

- Built-in microphone for added convenience.
- Aux input for blending external music.
- Battery operation for portability (AC adapter sold separately).
- Mic input accepts XLR or 1/4" microphone input.

QUICK DEMO

The Quick Demo provides a brief introduction to the VE-5 in under 60 seconds. Here's a simple setup guide:

- Connect a microphone to the [MIC IN] input or use the internal mic.
- Connect headphones to the [PHONES/LINEOUT] input.
- Turn down the volume to 0 using the [VOLUME] dial.
- Power on the VE-5.
- Adjust the volume to a comfortable level.

The Quick Demo: Using the VE-5

This demo consists of three steps:

STEP ONE: Show a Reverb Effect

- Select preset [BRIGHT ECHO] and sing, speak, or rap into the mic.
- Use the SOUND] knob to explore different reverb/echo presets.

STEP TWO: Show a Harmony Effect

- Choose preset 13: 5th HARMONY and demonstrate the harmony effect.
- Use the [SOUND] knob to navigate through different harmony presets.

STEP THREE: Show a Special Effect

- Select preset 20: ROBOT and showcase the special effect.
- Use the [SOUND] knob to cycle through various special effects presets.

PRODUCT USAGE

This section provides details on using the Looper:

How to Use the LOOPER:

- Press the [LOOP] button to start recording.
- · Press it again for playback mode.
- Press it once more for overdub mode.
- To momentarily stop the LOOPER, push [EXIT/STOP]. Activate it again with [LOOP].
- To quit the LOOPER, press [EXIT] twice.

How to Use the LOOPER Check Function:

Access the menu, select PHRASE LOOP, and switch to LoopType Check.

- Record a loop and use it to audition/adjust presets and parameters.
- To return to Perform mode, switch LoopType back to Perform.



• Find your preset and press and hold A, B, or C button for two seconds to store it.

- Six high-quality vocal effects from the VE-20: Reverb, Delay, Double/Harmony, Dynamics, Pitch Correct, and Tone/SFX.
- Phrase Looper for dynamic vocal performances.
