



  - 1. Connect the AC adaptor as shown in the nearby illustration.

- 2. Load six AA-size batteries.




- 3. Specify the battery type.









- Pressing the phrase switch of a phrase that is sounding stops the phrase.










Chord input keyboard

Input the following chords for the progression:  $C \rightarrow F \rightarrow C \rightarrow G$ .

Inputting a chord when there is a change from one measure to the next is recommended.
