Installation Instructions

- Connect the adapter directly to the USB-C /Thunderbolt 3 port of the host device.
- Connect a DVI-D Cable (sold separately) in the shortest length needed.
- Find a compatible video resolution between the host and the output display.
- Note: Audio is not carried over DVI and must be transmitted separately.

Troubleshooting Tips

- DisplayPort Alt Mode (video over USB-C) must be supported by your device.
- Test with a different DVI cable and output display.
- Try a different USB-C/Thunderbolt 3 port on your device.
- Check for updated Thunderbolt 3 driver updates For more information, go to kh.rablematters.com.
