## Product Information

### Specifications

### Description

The Chapin Wireless Remote On/Off Switch is a portable device that allows you to control 12V-24V products with the touch of a button. It is specifically designed for use with Chapin remote voltage control. The remote control is connected to a key chain clip for easy access and convenience. With this remote, you can turn a sprayer on and off from the seat of your garden tractor, zero-turn mower, or small tractor.

### Usage Instructions

1. Ensure that the Chapin Receiver is plugged into a power circuit.
2. Identify the buttons on the remote control:
  - The small LED at the top of the remote turns red when you press the on or off button.
  - The 'ON' green button turns on the Chapin Receiver.
  - The 'OFF' red button turns off the Chapin Receiver.
3. Before using, make sure to extend the antenna on the remote control.
4. To turn on a connected 12V-24V product, press the 'ON' green button on the remote control.
5. To turn off the connected product, press the 'OFF' red button on the remote control.

### Troubleshooting

**Problem: Remote does not control the receiver**

### **Possible Reasons:**

- Remote Battery is discharged
- Receiver is not on
- Radio interference

### **Possible Solutions:**

- Replace the battery with an A23, 12V Alkaline battery.
- Ensure that the receiver is plugged into a power circuit to function.
- Move the receiver and remote away from electronic interference.

### **FAQ**

- **Can I use this remote with any voltage control?**

No, this remote is only compatible with Chapin remote voltage control.

- **What is the maximum current that this remote can handle?**

This remote can control 12V products up to 20A.

- **Can obstructions or radio interference affect the effective distance of the remote control?**

Yes, obstructions and radio interference can reduce the effective distance of the remote control.

### **SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS:**

- This manual contains important safety instructions for Chapin wireless remote.
- This remote is only compatible with Chapin remote voltage control.

### **Button Identification**

- The small LED at the top of remote turns red when you press the on or off button.
- The 'ON' green button will only turn on the Chapin Receiver.
- The 'OFF' red button will only turn off the Chapin Receiver.
- Be sure to extend the antenna before using.

### **USE:**

- With the Chapin 12V Wireless Remote On/Off Switch you can control 12V-24V products with the touch of a button. Easily plug the 2-way, 2-wire, flat-molded connectors into an interface between a battery and pump. The wireless remote control is conveniently connected to a key chain clip. You can use it to turn a sprayer on and off from the seat of your garden tractor, zero-turn mower or small tractor.
- Used to control 12V products up to 20A

### **Storage Recommendations**

Store in cool, dry place. Keep away from direct sunlight and excess heat, cold or moisture.

## Remote Capabilities

- The remote can control the receiver up to 20-50 feet away.
- Obstructions and radio interference can reduce the effective distance.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Reason	Possible Solution
Remote does not control the receiver	Remote Battery is discharged	Replace battery with A23, 12V Alkaline battery
	Receiver is not on	Receiver must be plugged into power circuit to function.
	Radio interference	Move the receiver and remote away from the electronic interference
