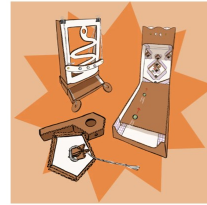

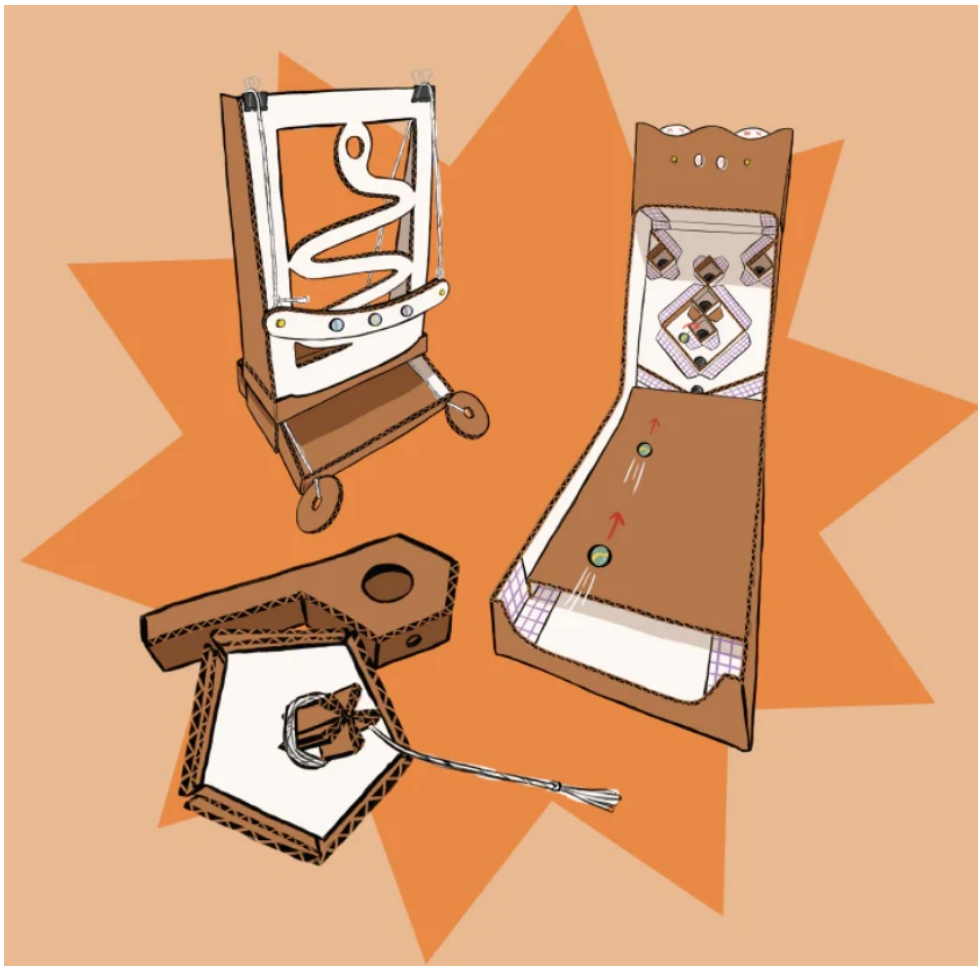

#### Specifications

Item	Description
Snake Game	A game involving a winding path.
Skeeball	A game with a ramp and scoring holes.
Spinning Top and Launcher	A toy that spins when launched.

#### Tools Needed

- Tape

#### Instructions

1. Transfer patterns onto cardboard.
2. Punch holes as indicated.

3. Cut out shapes along the lines.
4. Make folds as shown.
5. Apply tape to secure parts.
6. Remove surfaces as needed.

## **Symbols and Tips**

- If you see this symbol: **Flute Direction** – Make sure that piece is glued with the arrow oriented correctly.
- **Punch Hole:** Use the indicated hole size.
- **Cut Line:** Follow the line for precise cutting.
- **Combine your skills!** Use both hole punch and cut techniques.

## **Folding Techniques**

- **Mountain Fold:** Fold the paper upwards.
- **Valley Fold:** Fold the paper downwards.

## **Double Sided Tape**

Front and back views of how to apply double-sided tape for secure attachment.

## **Remove Surface**

Instructions on removing the surface layer of cardboard for certain parts.

