- 2. The Red shaded areas are the recommended \locations for best microphone performance.

## Items to look for before placement:

- 1. Do not place in front of air vents.
- 2. If the vehicle has tweeters placed on sail panels, do NOT locate the mic on the steering column area.
- 3. The front of the mic must not be blocked.
- 4. The mic should be firmly attached to the mounting location.
- 5. Do not cover the grille openings surrounding the mic.
- 6. To avoid excessive wind noise, do not place near the sunroof opening

Run microphone wire where it will NOT impede the operation of any safety items, i.e. Airbags, Knee Airbags, etc.


