

Product Usage Instructions

Step 1: Hardware Connection

- 1. Turn off the modem and remove any installed battery.
- 2. Connect Cudy's WAN port to your ISP modem.
- 3. Turn on the modem and wait for about 2 minutes for it to restart.
- 4. Connect the power adapter to the router and wait for about 2-3 minutes until all LEDs turn solid, indicating a successful hardware connection.

Step 2: Network Connection

Choose one of the following methods:

- 1. **Wi-Fi Connection:** Connect your device to the router's Wi-Fi using the SSID and Password printed on the bottom of the router (e.g., SSID: Cudy-***-5G).
- 2. **Wired Connection:** Turn off Wi-Fi on your computer and connect it to the router's LAN port via an Ethernet cable.


Step 3: Router Configuration

- 1. Launch a web browser and enter http://192.168.10.1/ in the address bar.
- 2. Create an administrator password to log in.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to set up the internet connection.



- 4. Connect the power adapter to the router. Then wait for about 2-3 minutes until the five LEDs turn solid on, indicating a successfull hardware connection.




5. Connect the router via A or B method.







• A Wi-Fi: Connect your device to the router's Wi-Fi using the SSID (network name) and Password printed on the bottom of the router.












- Go to step 6 and continue.
- **B Wired**: Turn off the Wi-Fi on your computer and connect it to the router's LAN port via an Ethernet cable.




