#### **Hardware Installation Instructions**

- 1. Unplug the power cable of your computer and remove the case panel.
- 2. Connect the Bluetooth USB cable to the adapter.
- 3. Insert the adapter into a PCI-E X1 or higher slot.
- 4. Plug the Bluetooth USB cable into a USB connector. Note: Skip this step if you don't have an available USB connector on the motherboard. The Wi-Fi functionality does not require this step.
- 5. Connect the antennas to the adapter.
- 6. Mount the case panel back to the computer and boot it up.

# • Q: Can I use this adapter with a laptop?


A: This adapter is designed for desktop computers with compatible slots. It may not be suitable for laptops.

# • Q: How do I troubleshoot if the adapter is not working after installation?


A: Ensure that the adapter is securely connected to the slot and that all cables are properly plugged in. You can also contact Cudy's technical support for assistance.

1. Unplug the power cable of your computer and remove the case panel.




2. Connect the Bluetooth USB cable to the adapter.




Bluetooth USB cable

3. Insert the adapter into a PCI-E X1 or higher slot.






4. Plug the Bluetooth USB cable into a USB connector.




**Note:** Skip this step if you don't have an available USB connector on the motherboard. The Wi-Fi functionality does not require this step.

5. Connect the antennas to the adapter.




6. Mount the case panel back to the computer and boot it up.



Click into the Wi-Fi and Bluetooth icons and click the "Download" buttons in the opened pages.










Double-click the downloaded files to run and complete the installation.
