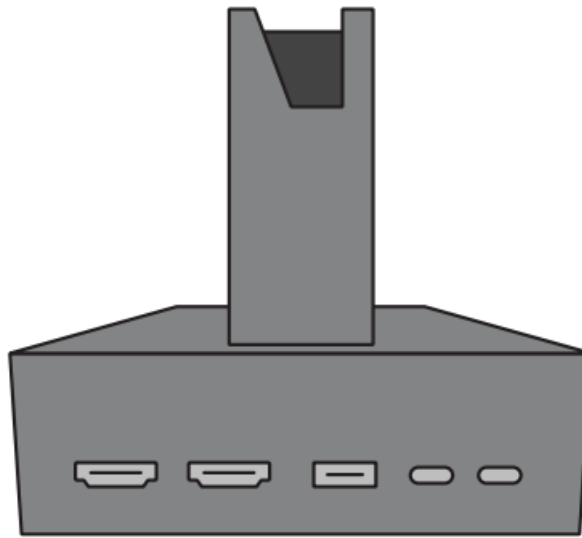

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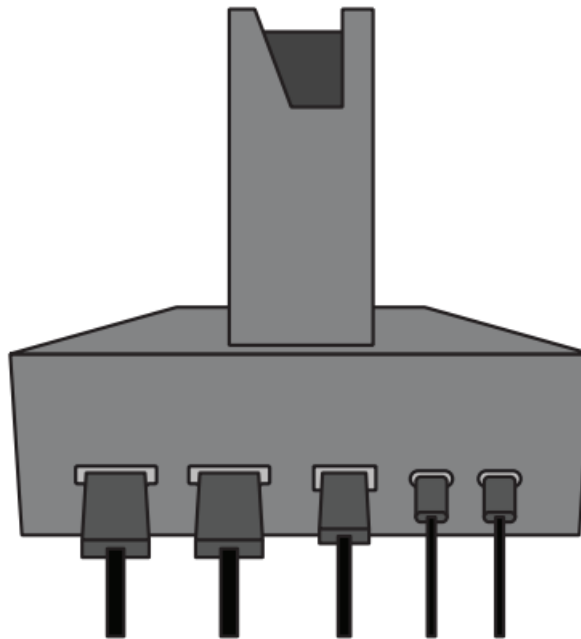
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ASSEMBLY

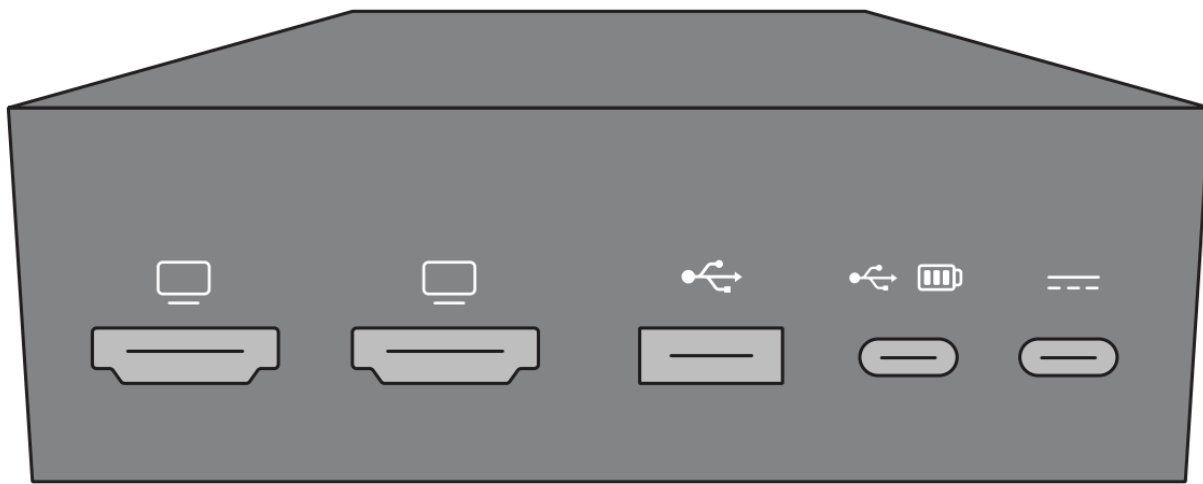
1. Remove Dock from packaging and place on the desktop.



