








Introduction

Thank you for choosing the CoBak Page Turner. This accessory includes a clip, a magnetic remote control, and a wrist strap for convenient use. It supports forward page turning, bringing a comfortable hands-free reading experience to your e-reader.

Package Contents

- Page Turner Clip (1 pc)
- Remote Control (1 pc)
- Wrist Strap (1 pc)
- USB-C Charging Cable (1 pc)
- User Manual





Product Features

- Magnetic Docking: The remote control attaches magnetically to the clip for storage and charging.
- **Shared Charging:** A single USB-C port charges both the clip and the remote simultaneously.
- Wrist Strap: Keeps the remote easily accessible and prevents accidental drops.

How to Use

Installing the Clip

- Attach the clip securely to the side of your e-reader.
- Make sure it does not block the screen.

Using the Remote

- Attach the wrist strap to the designated hole and wear it around your wrist for convenience and safety.
- Use the forward button to turn pages.

Charging

• Dock the remote onto the clip magnetically.

- Connect a USB-C cable to the clip's charging port.
- Both the clip and the remote will charge simultaneously.

Charging Indicator

- Red Light Charging
- Green Light / Off Fully charged
- Charging time: ~3 hours

Auto Sleep & Wake

- The clip will automatically enter sleep mode after 10 minutes of inactivity to conserve battery.
- To wake the clip, simply press the button on the clip.
- Tip: Before first use or after long storage, always press the clip button to activate the device.

Pairing the Devices


Default Pairing

• The clip and remote are pre-paired at the factory.

Re-Pairing

- Press and hold the pairing button on the clip until the indicator light flashes blue.
- Press the button on the remote. The clip's indicator light will flash blue once to confirm successful pairing.

Correct Use of Page Turner



The blue part of the page turner sensor contacts the blue area of the screen (shown on the right).



The readers creen senses the appropriate area.

Page Turner Incorrect Use

Stop! You Might Be Using Your Page Turner Wrong.

Why This Matters?

- Over-pressing triggers the device's rapid-scroll mode, disrupting your reading flow.
 Master the tap, and enjoy seamless navigation.
- Here are some common mistakes users make. Please avoid the following examples:
 - Wrong: Clamped to the left side of the screen
 - Wrong: Clamped on the upper/lower edges
 - Wrong: Clamped too far inside
 - Wrong: Not clamped in the reading area



Wrong: Clamped to the left side of the screen



Wrong: Clamped on the upperandlower edges



Wrong: clamped too far inside



Wrong: Not clamped in the reading area

Safety Notes

- Do not disassemble.
- Avoid placing near strong magnetic or electronic interference.
