


Blink Mini Pan Tilt Camera




Product Using Instructions


1. If you already have a Mini, unplug the USB cable from the camera and uninstall it from its base.




- Diagram: Illustration of a Mini camera with a USB cable being unplugged from the camera.
- 2. Connect the micro-USB connector cable from your Pan-Tilt Mount into the back of your Mini camera.

- 3. Snap your Mini camera onto your Pan-Tilt Mount, ensuring the micro-USB ports on your Pan-Tilt Mount and Mini camera are vertically aligned. When attaching your Mini camera, you will need to hold your Pan-Tilt Mount steadily in place, in order to securely snap your camera on It.

- 4. Plug in the micro-USB cable that came with your Mini camera into your Pan-Tilt Mount. Then plug the other end into a power outlet.



- **Note:** The flat side of the USB cord must face downward while the rounded side faces upward, to ensure the cable is properly connected.

- 5. Once the Pan-Tilt mount is connected to the Mini, it automatically calibrates based on its current position. A notification will display in your Blink app when the Pan-Tilt mount is added to your Mini camera.
 - Note: If you experience any issues during the calibration, refer to the <u>Recalibrate your Pan-Tilt Mount</u> section of <u>Troubleshoot the Pan-Tilt Mount</u>.
- 6. Tap OK.

FAQs

- Q: What should I do if my Pan-Tilt Mount doesn't calibrate automatically?
 - A: If the Pan-Tilt Mount does not calibrate automatically, refer to the <u>Recalibrate your Pan-Tilt Mount</u>
 section of <u>Troubleshoot the Pan-Tilt Mount</u>
- Q: How do I know if the USB cable is connected correctly?
 - **A:** Ensure the flat side of the USB cord faces downward while the rounded side faces upward to ensure proper connection.
- Q: Can I use the Pan-Tilt Mount with any Blink Mini camera?
 - A: Yes, the Pan-Tilt Mount is designed to be compatible with all Blink Mini cameras.
- Q: What should I do if my camera does not snap onto the Pan-Tilt Mount securely?
 - **A:** Make sure the micro-USB ports on your Pan-Tilt Mount and Mini camera are vertically aligned and hold the Pan-Tilt Mount steadily in place while snapping the camera on.
