Introduction

This Bluetooth AUX adapter boasts a clear 1.1-inch LCD screen that makes operation easy. You can access all the information about the wireless streaming status, such as Bluetooth connection status, battery, volume, and linked devices names, with only a quick glance at the screen. Our Bluetooth audio adapter is equipped with a Bluetooth 5.0 chip that allows for stable pairing, rapid transmission, and a broad signal range (33 feet). It can be connected to non-Bluetooth automotive audio systems, home stereos, wired headsets, and other devices via the 3.5mm AUX connector. Then you can listen to Wi-Fi hi-fi music!

COMSOON Bluetooth stereo receiver can reduce echo and block out intrusive background noise (such as wind, traffic, or crowds) using the latest CVC8.0 noise cancellation and Digital Signal Processor (DSP) technology, providing you crystal-clear calling sounds. 'Hands-free Calling & Navigation Broadcast' is an acronym for "Hands-free Calling & Navigation Broadcast." You can do Hands-free calls with a built-in microphone; one simple button to answer/redial/hang up/reject calls. Furthermore, the Bluetooth car adapter supports broadcasting voice notifications from an existing navigation App, so you won't have to take your eyes off the road to be safe. It has battery life of more than 10 hours. When making calls or playing music, this Bluetooth audio receiver has a working time of more than 10 hours and a standby time of up to 120 hours. It just takes 2 hours to fully charge the gadget using the provided Type-C charging cord. Furthermore, the device's high-efficiency lithium-ion battery allows it to be used securely while charging.

FEATURES

1. Receive Bluetooth audio from mobile phone/ Mp3 / tablet etc. and send it to the car stereo, boat stereo, home speakers, headphones via the AUX-IN port. Or plug a 3.5 mm wired earphone into this device to listen to music

directly.

2. LCD screen shows Bluetooth connect, volume, play status, battery level, and connected devices.
3. Noise cancellation tech for superb calling quality.
4. Double link function for connecting 2 devices at the same time.
5. Build-in mic for answering hands-free calls.
6. Auto-connect the last connected device.
7. Slide switch for easy power on/off.
8. Compatible with iOS and Android devices.

CHARGE THE DEVICE

1. Please fully charge the product before using it for the first time. While charging, the battery icon on the LCD screen will flash and become full when charging is complete.
2. There will be a beep when this device is in a low battery, then please charge it in time with DC 5V power supply input. (Do not use power supply higher than 5V)

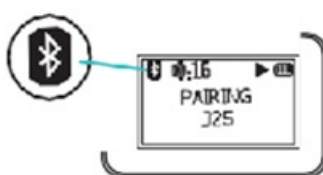
Note: Charge the product at least once every 3 months when not using for a long time.

PAIRED WITH YOUR BLUETOOTH-ENABLED SMARTPHONES, TABLETS, ETC.

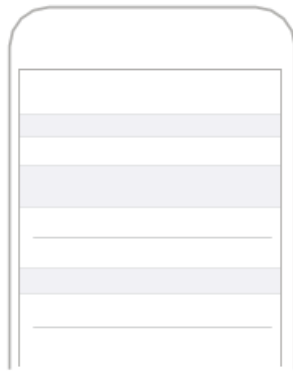
1. Slide the switch to "ON" side.



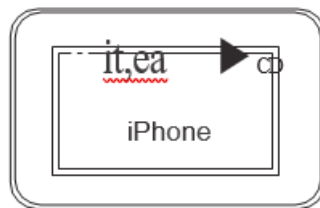
2. The Bluetooth icon on LCD display will flash, which means it's in pairing mode.



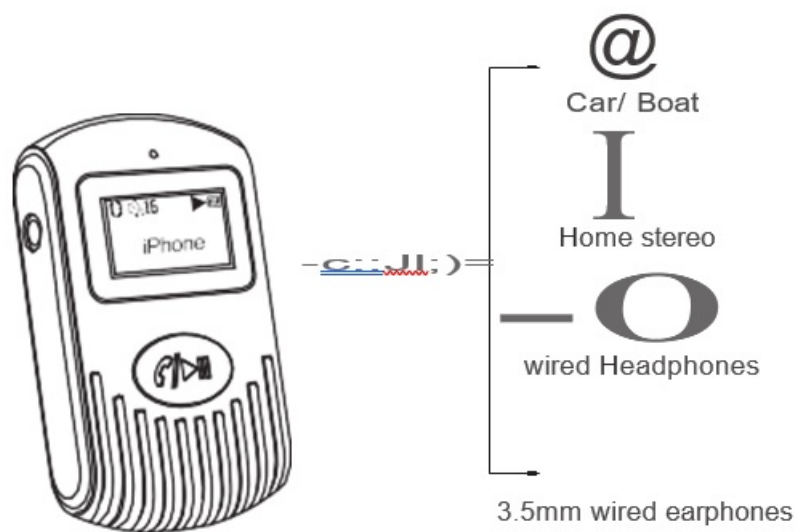
3. Turn on the Bluetooth function of your smart device, search for "J25" and connect.



