Align your nano SIM card with the SIM icon on the bottom side, and insert the card into the SIM slot until you


- Q: Where can I find the Wi-Fi name and password?
- A: The Wi-Fi name and password are printed on the back of the router.
- Q: How do I know if my SIM card is inserted correctly?
- A: Align your nano SIM card with the SIM icon on the bottom side and insert it into the SIM slot until you hear a

clicking sound.

- Q: How long should I wait for the router to start after powering it on?
- A: Wait approximately 2 minutes for the router to start after pressing the power button.


Insert your SIM card

• Align your nano SIM card with the SIM icon on the bottom side, and Insert the card into the SIM slot until you hear a clicking sound.




Power the device


• Connect the power adapter and press the power button to turn on the router. Please wait 2 minutes for it to start.






Check the ♀ LED

Enter configuration page





• If this message pops up, please enter your PIN and click "Save & Apply", or contact your cellular provider for help.




- If 4G is not connected, or if you want to customize the router yourself, click "Quick Setup" and follow the stepby-step instructions to configure the router.
