# **Product Usage Instructions**

## **Security Instructions:**

Always follow standard electrical safety precautions when using the record player.

## Functioning:

- 1. Plug in the power cord.
- 2. Place a vinyl record on the turntable.
- 3. Select the desired speed (33, 45, or 78 RPM).
- 4. Turn on the turntable.
- 5. Lift the arm and place it on the record.

## **Bluetooth Settings:**

- 1. Connect to Bluetooth by searching for "RECORD PLAYER PRO".
- 2. Confirm connection with a beep.
- 3. Control playback through the app.
- 4. To stop Bluetooth, remove the arm from the record.

## Adapter 45 RPM:

- 1. Remove the adapter.
- 2. Insert it onto the turntable.
- 3. Place the 45 RPM record on the turntable.
- 4. Enjoy your music!

## **Auxiliary Input:**

- 1. Turn on the turntable.
- 2. Connect an external audio device via AUX IN jack.
- 3. Adjust volume using the power wheel or external device controls.

## **FAQ**

## Problem: The turntable arm does not move properly.

Solution: Check if the arm holder lock is released and the arm is placed correctly on the record.

## Problem: Bluetooth connection fails.

Solution: Ensure proper pairing by following the Bluetooth settings instructions. Remove and reconnect the device if needed.

## Problem: No sound from speakers.

Solution: Check the volume settings on both the device and speakers. Make sure all connections are secure.



## **FUNCTIONING**

- 1. Plug the power cord of the turntable into the electrical outlet.
- 2. Place the vinyl record of your choice on the turntable.
- 3. Set the speed you want for your vinyl record playback using the speed selection switch. You can choose between 33, 45 and 78 RPM.
- 4. Turn on the turntable with the power knob, note that this also controls the volume. After-wards a beep will sound, this means that the turntable is in Bluetooth mode on.
- 5. Release the lock of the turntable arm holder, lift the arm slightly with your hand, and place the needle head vertically over the first track of the record, the turntable will start rotating automatically. The turntable will switch to vinyl mode and Bluetooth mode will be disa-bled. Once the arm of the turntable is placed on the vinyl, it will begin to play the music on the vinyl.
- 6. When a recording reaches the end, the turntable will stop automatically.
- 7. Lift the arm of the turntable and put it back on the armrest, the turntable will switch back to Bluetooth on mode.
- 8. Replace the turntable arm support lock.
- 9. Turn off the turntable with the power switch and disconnect from the mains power supply.


#### **BLUETOOTH SETTINGS**

- 1. Connect your device's Bluetooth, search "RECORD PLAYER PRO" and link the turntable to your device.
- 2. A beep will sound to confirm that the device has been connected correctly.
- 3. Through the APP you can play or pause the turntable and switch between songs.
- 4. To deactivate the device and stop Bluetooth, simply remove the turntable arm from the vinyl area.

#### **ADAPTER 45 RPM**


The 45 RPM adapter allows you to play smaller vinyl records, known as singles.

- 1. Remove the 45 RPM adapter.
- 2. Insert the 45 RPM adapter onto the turntable.
- 3. Gently place the 45 rpm record into the turntable.
- 4. Place the turntable arm head on the vinyl and you can enjoy your vinyl.



#### **AUXILIARY INPUT**

- 1. Turn on the turntable with the power knob.
- 2. Using a 3.5mm stereo cable, connect the external audio device to the AUX IN jack on the back of the device.
- 3. Use the power wheel to adjust the music volume or use the external audio device control-lers to control the playback/volume functions.



## **MAINTENANCE**

- It is recommended that you clean your vinyl records with an anti-static cloth for maximum enjoyment and longevity.
- For maximum durability, your stylus should be replaced periodically (approximately every 250 hours).
- Remove dust from the stylus occasionally using a very soft brush dipped in alcohol, brushing from the back of


the cartridge to the front.

## REPLACE THE HEAD NEEDLE

In addition to deterioration in sound quality, vinyl records may also suffer damage as the tip of the stylus wears out. It is recommended to change this needle every 3 or 4 months of continuous use of the turntable. These needles are easily found in specialized stores and websites.


Note: Before changing the needle, be sure to disconnect the product from the power outlet.

- 1. Release the turntable arm headlock.
- 2. Lift the turntable arm up and, to remove the needle, hold the turntable head firmly.



- 3. Pull out the front of the needle in a forward and downward motion.
- 4. Install the new replacement needle the same way you removed the old one. Raise the needle until you hear a click.

Make sure the stylus is securely installed and there is no gap between the new stylus and the turntable arm head.



#### PROBLEM RESOLUTION

The device is connected but does not work.

• Make sure the turntable is connected to power and check that you have turned it on and turned up the volume.

A strange sound is heard through the speakers.


- Check that the vinyl record is not damaged.
- Make sure the needle is in good condition and should not be replaced. (The needle should be replaced every 3~4 months of continuous use.)

• Do not set the volume to maximum to avoid sound distortion.
