


Arrow buttons

adjust temperature or time




Mode selector

change mode of operation


Circuit selector

changes between heating (I) and hot water (II)

































Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: How do I adjust the temperature on the ECL Comfort 301?
 - A: You can adjust the temperature by using the minus and plus buttons on the controller.
- Q: Can I restore factory settings on the ECL Comfort 301?
 - A: Yes, you can restore factory settings by pressing both buttons simultaneously for 2 seconds.
