# **Product Usage Instructions**

#### Charging

- To charge the CD player, connect the Micro USB Charging Cable to a USB power source and the charging port of the CD player.
- The charging LED will indicate the status (Steady red for charging, off when fully charged).
- Charging time is approximately 4 hours.

## **Turning On/Off**

- **Turning On:** After fully charging, press the Play/Pause button to turn on the CD player. It will default to CD playback mode.
- Turning Off: In CD mode, press the Stop button twice. In FM Radio mode, press the Stop button once.

## **Playing CD**

- 1. Press the Open button to open the CD door.
- 2. Place a disc on the disc tray with the label side up.
- 3. Close the CD door and press Play/Pause to start loading the CD.

## **Playback Control**

- Play/Pause: Press the Play/Pause button.
- Stop: Press the Stop button.

- Next Track: Press the Next Track button.
- Previous Track: Press the Previous Track button.
- Volume Control: Use the Volume +/- buttons.
- Playback Mode: Press Mode (M) button to set repeat, shuffle, or intro modes.

#### **Programming a CD**

- 1. In CD playback mode, press Stop to stop playback.
- 2. Press the Program button, select tracks, and save for programming up to 20 tracks.
- 3. Press Play/Pause to start playback of programmed tracks.

#### **Bluetooth Audio-Out Mode**

You can play music on a Bluetooth speaker and control it using the CD player buttons.

#### Listening to FM Radio

- 1. Tune to preset radio stations using Previous/Next Track buttons.
- 2. Adjust volume with Volume +/- buttons.

#### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

#### Q: How do I know if the CD player is fully charged?

A: The charging LED indicator will turn off when the CD player is fully charged.

## Q: Can I use Bluetooth headphones with this CD player?


**A:** No, this CD player does not support Bluetooth headphones, but it has Bluetooth Audio-Out mode for external speakers.

#### Q: How many tracks can be programmed in the CD player?

A: You can program up to 20 tracks in the CD player for playback in a specific order.

#### Overview




- 1. **LCD Display –** Displays the status of the CD player.
- 2. **Play/Pause button** In power off mode, press to turn on the CD player.
  - In CD mode, press to play or pause the playback.
- 3. **Stop button** In CD mode, press to stop the playback; press again to turn off the CD player. In FM radio mode, press to turn the FM Radio off.
- 4. **Mode button –** Press to set the CD playback mode.
- 5. **Program button** Press to program a loaded CD to play tracks in a specified order.
- 6. **Previous**/ **Next Track button** Press to skip to the previous or next track / preset radio station.
- 7. Open button Press to open the CD door.
- 8. **Volume -/+ Button -** Press to increase or decrease the volume level.
- 9. **CD button** Press to enter the CD playback mode.
- 10. FM/BT button Press to enter FM radio mode; press and hold to enter Bluetooth Audio-Out mode.
- 11. Earphone jack Connect your earphones or headphones to listen to CD music or FM radio.
- 12. Micro USB Charging port
- 13. Charging LED indicator
- 14. CD door

## Charging



Connect the supplied Micro USB Charging Cable to a USB power source and the Micro USB charging port of the CD player.

Fully charged	Off

# Turning on/off



# Turning the CD player on

- After fully charging the CD player, press the Play/Pause button to turn on the CD player, and it will automatically default to CD playback mode.
- · Turning the CD player off

## To turn the CD player off:

- In CD mode, press the Stop button twice.
- In FM Radio mode, press the Stop button once

# **Playing CD**



#### Loading a CD

- 1. Press the Open button to open the CD door.
- 2. Place a disc on the disc tray with the label side up.
- 3. Press the CD door to close it.
- 4. Press the Play/Pause button to turn the CD player on, then the CD player will automatically enter CD mode and load the CD, and the "CD" appears and the track format flashes on the display screen.

## Playing a CD

- 1. Follow the instructions for loading a CD and connect the included earphones to the earphone jack of the CD player.
- 2. Wait a few seconds until both the CD's track number and elapsed time appear on the display screen.

## **Playback Control**

Play/Pause	Press the Play/Pause button
Stop	Press the <b>Stop button</b> .
Next track	Press the Next Track button
Previous track	Press the Previous Track button .
Volume up	Press the Volume + button.
Volume down	Press the <b>Volume - button</b> .
Set the playback mode	Press the Mode button M to set your desired playback mode. The playback mode indicator will appear on the display screen. REP: Repeat mode for playing a single track repeatedly. ALL REP: All Repeat mode for repeating an entire CD. RAND: Random mode for shuffling the track playback order. INTRO: Intro mode for previewing the first ten seconds of each track in intro mode.  Note: To set Intro playback mode, press the Mode button M, then press the Previous or Next track button.

# **Programming a CD**

- 1. In CD playback mode, press the Stop button to stop the CD playback.
- 2. Press the Program button P. "00" begins to blink on the display screen.
- 3. Press the Previous/Next Track button to select the track you wish to program.
- 4. Press the Program button P to save the selected track for programming.
  - Repeat steps and step4 to program up to 20 tracks to play in the order they are programmed.
- 5. Press the Play/Pause button to start the playback for the programmed tracks.

#### **Bluetooth Audio-Out Mode**



#### Output music to external devices via Bluetooth

- **Step1.** In CD playback mode, press and hold the FM/BT button until the "BE" flashes on the display screen, indicating it enters Bluetooth Out mode.
- Step2. Turn on your device (like a Bluetooth speaker) and select Bluetooth mode in your device's setting, then the CD Player will automatically be paired with your device. If it is successfully connected, the "BE" stops flashing on the display screen. And the music will be output to your device for playback.
- Step3. Music will be playable on your Bluetooth speaker and controlled like CD playback mode through the

buttons on the CD player.

## Listening to FM Radio



- · Searching and presetting radio stations automatically
- Before Listening to FM Radio, connect your headphone to the CD player.
- 1. **Select FM Radio mode:** Press the FM/BT button to enter FM Radio mode, then the FM indicator and Radio frequency appear on the display screen.
- 2. Press and hold the Play/Pause button for 2 seconds to automatically search for the radio stations with strong reception.
  - Then all available radio stations will be stored by the preset channel number in order, and the first preset radio station will broadcast automatically.

#### Listening to the preset radio stations

- 1. In FM Radio mode, press the Previous/Next Track button to tune to your desired preset radio station.
- 2. Press the Volume +/- button to adjust the broadcast volume level.

## Notes:

- 1. You can try to position the headphone cable for better reception.
- 2. In FM Radio mode, you can press the CD button to switch to CD playback mode.