## **Recommended Order**

1. Transfer Patterns
2. Punch Holes
3. Cut Out Shapes
4. Make Folds
5. Apply Tape
6. Remove Surfaces

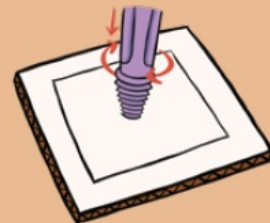
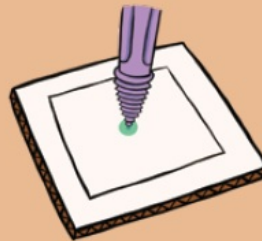
FLUTE DIRECTION

WITH THE ARROW ORIENTED LIKE THIS



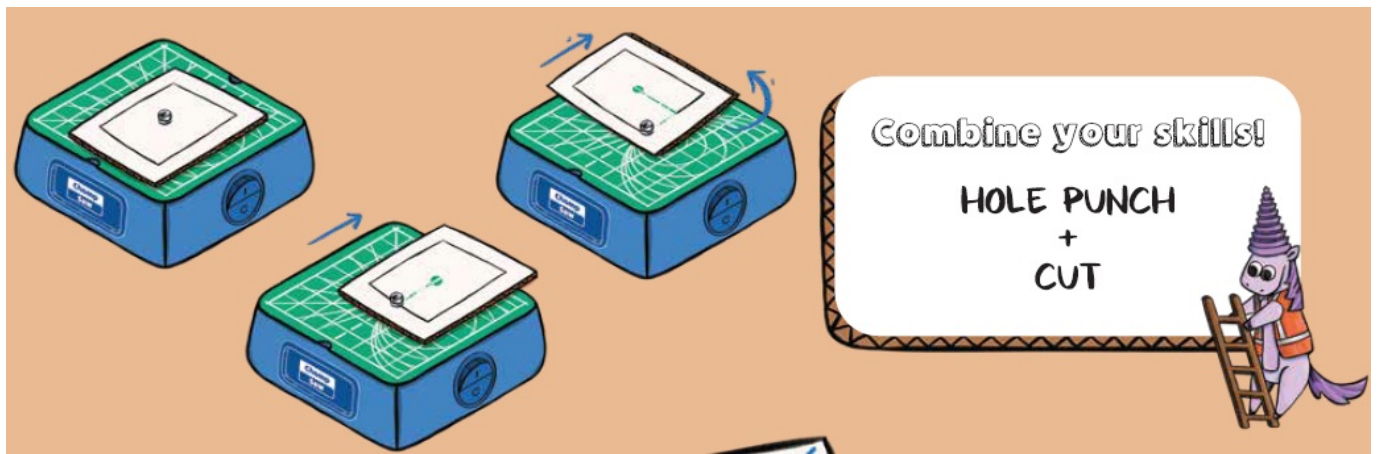
PUNCH HOLE

(HOLE SIZE)

