
## **Dynamic Water Pressure**



#### **Inlet Dimensions**









This product needs to be installed in accordance with, and meet the requirements of the Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999 and current by-laws. For full Installation Requirements & Notes (IRN) please visit wras.co.uk/directory. Isolation valves must be fitted to the inlet water supplies to ensure ease of future maintenance. Before installing this product the water supply must be thoroughly flushed in order to remove any swarf, solder etc. Full access must be made available for future maintenance/ servicing purposes. Before drilling into walls, check that there are no hidden electrical wires, cables or water supply pipes. This can be checked with the aid of an electronic detector. If power tools are used do not forget to:




#### **General Cleaning**

Bristan products are made from premium materials, with hand polished, PVD, EPD or electroplated finishes. Your shower should be regularly cleaned with warm water, a mild pH-neutral liquid soap, and polished with a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toothpaste, shampoos and shower gels can cause blemishes if not rinsed off straight after use. Household bleaches and cleaners contain harsh chemicals and may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar.

No flow or low flow r ate	Head of water is below the minimum distance req uired.	Refer to the specification for the minimum dist ance required.
	Are the water supply pressures balanced?	If pressures are unbalanced, a pressure reducing valve should be used for optimum performance.
	Hot or cold water being drawn off elsewhere causi ng pressure changes or instantaneous boiler temp erature changes.	Do not use other water outlets when using the shower.
	Airlock or partial blockage in the supply pipework.	Flush through pipework and filters to ensure r emoval of debris and any airlocks.
	Hot/Cold water supply has failed	Check the hot and cold feeds. The shower will not work if either fails.
Maximum Water Te mperature too Hot/C old	Maximum Water Temperature needs adjusting.	Refer to the Temperature Setting section to se t your desired maximum temperature.
	Filter/pipe blockage	Flush through pipework and filters to ensure r emoval of debris and any airlocks.
Outlet Wa ter Tempe rature too Hot/Cold	Installtion conditions outside operating parameters.	Refer to the specification for the minimum dist ance required.
	Hot water temperature is less than 10°C above the required blend temperature	Adjust hot water temperature or wait for water to reheat if a stored water system is used.
	Instantaneous water not igniting because the wate r flow rate is too low.	Increase water flow rate through the system. Refer to the Maintenance section to clean/che ck the cartridge and filters for any damage. Co ntact your boiler manufacturer.
		Refer to the specification for system requirem ents.
	Instantaneous water not igniting because the wate r pressure is too low.	Increase water pressure through the system.
		Contact your boiler manufacturer.
Only hot/ cold water from Sho wer Valve	Inlet water supplies are reversed.	Check the water inlet connections are the correct way around: Hot on the left, Cold on the right when viewed from the front. Rework pipework as necessary.
	Filter/pipe blockage	Flush through pipework and filters to ensure r emoval of debris and any airlocks.
Water drip ping from shower	This is normal for a short time after using the shower.	This is caused by residual water tension, the build up of water in the shower.
	If water continues to drip, possibly due to the cartri dge	Remove cartridge and clean, refer to 'Mainten ance' section before starting any maintenance.
	Closed isolation valve.	Open isolation valve.
