

INSTRUCTIONS

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Turn the head of the light in a counter-clockwise direction to remove it from the body of the light. Remove the battery cartridge. Place three AAA batteries into

the cartridge in the direction indicated on the cartridge. Replace the cartridge in the light. Replace the tail cap and turn it clockwise to tighten it until it is completely closed.

Note: The PX20 in packaging comes with the batteries pre-installed.

ON/OFF OPERATION

The PX20 has separate switches for each of the two colors. To activate the white light, press the gray or black switch, depending on the body color of the light. This switch is textured to allow identification in the dark. To activate the red light, press the red switch.

MAINTENANCE

- Wipe the external body with a cloth moistened with water or isopropyl alcohol.
- · Do not submerge.

Usage

- Turning On/Off: Press the tail cap switch to turn the flashlight on or off.
- Changing Modes: Cycle through the high, low, and red beam modes by pressing the switch halfway.
- Battery Replacement: Unscrew the tail cap, remove the old batteries, and insert new AAA batteries following
 the polarity markings.

Care and Maintenance

- Cleaning: Wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Care:** Remove the batteries if the flashlight will not be used for an extended period to prevent corrosion.
- Storage: Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check the flashlight for signs of wear or damage, particularly the O-rings and lens.

Troubleshooting

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
The flashlight does not turn on	Batteries are installed incorr ectly	Check and reinstall batteries according to polarity markings
	Batteries are dead	Replace with new AAA batteries
	The tail cap is not tightened	Ensure the tail cap is securely tightened
	Faulty tail cap switch	Contact COAST customer service for assistance
Light flickers	Batteries are low	Replace with new AAA batteries
	Battery contacts are dirty or corroded	Clean battery contacts and flashlight body
	The tail cap is not fully tighte ned	Tighten the tail cap
The red beam not working	Incorrect mode selected	Cycle through the modes to select the red beam
	LED is damaged	Inspect the LED and contact COAST customer ser vice if needed
Weak light output	Batteries are low	Replace with new AAA batteries
	Lens is dirty	Clean the lens with a soft, dry cloth
	LED is failing	Contact COAST customer service for assistance
The flashlight turns off inter mittently	Loose tail cap	Tighten the tail cap
	Faulty connection inside the flashlight	Contact COAST customer service for assistance
Flashlight overheats	Prolonged use in high mode	Switch to a lower mode or turn off the flashlight to cool

Pros and Cons

Pros:

- Bright 400-lumen light output
- Dual-color white and red beam
- Water-resistant design
- · Lifetime warranty

Cons:

- Requires 3 AAA batteries (included)
- May be too bright for close-range use