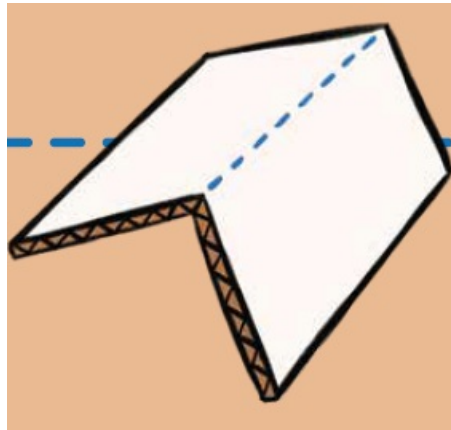


CUT LINE

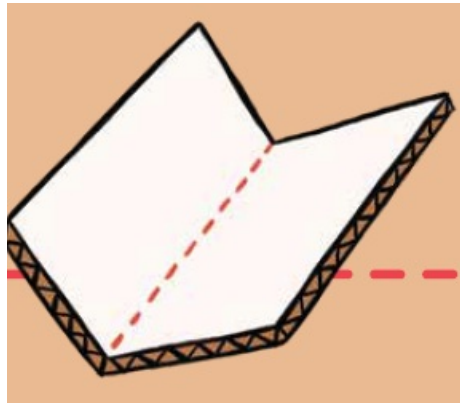




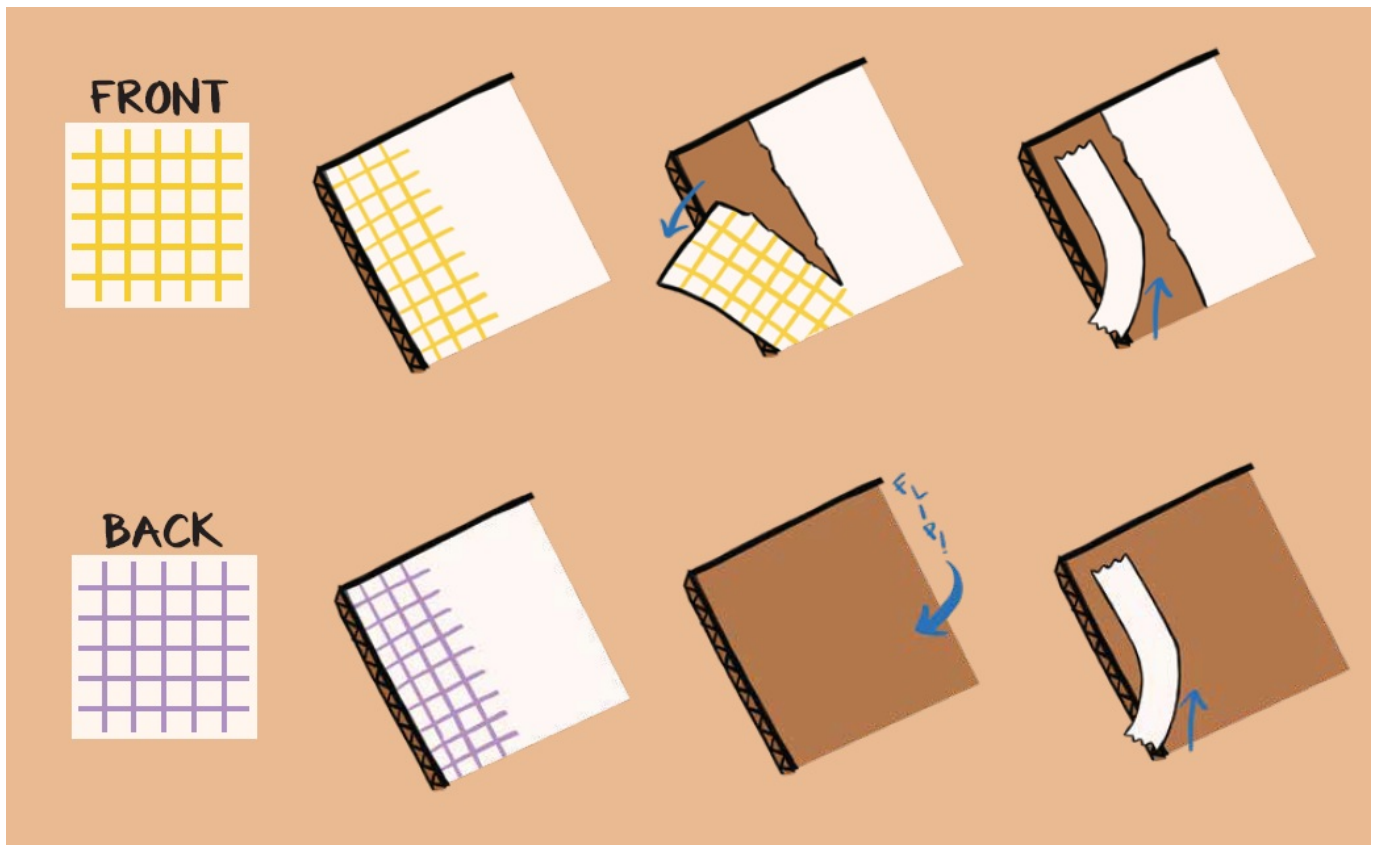
## MOUNTAIN FOLD



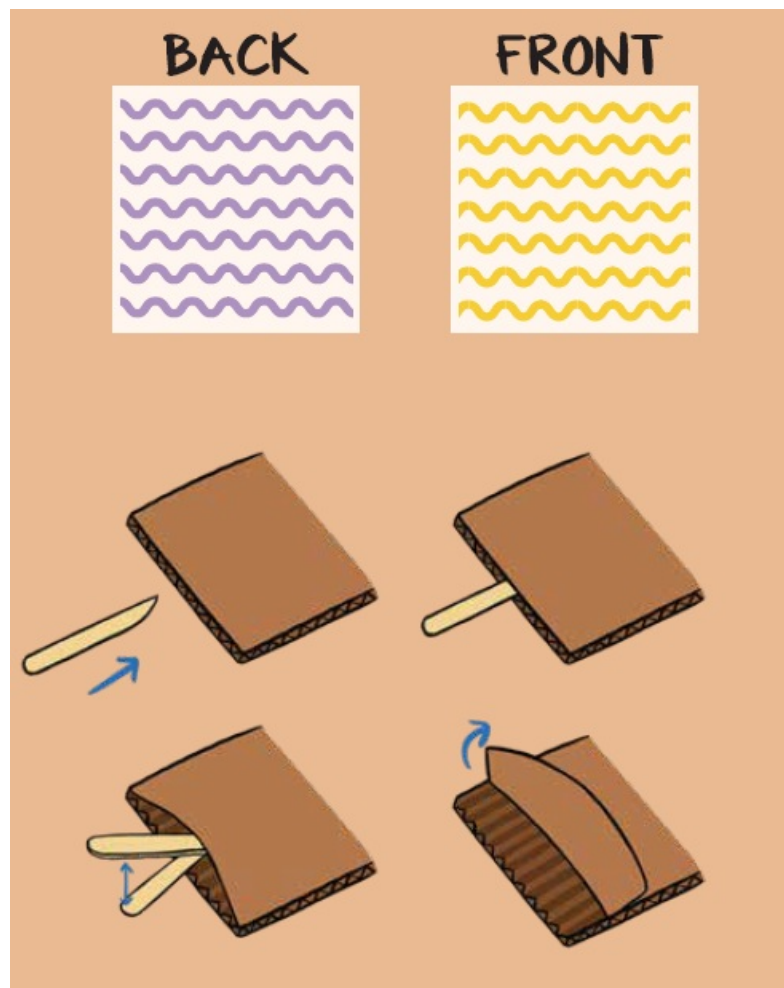
## VALLEY FOLD
