• Auto Power Off: 20 minutes (30 minutes for CT-S1)

Product Usage Instructions

Preparation: Preparing a Power Supply

Using the AC Adaptor

1. Connect the AC adaptor as shown in the illustration. Ensure to use the specified AC adaptor for the Digital Keyboard.

Using Batteries

- 1. For CT-S1-76: Insert 8 AA-size batteries; for CT-S1: Insert 6 AA-size batteries into the battery case.
- 2. For CT-S1-76, connect the power cord to the AC adaptor.

Practicing with the Metronome

Specify a beat value by holding down the respective keys for tempo setting.

Basic Operation: Selecting a Tone

- 1. Press the main tone buttons to select an instrument.
- 2. Select a variation using the TONE VARIATION button.

Touch Response

Key sensitivity: Press harder for louder sound, softer for softer sound.

Auto Power Off

The keyboard automatically turns off after 20 minutes of nonuse (switchable to 30 minutes for CT-S1).

Pedal

The pedal sustains notes played while depressed, releasing keys does not stop sustained notes until pedal

release.


Preparing a Power Supply

Using the AC Adaptor


- Connect the AC adaptor as shown in the right illustration.
- Make sure that you use only the AC adaptor specified for this Digital Keyboard.

Using Batteries

- 1. Bottom of console
- 2. 2 Insert AA-size batteries into the battery case (CT-S1-76: 8 batteries/CT-S1: 6 batteries).


4. Specify the battery type. See "Specifying the Battery Type" on the reverse side of this sheet.




The illustration shows the CT-S1. The CT-S1 has 61 keys; the CT-S1-76 has 76 keys.

Computer, smartphone, etc. (commercially available)


Connect using a USB cable that is no more than two meters long. For the CT-S1-76, connect the power cord to the AC adaptor.

Touch Response

Pressing a key harder produces louder sound, while a softer key press produces softer sound.

Auto Power Off


Automatically turns off power after 20 minutes* of non-use. (On, Off switchable) * 30 minutes for the CT-S1

Pedal


Sustains notes played while the pedal is depressed. Even if the keys played are released, notes are sustained as if the keys remain pressed, until the pedal is released.




To select a tone using the keyboard keys