2. Connect devices to the ports.

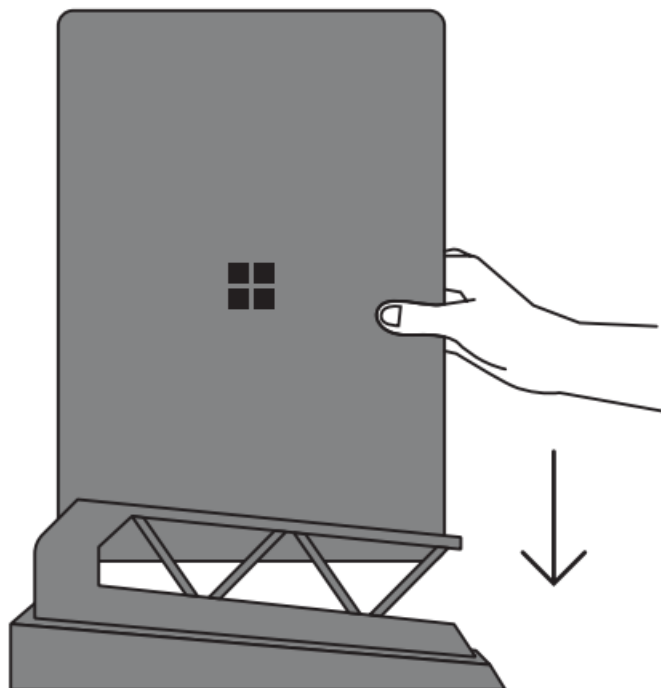

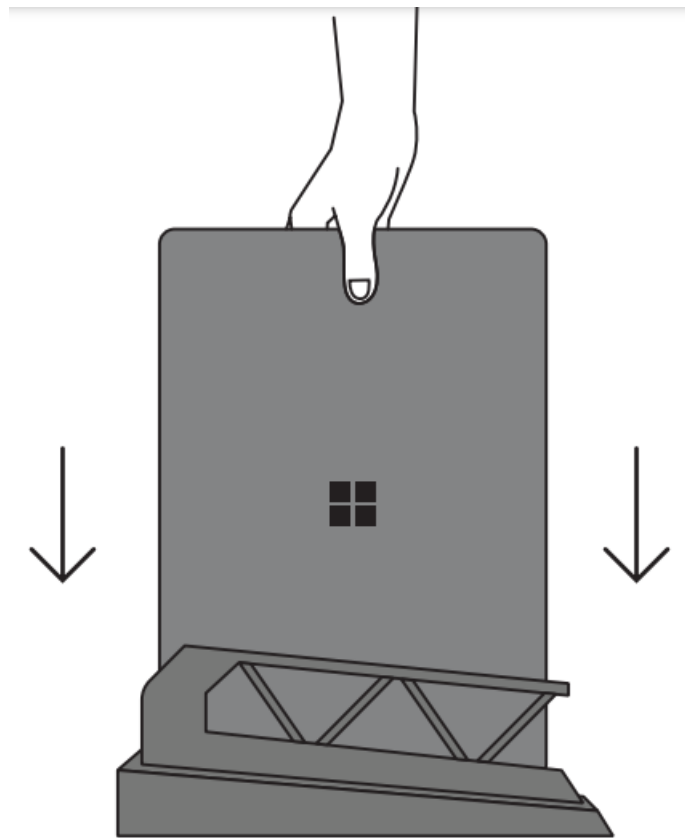

INSERT & REMOVE

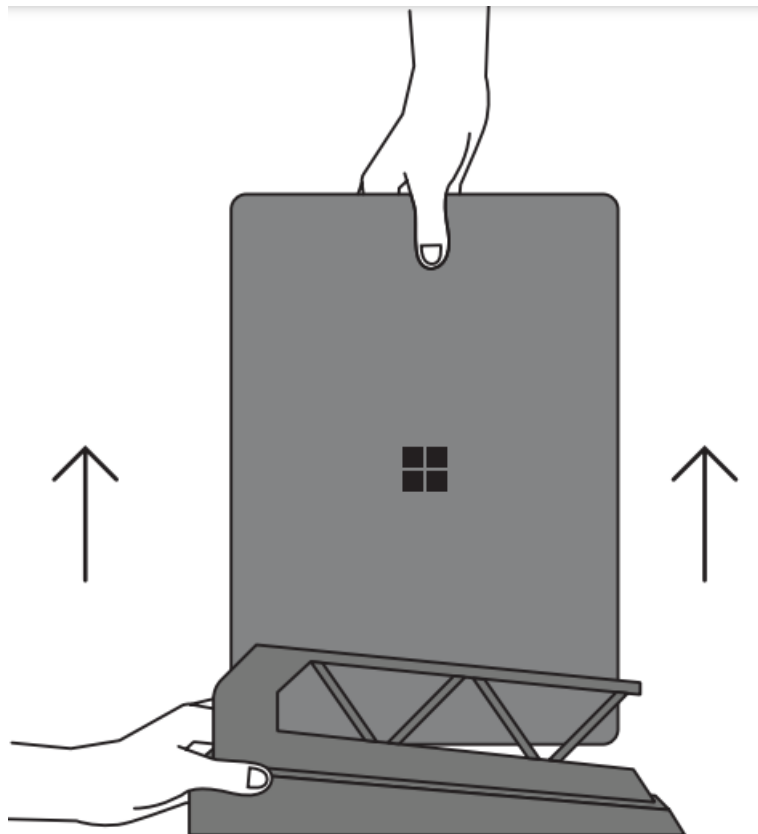
1. **INSERT:** Gently insert your Surface Laptop into the bottom of the black sleeve.



2. **SEAT:** Push down until the USB-C port engages.



3. **REMOVE:** Pull up and remove your Surface Laptop.



PROPER USAGE

Dropping the Surface Laptop into the Vertical Dock can damage the ports and dock connectors. Forcing or wobbling the computer into or out of the dock could result in port damage. Make sure that your grip on the computer is secure before docking and undocking.

Do not insert upside down or backward, this may result in port damage or cosmetic damage to your Surface

Laptop. The Surface Laptop should only be docked with the left-side ports down and the monitor hinge to the rear of the dock.

Cosmetic wear to the surface finish may result from any device that plugs into the Surface Laptop, including the Vertical Dock. Minor wear around the Surface Laptop’s ports is considered normal.