4. Connected successfully, the Bluetooth icon will stop flashing, and the display will show the name of the connected device.



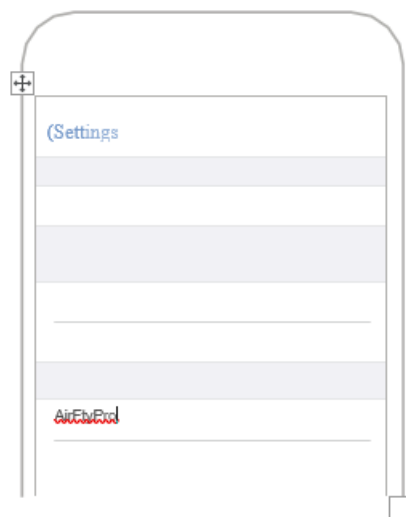
5. Connect J25 to the AUX-in port of your desired sources with the provided 3.5 mm audio cable, such as car, boat, home speakers, headphones; Or plug old 3.5 mm wired headphones into the J25.



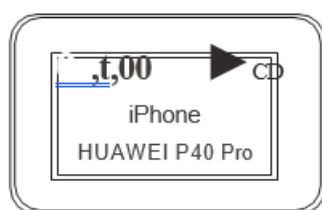
6. Now you can enjoy music wirelessly, or answer hands-free calls.

PAIR WITH SECOND SMARTPHONES, TABLETS, ETC.

1. After paired with the first smartphone successfully, turn off the Bluetooth function of the first smartphone, the product will enter pairing mode again



2. Turn on the Bluetooth function of the second smartphone, search for "J25" and connect.
3. Turn on the Bluetooth function of the first smartphone, select and connect "J25" in your pairing history.
4. Now two smartphones have connected with J25 simultaneously.



OPERATIONS

Function	Operation
Power On/Off	Slide the "ON/OFF" switch
Play/Pause/Answer/Hang up	Press the "MFB" once
Reject a call	Long press the "MFB"
Redial the last number	Press the "MFB" twice
Volume Up/Down	Long press the "+" / "-" button
Next/Previous Song	Press the "+" / "-" button once

AUTO-CONNECT

The product will automatically connect to the last paired Bluetooth device when you turn it on the next time.

AUTO POWER OFF

The product will power off automatically if not paired with any device in 5 minutes.

TROUBLESHOOTING

The product can't pair with your Bluetooth-enabled phone, MP3, etc.

1. Please make sure the receiver is in pairing mode.

2. Turn off J25 and Bluetooth of your phone, MP3, etc. then turn on and try again.

The Bluetooth range or the sound quality is not good. Bluetooth signal can be blocked by surrounding objects and reduce the audio quality, please put it in the right position without barrier between adapter and your phone (or other devices).

Frequently Asked Questions

• What is the best way to charge the Bluetooth aux?

Before using the BT AUX for the first time, make sure it is completely charged. Simply put the USB end of the charging cable into a USB wall outlet or a USB port on a laptop or PC. Connect the opposite end of the cord to the BT AUX's charging port.

• How do I resolve the issue with my Bluetooth dongle?

Check to see if your Bluetooth device is discoverable.

Restart the Bluetooth device as well as the computer.

Please unplug and re-plug the Bluetooth USB Adapter.

Please try installing the driver manually once again.

If you don't erase the device after it's been linked, you won't be able to scan it again.

- **Why isn't my external Bluetooth device functioning properly?**

Make sure you're not in aeroplane mode: Select Start, then Settings > Network & Internet > Airplane mode from the drop-down menu. Make sure you're not in aeroplane mode. Turn on and off Bluetooth: Select Start, then Settings > Devices > Bluetooth & other devices from the drop-down menu. Turn Bluetooth off for a few seconds, then on again.

- **Is it possible to use Bluetooth via AUX?**

Is it even feasible to connect your AUX and Bluetooth devices? Most gadgets won't let you use the auxiliary output and Bluetooth at the same time, but with an auxiliary splitter and Bluetooth adapter, you can listen to music on both channels.

- **What is the difference between a Bluetooth audio transmitter and a Bluetooth audio receiver?**

A Bluetooth transmitter is a gadget that allows you to send audio from one device to another wirelessly. It works by adding Bluetooth to devices that don't have it already (like an older smart TV).
