Welcome ! Setting up your RF400 Logger

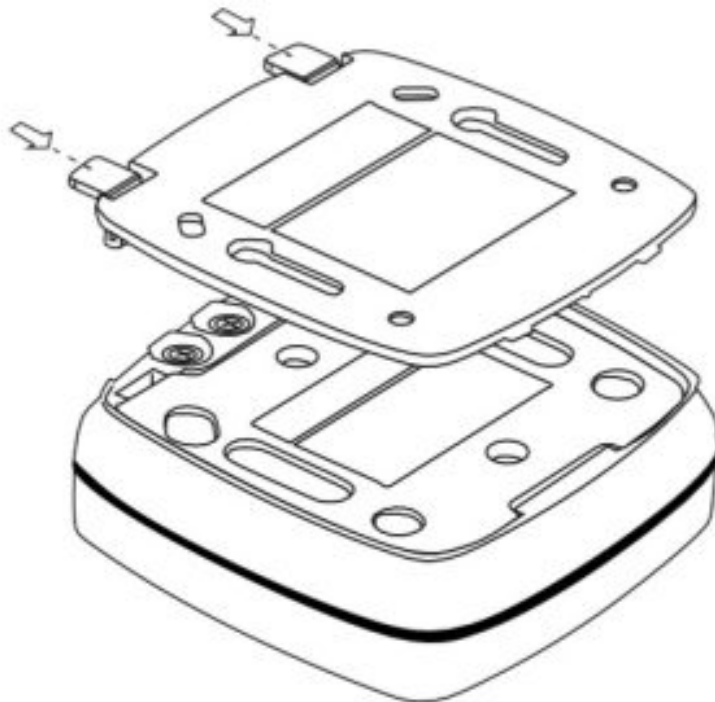
Before you connect your RF400 data logger, you will need to complete the following steps.



- Set up an account on www.comarkinstruments.net/software/44Cloud so that you can view your devices remotely.
- Download the Comark Cloud App on your phone or tablet
- Have your WiFi network details to hand

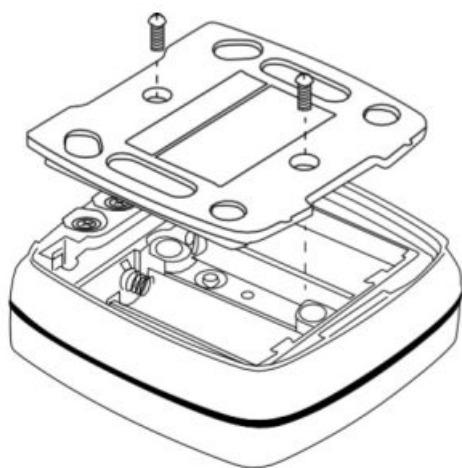


Remove mounting bracket

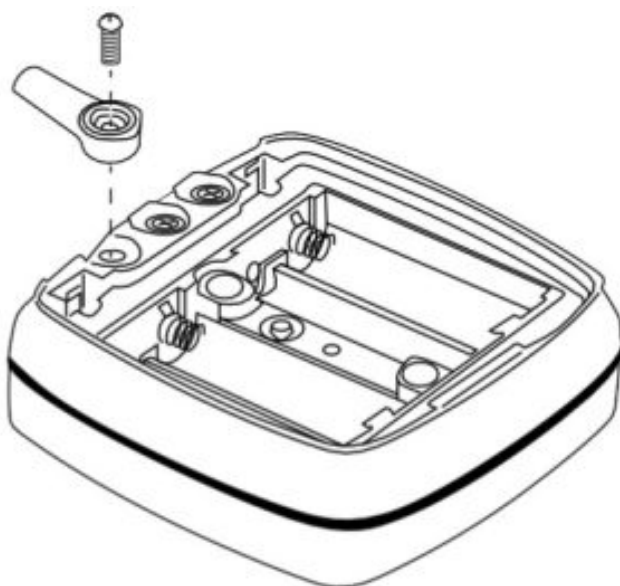


Remove battery cover

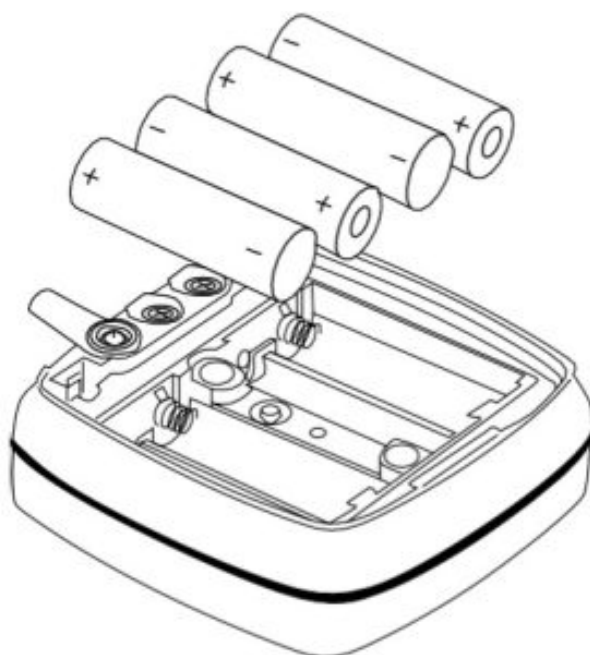
(Do not refit this until setup is complete)

6. In the Comark Cloud App, go to the menu, select Set Up Device and follow the on-screen instructions

7. Once the RF400 data logger is connected to your WiFi network replace the battery cover and install the RF400 data logger where it is to be used.



View and change device settings using the App or through your Comark Cloud Account

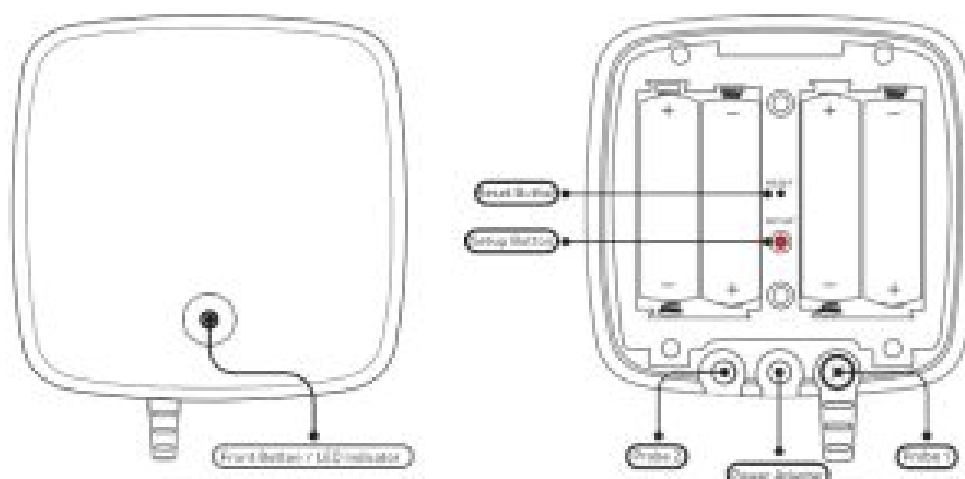

State	Front Button LED	Sounder
Device OK	1 Flash / 5 Sec	No Sounder
 Fault	1 Flash / 5 Sec	Single-tone ring every 30 minutes
 Alarm	1 Flash / 5 Sec	Continuous two-tone ring

Risk of explosion if the battery is replaced by an incorrect type. Dispose of used batteries according to the instructions.

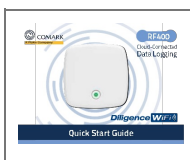
