on.
 - a. Please check if the power connection is correct.
2. No sound output.
 - a. Please try to adjust the volume knob, mute button and check the play source.
 - b. please contact service center for support if the issue remained.
3. Sound distortion.
 - a. Please try to adjust and play the music at a lower volume level.
 - b. Check the status of treble/bass setting.
 - c. Please try to decrease the volume level on outsourcing player like TV etc.
4. The sound is sounding intermittently in Bluetooth mode.
 - a. Please try to move the Bluetooth device closer to speaker.
 - b. Please try to repair the speaker with Bluetooth device.
5. There is no sound output in optical or HDMI(ARC) mode.
 - a. Please check if there was connected properly between speaker and device.
 - b. Please make sure that your TV has HDMI (ARC) compliant, and appropriate port was connected. Please set up the TV to HDMI ARC(CEC).
 - c. Set up audio output mode of TV to PCM format.


